

LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox had their losing skid extend to five-consecutive games on Tuesday night, falling 7-3 to the Hartford Yard Goats in the opener of a six-game series at Prince George's Stadium. Bowie simply could not find any rhythm against Hartford's Noah Davis, who spun a season-high seven innings to win. The only Bowie batter that found good contact was Gunnar Henderson, as the infielder launched two home runs for all of Bowie's offense. Seeming merely human for the first time this season, right-hander Ryan Watson (L, 2-1) Was tagged for four runs in the second inning on five hits, and two unearned runs in the third inning. To go along with Watson's career-high nine hits allowed, the Baysox also committed a season-high four errors while trying to back up the pitchers.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Hartford and Bowie have settled to some very similar numbers over the first six weeks of the season. Entering the series, both teams have scored exactly 155 runs, while Bowie does have a slightly higher ERA, compared to Hartford's 4.40. Hartford has relied plenty on their speed, as they lead the league with 62 stolen bases, despite only having two players with double-digit steals so far this year. Hartford has had to coast on their early offense this season, as their starting pitchers have the third-highest ERA in the league, while their bullpen arms have the second-lowest ERA in the league.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Karl Kauffmann has matured into a key Double-A starter after a rough 2021. While he did go 2-11 with a 7.35 ERA last season, it was still only his first season of pro ball, and the 2019 second round selection out of Michigan has excelled in all but one start this season. In his second go-around with Somerset in late April, Kauffmann was smacked for eight runs on nine hits in five innings. In his three starts to follow, Kauffmann has only allowed three runs in 19 innings, striking out 23, and walking only three. He's a sinker-slider pitcher with a low-90s fastball, that has relied more on his location than on his movement.

POWER PACKED

Bowie has been relying on their home runs recently. In their last three games, bowie has scored seven of their ten runs on home runs. Bowie has scored about 35% of their runs on home runs this season, sitting in the middle of the league.

PATIENCE, YOUNG GRASSHOPPER

Bowie has been frustrating opposing pitchers this season with their patience and discipline at the plate. Their 157 walks lead the Eastern League, despite playing two fewer games than most teams in the circuit. Bowie has also drawn 211 full counts this season, and 88 walks on full counts, both numbers also lead the league. However, Bowie only drew one walk on Tuesday, a season low.

PULL AWAY EARLY

Bowie has ran into plenty of trouble this season in the middle of their games. Bowie has only scored nine runs in the fifth inning all season, the lowest tally in the League. Their -16 run differential in the frame is understandably their worst in any inning this season, and is the worst in the Eastern League in the fifth inning. Things don't get much better in the sixth inning, as Bowie has only scored 15 runs in the sixth, the fifth-fewest, and allowed 28 runs, the most.

TOP GUNNAR

Infielder Gunnar Henderson is on a stellar stretch in May. This month, Gunnar has hit .372 with an 1.165 OPS. He's also drawn ten walks and only struck out nine times. Gunnar has increased his walk rate from just 12.1% across three levels played last season up to over 20% so far this season. Henderson is ranked as the Orioles #3 prospect and Minor League Baseball's #64 overall prospect entering the 2022 season according to MLB Pipeline. Listed as #4 for the Orioles and #57 in MiLB by Baseball America. He was named the Orioles Organization All-Star at third base by MiLB.com for his 2021 season.

SETTLING OUT WEST

Infielder Jordan Westburg got a quick reset with a short vacation out of the top four slots in the lineup. In a 16-game stretch from 4/20-5/10, Westburg was only able to manage a 6-for-59 mark at the plate (.102) with two doubles, one home run, three RBI, three runs scored, eight walks, and 23 strikeouts, all while batting among the first four spots in the lineup. On 5/11, Westburg shifted the fifth spot in the lineup for three games, and has hit 8-for-21 since, with five doubles, one home run, six runs driven in, and four runs scored.

Eight of his first nine appearances were out of the bullpen, but his following 14 appearances to close the season were starts.

- Began his career at Florida State in the bullpen, had begun the transition into a weekend starter for the Seminoles at the urging of his pitching coach when the coronavirus pandemic forced the season to be shut down.
