LAST GAME

Into the All-Star Break, the Baysox missed their chance at their first series sweep of the season, and were instead served their sixth shutout loss of the season on Sunday afternoon, falling 9-0 to Akron. A leadoff home run by Jose Tena in the first inning set the scene, as Akron would score seven of their runs on long balls, including a pair of three-run blasts in the eighth inning, one off of Justin Armbruester, and the other off of Tyler Burch. Bowie only managed four hits in the contest, singles by Cesar Prieto and Greg Cullen, as well as doubles by Shayne Fontana and Andrew Daschbach. It was the fourth time in their last nine games that Bowie had been held to four or fewer hits offensively.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Returning to face off against the Southwest Division First Half Champion for the second time in less than a month, Richmond is not in much better shape than they were at the end of June when Bowie took five-of-six at Prince George's Stadium. Richmond split their following series with Reading, and lost their most recent series with Altoona. Richmond has the lowest batting average in the league in the second half at .217, nearly 25 points lower than the next-worst team. That league-worst contact number is coupled by the most strikeouts at the plate in the second half, over 11 strikeouts per game. Their pitching staff has 5.58 ERA after the first three weeks of the half, as well as the most walks allowed in the league with 92.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

After a late start to the season, right-hander Matt Frisbee has been reliable arm for the Squirrels. Frisbee missed the first two series of the season, and could not finish the fourth inning in any of his first four starts with Richmond, but went on a string of eight-consecutive starts of at least five innings pitched. His luck ran out when he ran into Bowie however, as the Baysox drilled a new career-high 10 runs, including a grand slam by Cesar Prieto. A contact heavy pitcher, Frisbee has only struck out five-or-more batters in just four of his 16 outings this season.

JOLTIN' JOEY

Baysox infielder Joey Ortiz has been on a great run to start the month of July. In 14 games this month, Ortiz has already gone 17-for-51 (.333) at the plate with a pair of doubles, his first career multi-home run game on July 15, and leads the team with nine runs scored in the month. Ortiz was ranked as the Orioles #15 prospect entering the 2022 season according to MLB Pipeline, #16 according to Baseball America. He has already played more games this season than in 2021, due to a torn labrum in his left shoulder in late June that season.

EARLY STRIKE

Games between Bowie and Richmond are always at an opportunity to get underway early. Entering this series, Richmond (60) and Bowie (54) are second and third in the League, respectively, in runs allowed in the first inning of games. Offensively, Bowie is only fifth-best (50) in the league, while Richmond is only eighth-best (42) in the league at scoring in the first inning of games.

LOOK, IT'S A PITCHING TEAM NOW

While many of Bowie's strengths were coming from the offense over the first few months of the season, July has been propped up by the Bowie pitching staff. Bowie has the best ERA in the Eastern League in July (3.02) as well as the fewest walks allowed (33). That strength has been sapped from the Bowie offense, however, as Bowie has the lowest batting average (.221) scored the fewest runs (42, 3/G) stolen the fewest bases (3) and drawn the second-fewest walks (38) in the Eastern League this month.

MIGHT AS WELL JUST START ON BASE

Some of Bowie's offensive woes this season have not been from a lack of effort. In fact, the Baysox are the team most likely to start an inning with a runner on base in the Eastern League. Bowie leads the league in all three slash lines (.281/.368/.481) from the first batter of an inning this season. They also lead the league in lead off home runs and doubles, while sporting the third-fewest strikeouts from the first batter of an inning. All of those numbers combine to Bowie leaving 631 runners on base this season, the most in the league, and an average of 7.5 per game. Inversely, Bowie has the fifth-most strikeouts, and the second-lowest batting average (.236) in the league when batting with runners on base.

The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
