#### LAST GAME

Despite their second ninth inning game-tying home run in less than a week, the Bowie Baysox were instead handed their seventh walk-off loss of the season on Wednesday night, dropping another game to the Erie SeaWolves 5-4 in 11 innings. Bowie made inroads early with an RBI single from Maverick Handley in the first inning, and then a pair of errors by Erie to score a run in the third. The early offense was the best Bowie could manage until the ninth inning, however, as right-hander Austin Bergner fired six innings while striking out six batters. Dane Myers carried most of the load for Erie, blasting two home runs to make it a 4-2 game, but a ninth inning game-tying two-run home run by Zach Watson gave Bowie new life. While Erie held Bowie empty in the two extra innings, Quincy Nieporte finally closed the game with a walk-off single off of Jensen Eliott in the 11th.

#### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The final week of the first half is an important one for the SeaWolves, as they hope to overcome a scant two-game deficit in the Southwest Division to clinch their first berth in the Eastern League playoffs since 2013. While much of their offense has been league-average, their numbers are carried heavily by early MVP candidate Kerry Carpenter, as the outfielder leads all of Minor League Baseball with 22 home runs, a number that trails only Aaron Judge's 25 among all of baseball. Carpenter hit five home runs against Bowie in May, and 13 total in the month of May, As a staff. Erie has put together some of the best pitching numbers in the league, including the fewest walks allowed, and the second-best ERA. Their starting rotation has been the best in the league, with a 3.07 ERA

#### **TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER**

In just his second Minor League season, right-hander Wilmer Flores has turned some heads following a stellar start to the season with High-A West Michigan. While he does share a name with his older brother, San Francisco Giants infielder Wilmer Flores, the younger Flores dominates on the mound rather than in the field. In his Double-A debut, Flores fired five one-hit innings against New Hampshire while striking out seven batters and only walking one. In the outing, Flores retired the final 12 batters he faced in order. Bowie nicked him for four runs and seven hits in May, but has only allowed six earned runs in his following 16 innings. While his fastball has had its issues with location, it can get up to 98 miles per hour. He also features a tight curveball, and a budding changeup and

#### **OUT OF GAS**

Bowie has been dealt seven walk-off losses this season, a scenario that is normally only possible through bullpen performance. In just their last nine games, the Bowie bullpen has seen their collective ERA rise from 4.71 to 4.96, the highest mark in the league. Bowie relievers have also allowed a league-leading 37 home

#### **SLIM MARGINS**

Bowie had an early handle on one-run games this season, as they opened the season at an even 3-3 in games decided by one run, but have only gone 5-12 in one run games since. One run games have been the biggest factor in Bowie's current position in the standings, as their 23 one-run games is the third-most in the league, but their .348 winning percentage in one run games is the worst in the league.

#### TRY FOR SOME GROUND BALLS

Baysox pitching has had their ERA heavily influenced by the long ball. The 84 home runs allowed by Bowie pitching is the second-most in the Eastern League. Bowie has allowed 18 total home runs over their last 13 games, the most in the league. Bowie has allowed 19 home runs to Erie already in just eight games. Already tied for the most home runs they've allowed to any single opponent this season.

#### FIELD GENERALS

Bowie's catchers have been a strong asset this season. Bowie's CS% of 44% from their catchers is the highest mark in the league. Additionally, Bowie has only allowed 29 stolen bases this season, the fewest in the minors. Catcher Cody Roberts made a big return to Bowie after a short trip up to Triple-A Norfolk, going 5-for-12 at the plate with a three-run home run, a walk-off RBI single, and a double. Roberts tied a career high with four RBI on Friday, and has collected hits in


