LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox were thoroughly overpowered on Friday night in Pennsylvania, as they fell to the Harrisburg Senators 10-1, Bowie was shutout over the first seven innings, with only a solo home run saving them from the full shutout. Harrisburg scored runs in five of their eight innings offensively. Bowie could find no answer to Harrisburg right-hander Luis Reyes, as the 27-year-old held the Baysox to only one hit over six shutout innings. Bowie broke the shutout in the eighth inning when Cristopher Cespedes launched a solo home run to right-center field, his first of the season with Bowie. Antonio Velez was tagged for three runs early, but was still able to move through five innings while striking out six batters. Harrisburg continued to attack the bullpen, as Clayton McGinness allowed four runs in his second Double-A outing, and Easton Lucas allowed a three-run home run to Wilson Garcia.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The first month of 2022 belonged to Harrisburg, as the Senators held the top spot in the Southwest Division for most of April, but have not found much success since. After opening the season at 12-9, they have gone 9-20 entering this week at FNB Field. Most of Harrisburg's struggles have been at the plate, as their 209 runs scored (4.3/G) is the third-fewest in the league. Harrisburg makes plenty of contact to run their offense, as they have the second-fewest strikeouts at the plate, and the fewest walks drawn in the league. The back end of this road trip could be a good lift for Bowie, as Harrisburg is only 9-15 at home at the start of this series, the second-lowest winning percentage in the league

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Jake Irvin got his well-earned promotion to Harrisburg last week after picking apart batters in High-A. Irvin made nine starts at the lower level, and only allowed five earned runs in 30 innings, while striking out 29 batters and only walking eight. Distance has been a notable problem with his starts, as Irvin never even moved into the fifth inning. He tried to enter the fifth inning in his Double-A debut against Erie, but only collected one out while allowing four runs and taking the loss. His fastball can touch up to 97 miles per hour, as well as a curveball and a changeup.

YOUNG GUNS

The Bowie pitching staff has been pitching to plenty of contact this season, for better or worse. The Baysox have allowed the third-fewest walks in the league, but also only struck out the third-fewest batters. Meanwhile, Bowie pitchers have the highest Hits/9, at just over nine.

YOUNG GUNS

The Baysox have the fourth-youngest roster in the Eastern League, with the combination of their full roster averaging 23.8 years old. Only Akron, Altoona, and New Hampshire have younger rosters than the Baysox. Harrisburg's roster is nearly two years older than Bowie on average, at 25.5 years old

INEFFECTIVELY WILD

Bowie pitching had a tough time with grip and location on Friday, hitting five batters during their 10-1 loss. While it wasn't the most hit by pitches in a game (Harrisburg actually hit seven Richmond Flying Squirrels in a game earlier this season), it tied a franchise record for Harrisburg for batters hit by pitches, and was the most hit by pitches from Bowie pitching in a single game since at least 2005, according the MLB Research portal.

GET 'EM ON, GET 'EM OVER, FORGOT THE LAST ONE

The Baysox left another three runners on base in Friday's game, it was the second time that Bowie had collected only two hits in a game this season, and continued a tough trend of leaving runners on base. Bowie has retaken the top spot in the league for the most runners left on base, with 395 total runners left stranded, and average of 7.4 runners left on base per game.

FIELD GENERALS

Bowie's catchers have been a strong asset this season. Bowie's CS% of 47% from their catchers is the highest mark in the league. Additionally, Bowie has only allowed 23 stolen bases this season, the fewest in the minors

What They're Saying:

Matt Blood, Orioles Dir. of Player Development: "He throws a lot of strikes. He's deceptive, he's an uncomfortable at-bat for hitters and he's still pretty young, so we're excited about that."

MLB Pipeline: "Lean and projectable, Rom hides the ball well by creating deception with his 6-foot-2 frame. He releases from a three-quarters arm slot and uses his long stride and crossfire finish to create good extension, which allows his pitches to play up and miss barrels consistently. He is comfortable throwing either off-speed pitch in fastball counts as well as mixing up arm angles; he couples this unpredictability with a quick pace and moderate effort delivery that projects durability.

Baseball America: "Rom hasn't yet developed a standout pitch, but a varied mix and precocious pitchability have helped him carve up hitters at every level. He experimented with dropping his arm slot against lefties to create different action on his two-seam fastball. Rom knows how the pitches play off one another, and pitches backwards while taking advantage of his deception and angles."

Manager: Kyle Moore

Conway was selected in the fourth round of the 2012 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by the Chicago Cubs out of Coastal Carolina. He played three seasons with the Cubs organization, making it to Double-A in 2016. The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
