### LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox suffered their fifth walk-off loss of the season on Saturday night, and their second in less than a week, as they fell to the Harrisburg Senators 2-1 in ten innings. Neither of Harrisburg's runs were earned, while Bowie collected their only run on a late-game solo home run for the second-consecutive night. A first inning error with two outs eventually led to Harrisburg's early run when Alfredo Rodriguez lined a single to center field to plate the run. After the unexpectedly extended inning, Drew Rom was only able to log 3.2 innings in a short start. In relief, Noah Denoyer logged another strong outing by spinning 3.1 scoreless innings while striking out seven batters. Vowie tied the game in the seventh inning when J.D. Mundy lifted a solo home run to right field, but after Bowie failed to plate their free runner in the tenth inning, Harrisburg used a pair of singles, including a game-winning liner by Gilbert Lara to take the series win.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The first month of 2022 belonged to Harrisburg, as the Senators held the top spot in the Southwest Division for most of April, but have not found much success since. After opening the season at 12-9, they have gone 9-20 entering this week at FNB Field. Most of Harrisburg's struggles have been at the plate, as their 209 runs scored (4.3/G) is the third-fewest in the league. Harrisburg makes plenty of contact to run their offense, as they have the second-fewest strikeouts at the plate, and the fewest walks drawn in the league. The back end of this road trip could be a good lift for Bowie, as Harrisburg is only 9-15 at home at the start of this series, the second-lowest winning percentage in the league.

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-handed pitcher Steven Fuentes returns to the Nationals organization after seven years of service. He was signed as a minor league free agent on November 15th. Last season, he pitched in four levels of the Nationals organization, most notably to a 19.96 ERA in seven appearances in AAA Rochester. He's logged strong outings with Harrisburg this season, including four innings of one-run ball against Bowie in early May. Following his worst outing of the season, allowing seven runs on eight hits in just four innings to Erie on the final day of May, he was the tough-luck loser to Bowie at the start of this series, allowing only two runs in six innings while striking out six batters.

### NO NEED TO DASCH TO FIRST

First baseman Andrew Daschbach has had a curious relationship with full counts and walks this season. While currently on pace to eclipse his 42 walks from 2021, Daschbach is also on pace to strike out 171 times, nearly 30 more times than 2021. Most interesting of his approach to the plate has been Daschbach's ability to draw a full count. He has worked 40 plate appearances full this season, the fifth-most in the league. He does not have a single base hit on a full count. No other batter among the top 50 for most full counts in the league has gone hitless on full counts.

### SLIM MARGINS

Bowie had an early handle on one-run games this season, as they opened the season at an even 3-3 in games decided by one run, but have only gone 3-10 in one run games since. One run games have been the biggest factor in Bowie's current position in the standings, as their 19 one-run games is the third-most in the league, but their .316 winning percentage in one run games is the worst in the league.

### SEASONAL DROUGHTS

Bowie has come hit a wall after just one run on their last two games, with both runs coming in on solo home runs late in game. It is the third time this season that the Baysox have scored one run or fewer in consecutive games. Bowie and Harrisburg are the only two teams in the league this season to score one run or fewer in three-consecutive games. This all comes while Bowie has still scored the fifth-most runs in the league.

### FIELD GENERALS

Bowie's catchers have been a strong asset this season. Bowie's CS% of 47% from their catchers is the highest mark in the league. Additionally, Bowie has only allowed 23 stolen bases this season, the fewest in the minors.

- Full Trade: (Dec. 4, 2019) Orioles receive: RHP Isaac Mattson, RHP Kyle Bradish, RHP Kyle Brnovich and RHP Zach Peek. Angels receive: RHP Dylan Bundy
- Friday starter at Winthrop for his junior campaign, leading both Winthrop and the Big South Conference with 91 strikeouts. Also logged eight quality starts.
- Earned a four-inning save in his High-A debut in 2021, despite allowing four runs. Had an 8-1 lead, to still win 8-5. Also struck out seven batters in his four innings.

## What They're Saying:

Peek, on offseason improvements: "Before last spring training my offseason goal was to move better with the lower half...move better with the hips. This offseason my goal was to be more rotational into arm path. Last year my arm was climbing a little bit with the elbow so I'd get to a point so then my elbow would come up and then down, so we just worked on smoothing that out to have more of a rotational movement." ## Notes by Outing\*

- 4/12 at BNG All three runs allowed in just first two innings. After striking out the first batter of the day, allowed a single and two doubles for tow runs, and later a solo home run to Antoine Duplantis in the second inning. After allowing three baserunners in the third inning, retired the final seven batters faced. Was the first Bowie pitcher of the season to complete five innings.
- 4/19 v AKR Allowed a string of three consecutive batters to reach with one out in the first inning, but only one run would score as he would get out of the inning. Would take long breaks on the bench, as Bowie scored eight runs in the first inning, and then four runs in the second inning.
- 4/24 v AKR Struck out three batters over two scoreless innings to start the outing, but allowed three consecutive batters to reach base to start the third, and two runs total. Drew to fly balls and a ground out for a perfect fourth inning to finish the night.
- 4/30 @ RIC Opened with two scoreless innings on all contact, four groundouts and two flyouts. Allowed a run in the third inning on a double, a stolen base, and a wild pitch. Struck out three of the final four batters he faced.
- 5/26 v ERI Allowed a pair of leadoff singles in the first inning, but used a double play to keep a scoreless frame. Allowed a two more singles and a walk in the second inning, and was lifted with two outs at a pitch limit. Reliever allowed a grand slam.
- 6/1 @ ALT Allowed one single in all four innings worked, and eliminated each of the first three singles on double plays
- 6/7 @ HBG Faced the minimum over the first three innings thanks to a caught stealing after a two-out single in the second inning, struck out four batters over the stretch. Allowed a leadoff double in the fourth inning, but Peek caught the runner stealing third base. Only run allowed was a solo home run to Wilson Garcia later in the fourth inning. Garcia would hit four home runs in the seven-game series.
