LAST GAME

While the Bowie offense did return from its three-game trip to the stratosphere, the Baysox were still able to attack late to pick up their fourth-consecutive win, taking down Richmond 4-2. Making his first Double-A start, Noah Denoyer was hit for a leadoff home run by Micheal Gigliotti to open the game, and an unearned run later in the day, but the right-hander still fired five innings while striking out a career-high nine batters. Bowie tied the game quickly in the first on an RBI single by Coby Mayo, and retied the game in the sixth on a leadoff home run by Hudson Haskin. An RBI fielder's choice hit by Andrew Daschbach gave Bowie the lead, and a wild pitch later in the game allowed Joey Ortiz to score some insurance for the Baysox.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Richmond enters this series flying high, having punched their way into the playoffs for the first time since 2014. A tiebreak atop the Southwest Division gave Richmond the first half berth thanks to their head-to-head record over Akron. The Squirrels had an excellent June going 15-8 with a 2.66 staff ERA in the month, both marks topping the Eastern League, while they only lost consecutive games once during the month. Despite playing in one of the most pitcher-friendly parks in the Eastern League, Richmond has done plenty of their damage with home runs. Their .228 batting average is the second-lowest in the Eastern League, but their 89 home runs are the second-most. Entering the series, Richmond has already won seven of the nine meetings between these two clubs.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Left-hander Kyle Harrison is yet another strikeout-artist, top-prospect, arm in the Richmond rotation. Ranked as the Giants #2 overall prospect, and the #3 left-handed pitching prospect in baseball by MLB Pipeline, Harrison outclassed batters in High-A, only allowing runs in two of his seven starts, and striking out at least seven batters in all but one start. Since joining Richmond at the end of May, the learning curve has started to dissipate. In his first three starts with Richmond, Harrison allowed 11 runs in 13.1 innings along with three home runs. In his following three starts, Harrison has allowed just three earned runs in 18 innings while striking out 28 batters and only walking eight. His fastball can touch 98 MPH at points while moving on both planes, as well as a slider and changeup that both sit in the lower 80s, helping Harrison draw tons of swings and misses.

HURRY UP HUDSON

Bowie outfielder Hudson Haskin has been a big fan of the early attack. One of the most liable to attack the first pitch, Haskin has put the first pitch of a plate appearance into play 40 time this season, or about one-in-seven of his plate appearances. In a similar vein, Haskin has been able to pounce on pitchers when they are still trying to settle into an inning. Of his 10 home runs this season, Haskin has hit six of them when leading off an inning, tied with Richmond's Sean Roby for the most in the Eastern League.

GIMMIE FIVE

Bowie is on their third four-game winning streak of the season. Their first came in April, when they also won the first four games of a six-game series with Akron, and the second came at the change from May to June, as Bowie took two games each from Erie and Altoona. Bowie has not won five-consecutive games at any point this season, and their last win streak of at least five games came in mid-September of 2021, when the Baysox strung together ten-consecutive wins.

NO NEED TO DASCH TO FIRST

First baseman Andrew Daschbach has had a curious relationship with full counts and walks this season. While currently on pace to eclipse his 42 walks from 2021, Daschbach is also on pace to strike out 161 times, nearly 30 more times than 2021. Most interesting of his approach to the plate has been Daschbach's ability to draw a full count. He has worked 49 plate appearances full this season, the sixth-most in the league. He does not have a single base hit on a full count. No other batter among the top 50 for most full counts in the league has gone hitless on full counts.

NOW THAT'S A STAFF

Bowie pitching has been on strong run over this current win streak. Over the current four-game run, Bowie pitching has held a strong 2.75 ERA. While the Baysox did enter this series with an overall 4.99 ERA, the highest in the league, these for games have dropped them down to 4.84, a step in the right direction at just the third-highest in the league.

- Full Trade: (Dec. 4, 2019) Orioles receive: RHP Isaac Mattson, RHP Kyle Bradish, RHP Kyle Brnovich and RHP Zach Peek. Angels receive: RHP Dylan Bundy
- Friday starter at Winthrop for his junior campaign, leading both Winthrop and the Big South Conference with 91 strikeouts. Also logged eight quality starts.
- Earned a four-inning save in his High-A debut in 2021, despite allowing four runs. Had an 8-1 lead, to still win 8-5. Also struck out seven batters in his four innings.

What They're Saying:

Peek, on offseason improvements: "Before last spring training my offseason goal was to move better with the lower half...move better with the hips. This offseason my goal was to be more rotational into arm path. Last year my arm was climbing a little bit with the elbow so I'd get to a point so then my elbow would come up and then down, so we just worked on smoothing that out to have more of a rotational movement." Notes by Outing ^

- 4/12 at BNG All three runs allowed in just first two innings. After striking out the first batter of the day, allowed a single and two doubles for tow runs, and later a solo home run to Antoine Duplantis in the second inning. After allowing three baserunners in the third inning, retired the final seven batters faced. Was the first Bowie pitcher of the season to complete five innings.
- 4/19 v AKR Allowed a string of three consecutive batters to reach with one out in the first inning, but only one run would score as he would get out of the inning. Would take long breaks on the bench, as Bowie scored eight runs in the first inning, and then four runs in the second inning.
- 4/24 v AKR Struck out three batters over two scoreless innings to start the outing, but allowed three consecutive batters to reach base to start the third, and two runs total. Drew to fly balls and a ground out for a perfect fourth inning to finish the night.
- 4/30 @ RIC Opened with two scoreless innings on all contact, four groundouts and two flyouts. Allowed a run in the third inning on a double, a stolen base, and a wild pitch. Struck out three of the final four batters he faced.
- 5/26 v ERI Allowed a pair of leadoff singles in the first inning, but used a double play to keep a scoreless frame. Allowed a two more singles and a walk in the second inning, and was lifted with two outs at a pitch limit. Reliever allowed a grand slam.
- 6/1 @ ALT Allowed one single in all four innings worked, and eliminated each of the first three singles on double plays
- 6/7 @ HBG Faced the minimum over the first three innings thanks to a caught stealing after a two-out single in the second inning, struck out four batters over the stretch. Allowed a leadoff double in the fourth inning, but Peek caught the runner stealing third base. Only run allowed was a solo home run to Wilson Garcia later in the fourth inning. Garcia would hit four home runs in the seven-game series.
- 6/12 @ HBG Allowed a single on the first pitch thrown, but faced the minimum over his first four innings thanks to a double play, while striking out five batters. Allowed a leadoff double in the fifth inning, but stranded the runner. Only worked one three-ball count.
- 6/18 v BNG Career-high six innings. Allowed a solo home run in the first inning to Ronny Mauricio, but also struck out three batters. Allowed an unearned run on a fielding error in the third inning. Only allowed two baserunners through the end of the game.
- 6/25 @ ERI Used 39 pitches over his first two innings while working scoreless, but only 22 in next two innings. Allowed an unearned run after leadoff batter reached on error in the fifth
