LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox rolled on into the month of June with more hitting, as they slapped another 12 hits against the Altoona Curve on the way to a 5-3 win on Wednesday night, their fourth-consecutive win. Gunnar Henderson collected three hits for the second-straight day, while every Baysox batter reached base at least once. Zach Peek spun four scoreless innings in his second start since an injured List stint, drawing three double plays in the process. Hudson Haskin, Cesar Prieto, and Cody Roberts all extended their hit-streaks to four-consecutive games, while Andrew Daschbach launched his seventh home run of the season, a solo bomb to left field in the second inning.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Altoona has worked through some of their own injury woes to climb out of an early-season hole. While the Curve opened the season at a 14-19 mark, they've gone 8-4 over their last 12 games, and briefly sitting above .500 before dropping the last two games of their most recent series with Harrisburg. The Curve sit in the middle of many statistical categories in the Eastern League except one, base hits. Entering this series, Altoona has 392 total base hits, nearly 40 more than the team in second place, and it's helped them to the second-most runs in the league, at 230, or 5.1 per game. Their pitching carries an interesting quirk into the series, as Altoona has the second-best bullpen ERA in the league at 3.78, but also the most blown saves in the league, at 12.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Altoona will use an opening pitcher for Thursday's game, sending out right-hander Will Kobos before handing things off to lefty Omar Cruz to take a bulk of the innings. Kobos, who had starting experience before the pandemic, has been used exclusively as a reliever since the start of 2021. The George Washington alum has not allowed a run to cross home in five-consecutive appearances. Cruz was acquired by the Pirates in the Joe Musgrove deal in 2020, and put together strong numbers with Altoona in 2021. This season, he'd been stuttering after a great opening. While Cruz worked a 1.46 ERA over his first four appearances, all in relief, his six appearances since have seen 19 earned runs in just 24 innings, with six home run allowed. Cruz is a fastball/curveball primary attacker, with his overhead curve hovering in the high-70s.

¡BIENVENIDO CÉSAR!

Breakout international prospect César Prieto singled in the ninth inning on Wednesday, and is already hitting .300 in Double-A. When including the tail end of his time with High-A Aberdeen, Prieto has collected hits in 15 of his last 16 games. Ranked as the Orioles #12 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, and the #15 prospect in the Baseball America in-season rankings, Prieto is still in just his first professional season, and played for parts of four seasons in the Cuban National Series, the primary professional league in the country, and most of his career with Elefantes de Cienfuegos in his hometown. In his complete foreign career, he slashed .370/.433/.520 with 11 home runs and 93 runs driven in over 157 games. He opened the year with High-A Aberdeen, and slashed .340/.381/.619 with seven home runs and 20 RBI in 25 games.

SWINGING LOGS AT BEACH BALLS

Bowie has broken through for some of their best contact numbers all season during their current four-game win streak. Bowie has logged 50 hits over their last four games, collecting at least 10 hits in every game. Prior to the current winning streak, Bowie had not collected at least 10 hits in back-to-back games all season.

DASCH-ING THROUGH THE SNOW

Bowie first baseman Andrew Daschbach swatted his seventh home run of the season on Wednesday evening in Altoona. Daschbach hit eight home runs in just 30 games with Bowie at the tail end of 2021, after hitting eight home runs in 75 games with High-A Aberdeen that same season. Plate discipline has been a big improvement for Daschbach, as he only drew 42 walks in 105 total games last season, but is already up to 24 in just 35 games this season. Daschbach was known for his strikeouts in 2021, his 144 strikeouts were the second-most in the Orioles system, behind only Kyle Stowers (171). This season, however, Daschbach is on pace to strike out 186 times, and leads the entire Orioles organization with 61 strikeouts.

What They're Saying:
Baseball America (2021): "Stallings is a polished righthander who mixes his pitches, limits his walks and lasts deep into his starts. His fastball sits 90-92 mph and his short, sharp mid-80s slider is his best secondary offering. Stallings mixes in an average low-80s changeup he commands well and a big, upper-70s curveball he is trying to throw for more strikes early in the count. He has a smooth, up-tempo delivery that is easy to repeat and allows him to command and sequence his four-pitch repertoire effectively. Stallings has a chance to move fast because of his command, advanced feel for pitching and business-like approach. His lack of a plus pitch limits his ceiling to a back-of-the-rotation starter."

Baysox Pitching Coach Josh Conway - Working with Stallings at Aberdeen in 2021: "He's a gamer. As far as the stuff goes, he's not going to blow up the radar gun, but he knows how to use what he's got....He's always in the zone.....a very efficient guy pounding the zone, coming right after you and basically daring you to hit him, which is nice. And he takes his strikeouts as needed. He found himself in a ton of 0-2, 1-2 counts this year, just being ahead of hitters, attacking guys in four pitches or less. Really had that mentality of, 'I'm just going to go right after you.' It was intriguing to see. He did a great job."

Notes by Outing*

- 4/13 @ BNG Allowed three baserunners in the first inning, but no runs across thanks to a double play. Struck out two batters in a perfect second inning, but allowed two runs across in the third on consecutive two-out doubles. Followed with a perfect fourth on a pop out and two ground outs. Bowie had an early three-run home run, Binghamton would tie the game, and Bowie would sneak a run across in the seventh to win.
- 4/20 v AKR Allowed a two-out single to Brayan Rocchio in the first inning, the only hit in the game for Akron. Logged two strikeouts looking in the second inning, part of a string of nine consecutive outs after the single. Allowed a two-out walk in the fourth inning, then again in the fifth inning. Ryan Watson piggybacked with four perfect innings. Tied for the longest scoreless outing of his career.
- 4/26 @ RIC Struck out the first two batters of the game, but allowed a solo home run to Sean Roby. Loaded the bases to start the second inning on a walk, a hit-by-pitch, and an error, but retired the next eight batters and worked a double play to avoid more runs. Bowie was shutout.
- 5/1 @ RIC All four hits given up to Richmond went for extra-bases, and all scored. Double and home run by Frankie Tostado, double by Rob Emery, and 2R HR by Shane Matheny.
- 5/8 v HBG **11th No-Hitter in Bowie Baysox history.** First game of a doubleheader against Harrisburg after rainouts the previous two days. Walked the third batter of the game, and eventually one more walk with one out in the third inning. Retired the last 11 batters faced. Worked eight ground outs, two fly outs, one pop out, and a line out. Morgan McSweeney closed the game with a perfect seventh inning.
- 5/15 @ REA Allowed two early extra-base hits, a one-out triple and two-run home run. Later allowed three singles in the second inning for another run to score. Walked a batter and let up a single in the third inning, but stranded both runners. Used 23 pitches in the first inning, and 30 in the second inning.
- 5/21 v HFD Faced the minimum in the first inning after an error and a double play. Allowed two solo home runs in the third inning, one to Daniel Cope, and one to Ezequiel Tovar. After two more scoreless innings, allowed another solo home run to Tovar in the sixth inning before finishing the sixth.
- 5/27 v ERI Allowed a solo home run to Kerry Carpenter in the first inning, and another to Gage Workman in the second inning. After three scoreless innings, allowed five-consecutive base hits to start the sixth inning, including a three-run home run by Carpenter. Was about to be relieved, but the game entered a rain delay, and was eventually called after just five full innings. First career complete game.

Manager: Kyle Moore
