### LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox were served their fifth shutout loss of the season, and second in just three games on Thursday night, as they fell 5-0 to the Somerset Patriots. Bowie only managed four hits on the day, and only one baserunner reached third base. Just as it had happened in Bowie's shutout loss on Monday, Somerset relied on a gem from their starting pitcher to carry the load. Will Warren (W, 4-2) tossed seven strong frames while allowing just three hits and striking out five batters. The Somerset offense made it a near-polar opposite day for Noah Denoyer on the mound, as the right-hander only collected two outs in the first inning before needing to depart after allowing back-to-back RBI singles to Jesus Bastidas and Rodolfo Duran. Jake Prizina and Adam Stauffer were each hit off at least one run in relief, while Griffin McLarty tossed two scoreless innings to close the night for Bowie.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

Going from one first half winner to the other, the Baysox are on their only trip to New Jersey this season. The Yankees Double-A affiliate has consistently had the best pitching staff in the league, sporting a 3.46 ERA, but it has not been buoyed by any other league-leading marks, such as strikeouts, walks, or hits allowed. The addition of power to the lineup has always been a help for the Patriots, as they enter the series as the only team in the league with over 100 home runs. No individual player has carried the load in full for Somerset, as they have four different players with at least ten home runs. Speed has been critical for their success as well, with two players among the top three for stolen bases in the EL, including Anthony Volpe's league-leading 32.

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

A top-10 prospect in the Yankees system, Luis Medina has been on a slow climb through the minors since being signed out of the Dominican back in 2015. While his first two seasons in the minors were unimpressive, (he did not have a full season with an ERA under 5.00) small physical and mental tweaks have given him some edge back as he's worked into the upper minors. A staple of the Somerset rotation last season, Medina has put up similar rate numbers this season, albeit in fewer innings. He sports a devastating fastball that has hit at 103 MPH previously, contrasted with a hard-breaking curveball, and a changeup.

### NO NEED TO DASCH TO FIRST

First baseman Andrew Daschbach has had a curious relationship with full counts and walks this season. While currently on pace to eclipse his 42 walks from 2021, Daschbach is also on pace to strike out 160 times, nearly 30 more times than 2021, while he currently leads all Orioles minor leaguers in strikeouts. Most interesting of his approach to the plate has been Daschbach's ability to draw a full count. He has worked 50 plate appearances full this season, the tenth-most in the league. He does not have a single base hit on a full count. No other batter among the top 50 for most full counts in the league has gone hitless on full counts.

### JOLTIN' JOEY

Baysox infielder Joey Ortiz has been on a great run to start the month of July. In six games this month, Ortiz has already gone 7-for-23 (.304) at the plate with a double, and has only struck out once. Ortiz was ranked as the Orioles #15 prospect entering the 2022 season according to MLB Pipeline, #16 according to Baseball America. He has already played more games this season than in 2021, due to a torn labrum in his left shoulder in late June.

### FROM THE GET GO

The first inning has always been eventful for Bowie this season, for better or worse. The Baysox have the most pitching strikeouts in the Eastern League in the first inning this season (97), but have allowed the second-most hits (88), and have the fourth-highest ERA (5.54). Bowie also has the second-highest batting average in the league in the first inning (.291) however only the fifth-most runs scored (48).

### I'VE GOT A FEVER, AND THE ONLY PRESCRIPTION IS MORE COWSER

Bowie outfielder Colton Cowser has been steadily warming since his call up to Double-A to start the second half. Cowser went 1-for-3 at the plate on Wednesday with a double. Cowser and fellow Double-A newcomer Connor Norby have combined to go 20-for-57 (.351) at the plate since being promoted. Cowser is ranked as the Orioles #4 prospect and #54 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline at the time of his promotion, and the #6 prospect by Baseball America in its in-season rankings and the #98 overall prospect in the Baseball America preseason rankings.

### HIGH-CONTACT SURFACE

While the Baysox had led the Eastern League in walks drawn for much of the season, they've relinquished it while transitioning into more contact at the plate. Since the start of June, Bowie has only drawn 110 walks at the plate, the third-fewest in the league. However, their 287 hits are the most in the league over the same span, while their 281 strikeouts are the fourth-fewest in the league.

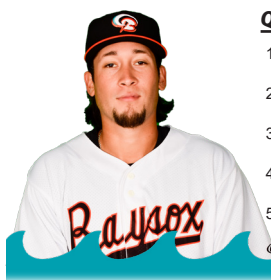

## Notes

- Full trade: Orioles trade RHP Cole Sulser and LHP Tanner Scott to Miami in exchange for OF Kevin Guerrero, LHP Antonio Velez, and a Competitive Balance Round B draft selection
- This is his second season of pro ball after catching on with Miami in 2020 as a reliever. Eight of his first nine appearances were out of the bullpen, but his following 14 appearances to close the season were starts.
- Began his career at Florida State in the bullpen, had begun the transition into a weekend starter for the Seminoles at the urging of his pitching coach when the coronavirus pandemic forced the season to be shut down.
- Earned his promotion to Double-A after silencing opponent for High-A Beloit. Fired 26 innings in four starts, allowing only one run, a solo home run, while striking out 20 batters and only walking two.

## Notes by Outing ^

- Apr 10 v RIC Orioles organizational debut. Only hit allowed was a one-out single in the first inning. Struck out six of his first eight batters faced.
- Apr 17 @ BNG Struck out the side in the first inning (including an auto-strike three on the leadoff batter) When Bowie had jumped to a 4-0 lead, Velez allowed a solo home run in the second inning before tossing a perfect third. Was chased in the fifth inning after allowing five consecutive batters to reach base, as well as four runs, with a two-run home run mixed in by top Mets prospect Francisco Alvarez. All four runs were scored with two outs.
- Apr 23 v AKR Worked heavily on pitching to contact. Only struck out one batter over the first 4.2 innings. Only run over first five innings was due to a leadoff triple followed by a single in the fifth. Only used 38 total pitches over the first five innings. Was the first pitcher for Bowie this season to pitch into the sixth inning, but allowed a string of four hits and a sacrifice fly on the third trip through the order that knocked him out of the game. Spent the game going toe-to-toe with Akron's Daniel Espino while the top Guardians pitching prospect struck out the first 11 batters of the game, and 14 total.
- 4/29 @ RIC Third batter of the game was a two-run home run by Sean Roby, his eighth home run of the season. Velez did not allow another baserunner for the remainder of the outing, aside from one error. Bowie held Richmond to only two hits, but lost 2-1.
- 5/12 @ REA Faced only one over the minimum in first two innings, but labored through a 28-pitch third inning. Allowed a string of five-consecutive batters to reach safely, and a total of five runs to score in the frame.
- 5/18 v HFD Shifted into piggyback role to follow a Major League Rehab start by Dean Kremer. After Kremer threw two scoreless innings, Velez allowed a solo home run to the second batter he faced. Struck out the side in the fourth inning, but allowed another solo home run to the first batter of the fifth inning. Five of the seven hits Velez allowed were extra-base-hits.
- 5/24 v ERI After a scoreless first inning, allowed a two-out solo home run to Gage Workman in the second, and later another solo home run to Dillon Dingler in the third. Rebounded with a scoreless fourth, but was hammered in the fifth with three more home runs, a solo blast by Luis Carpio, and two-run home runs by Kerry Carpenter and Parker Meadows. Previous career high was only two home runs allowed in one game.
- 5/29 v ERI Worked early contact to spin longest scoreless outing. Allowed at least one batter to reach in all five innings, but only one runner reached second base.
- 6/4 @ ALT Allowed a one-out RBI triple and single for two early runs. Allowed a runner into scoring position in each of the next two innings, but worked scoreless. After a perfect fourth inning, allowed a two-run home run in the fifth inning.
- 6/10 @ HBG All three runs allowed were off of Harrisburg INF Alfredo Rodriguez, RBI 2B in 1st, 2RBI 2B in 3rd
