#### **LAST GAME**

The Baysox soared over the Richmond Flying Squirrels on Sunday night at Prince George's Stadium, taking the finale of the six-game series 5-1. Coincidentally, 5-1 was also how the full series had ended in favor of the Baysox, as they won five games in a series for the first time this season. Making his second rehab start for the Baysox, matt Harvey spun five scoreless innings while striking out seven batters, while Justin Armbruester followed in tandem to strike out eight batters and earn the four-inning save. Bowie broke through for three runs in the third inning on a two-run home run by Maverick Handley, and Zach Watson contributed with a two-run blast of his own in the seventh.

#### **TODAY'S OPPONENT**

Going from one first half winner to the other, the Baysox are on their only trip to New Jersey this season. The Yankees Double-A affiliate has consistently had the best pitching staff in the league, sporting a 3.46 ERA, but it has not been buoyed by any other league-leading marks, such as strikeouts, walks, or hits allowed. The addition of power to the lineup has always been a help for the Patriots, as they enter the series as the only team in the league with over 100 home runs. No individual player has carried the load in full for Somerset, as they have four different players with at least ten home runs. Speed has been critical for their success as well, with two players among the top three for stolen bases in the EL, including Anthony Volpe's league-leading 32.

#### **TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER**

Sean Boyle is getting his first full taste of Double-A action after climbing through the Yankees organization for over three years. A "Have Arm, Will Travel" pitcher in the organization in 2021, Boyle made at least four appearances at all four main affiliates for the Yankees, including six outings at Triple-A where he only allowed three earned runs in 25.1 innings. His time with Somerset this season has been somewhat erratic, however. Following a two-start span in which he allowed 17 runs in 8.1 innings to end May, Boyle has gome 3-1 in his following five starts, allowing only 12 earned runs in 29.1 innings. Home runs have been harmful to the right-hander, as his 13 home runs allowed is tied for the fourth-most in the league this season.

#### HIGH-CONTACT SURFACE

While the Baysox do still lead the Eastern League in walks drawn this season, the lead has been shrinking while Bowie has made transitions into more contact at the plate. In the last 30 days, Bowie has only drawn 94 walks in 28 games (3.6) only the seventh-most in the league, but in the same span their 228 hits is the most in the league, and their 225 strikeouts is the second-fewest in the league.

#### **NOW THAT'S A STAFF**

Bowie pitching has been on strong run over this current win streak. Over the first six games of the second half, Bowie pitching has held a strong 3.46 ERA. While the Baysox did enter this half with an overall 4.99 ERA, the highest in the league, these for games have dropped them down to 4.86, a step in the right direction at just the third-highest in the league.

#### **CO-CO-COMING UP**

For the start of the second half, Baltimore has promoted three of its top offensive prospects to Bowie following successful stints with Aberdeen.

Colton Cowser is ranked as the Orioles #4 prospect and #54 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline, made a quick impression on the Baysox lineup, going 3-for-3 with a home run in his first official Double-A at bat, and has already drawn seven walks against just five strikeouts in five games. Connor Norby is ranked as the Orioles #10 prospect by MLB Pipeline, and went 1-for-4 with a walk in a run scored in his debut while leading off for Bowie, and has collected a hit in every game played with Bowie so far, as well as drawing three walks against just four strikeouts. Coby Mayo is ranked as the Orioles #7 prospect by MLB Pipeline, but the infielder went 0-for-5 in his debut, but rebounded to smash a two-run home run for his first Double-A hit.

# **FIELD GENERALS**

Thanks to Cody Roberts and Maverick Handley, Bowie has had the most feared backstops in the league. Bowie's CS% of 40% is the highest mark in the league. Additionally, Bowie has only allowed 36 stolen bases this season, the second-fewest in the minors (Omaha-32).



# Manager: Kyle Moore
