### LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox rallied for their largest comeback win of the season on Thursday night, taking down Binghamton 7-6 after trailing 5-1 just three innings into the night. After Ryan Watson was tagged early, the right-hander held strong for five innings, securing his fourth win of the season, while Conner Loeprich and Shelton Perkins worked strong in relief to maintain the win. Andrew Daschbach continued his strong attack of Binghamton with a two-run home run to open the rally, his third against the Ponies this season. Bowie plated three runs in the fourth inning to take the lead, including RBI from Cesar Prieto, Maverick Handley, and Chris Givin. Greg Cullen went 0-for-4 at the plate, but drove in both the first and last run for Bowie, including the eventual winning run in the sixth inning.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

Binghamton has run into many of the same problems as Bowie in 2022, with games plagued by pitching woes. Entering the series, Binghamton has the highest ERA in the Eastern League, and the only one north of 5.00, at 5.09. The two teams have had inverted issues from their staffs, as Bowie has a worse ERA from their relievers, but Binghamton has had a worse ERA from their starting pitchers. The Ponies have only won consecutive games four times this season and have not won three-consecutive games at any point this season. 20-year-old Francisco Alvarez has been anchoring the offense, as the top Mets prospect has collected five of Binghamton's 10 home runs in the month of June.

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Alex Valverde has been looking for some consistency in his first season in the Mets system after being picked up in the Rule 5 draft from the Tampa Bay Organization. With a trio of long relief outings mixed in to his spot in the rotation, Valverde has allowed at least four runs in over half of his outings so far this season, and has allowed five home runs in just his last three appearances. Valverde did allow a pair of runs to Bowie, including a solo home run to Andrew Daschbach back in April. He can rely on plenty of called strikes, but gives up fly balls extremely often, over 70% of the balls put in play against him are in the air.

### TALK TO ME, GOOSE

Baysox catcher Maverick Handley is flying high lately. Over his last 20 games, Handley has slashed .368/.457/.603 while slugging three home runs, seven doubles, driving in 13 runs, and only striking out 10 times with just as many walks. All three slash lines lead the Baysox among qualified players on the roster.

### NO NEED TO DASCH TO FIRST

First baseman Andrew Daschbach has had a curious relationship with full counts and walks this season. While currently on pace to eclipse his 42 walks from 2021, Daschbach is also on pace to strike out 169 times, nearly 30 more times than 2021. Most interesting of his approach to the plate has been Daschbach's ability to draw a full count. He has worked 42 plate appearances full this season, the seventh-most in the league. He does not have a single base hit on a full count. No other batter among the top 50 for most full counts in the league has gone hitless on full counts.

### SLIM MARGINS

Bowie had an early handle on one-run games this season, as they opened the season at an even 3-3 in games decided by one run, but have only gone 4-11 in one run games since. One run games have been the biggest factor in Bowie's current position in the standings, as their 21 one-run games is the third-most in the league, but their .333 winning percentage in one run games is the worst in the league.

### SWINGING LOGS AT BEACH BALLS

Bowie has broken through lately for some of their best contact numbers all season, as they have logged 155 hits over their last 17 games, the most in the league over the span. Bowie has collected at least 10 hits in nine games during the span, including a stretch of six-consecutive games, tied for the longest team streak in the Eastern League this season, only Somerset has an equal stretch. Prior to this streak, Bowie had not collected at least 10 hits in back-to-back games all season. Prior to the start of the streak, Bowie was averaging about 7.5 hits per game, and have been averaging 9.1 hits per game since the start of the streak.

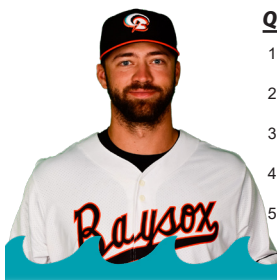

## Notes

- Gained 27 pounds between the start of spring training and Opening Day. "Just eating and lifting. Starting to focus now on making some muscle out of it"
- Picked up tips on his changeup from Orioles starter John Means when Means made a rehab start with Bowie in 2021: "I was kind of like the little kid, just nervous to talk to him. Eventually I got the nuts to ask him about his changeup. He was the nicest, most genuine guy. He told me how he throws it, how he grips it. He was awesome about it."
- Closed 2021 with 13 consecutive scoreless innings for Bowie after allowing at least one earned run in each of his previous seven outings, including all of his outings with Bowie.
- In 2021, Aberdeen averaged eight runs in games Drew appeared in, while Bowie only averaged 5.8 runs in the same games
- Major contributor for manager Kyle Moore with the Delmarva Shorebirds in 2019. Team finished with a 90-48 record, the best in Minor League Baseball. Rom was one of eight Shorebirds named to the South Atlantic League All-Star Game.

## What They're Saying:

**Matt Blood, Orioles Dir. of Player Development:** "He throws a lot of strikes. He's deceptive, he's an uncomfortable at-bat for hitters and he's still pretty young, so we're excited about that."

**MLB Pipeline:** "Lean and projectable, Rom hides the ball well by creating deception with his 6-foot-2 frame. He releases from a three-quarters arm slot and uses his long stride and crossfire finish to create good extension, which allows his pitches to play up and miss barrels consistently. He is comfortable throwing either off-speed pitch in fastball counts as well as mixing up arm angles; he couples this unpredictability with a quick pace and moderate effort delivery that projects durability."

**Baseball America:** "Rom hasn't yet developed a standout pitch, but a varied mix and precocious pitchability have helped him carve up hitters at every level. He experimented with dropping his arm slot against lefties to create different action on his two-seam fastball. Rom knows how the pitches play off one another, and pitches backwards while taking advantage of his deception and angles."

## Notes by Outing

- Apr 8 v RIC Bowie's Opening Day starter, was peppered with base hits over his three innings, six singles. Allowed three single over the first two innings, but did not allow a runner to reach third base. Once he reached the second trip through the order, Richmond started with two singles and two walks to eventually score three runs.
- Apr 14 @ BNG Five shutout frames versus the Ponies, with his only hiccup coming in the second inning, where he allowed a pair of base hits and a walk to load the bases with only one out. Those three baserunners were the only three he allowed all day.
- Apr 21 v AKR Retired 12 of the first 13 batters faced. Only baserunner was a two-out infield single in the first inning. First inning was also hampered by reaching a three-ball count on each of the first three batters. Left midway through the fifth inning after allowing the first three batters to reach on a walk and two singles. Bowie won with a walk-off in the tenth inning.
- Apr 28 @ RIC Gave up a string of five-consecutive base hits with one out in the first inning, allowing three runs to score. Labored through lengthy plate appearances for the following two innings, including stranding the bases loaded in the second inning. Only finished three innings.
- 5/4 v HBG Retired the first eight batters of the game, while striking out three. Allowed a pair of base hits with two outs in the third inning, but stranded both runners and worked a hitless fourth and fifth. In the sixth inning, allowed three singles to load the bases before being lifted from the game, and a wild pitch allowed one of the runners to score.
- 5/25 v ERI First start in three weeks following an IL stint, and was placed on a pitch limit. Allowed a solo home run to Kerry Carpenter in the first inning (Carpenter hit five home runs in the six-game series, and was named EL Player of the Week). Fired a perfect second inning with three contact outs, but allowed a double and a two-run home run with one out in the third inning before being lifted.
- 5/31 @ ALT Allowed an unearned run in the first inning after a leadoff single. Allowed two one-out singles in the second inning before rattling off seven-consecutive outs, including five of his six strikeouts. Lifted in the fourth inning after allowing a two-out double and RBI single.
- 6/5 @ ALT Lone run scored on a double, wild pitch, and sacrifice fly in the second inning. Allowed at least one hit in all four innings.
- 6/11 @ HBG Was set to finish an 11-pitch first inning, but a two-out error extended the inning, and he eventually allowed the run to score while needing 17 more pitches. Worked scoreless the rest of the way.

### Manager: Kyle Moore

He played three seasons with the Cubs organization, making it to Double- A in 2016. The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
