#### LAST GAME

What started as a breath of fresh air for Bowie, they had hit it big with three runs in the second inning to take a two-run lead. It ended in a fourth-straight loss for the Baysox, however, in extra innings against the Erie SeaWolves. While Erie did jump to the early lead on Kerry Carpenter's 13th home run of the season, a solo shot in the first inning, Bowie leap-frogged with a pair of two-out RBI doubles in the second inning to plate three runs. Erie used three runs in the top of the third to jump back ahead, but Erie tied the game with another two-out RBI double in the fifth inning, and the game stayed tied at four into the tenth inning. Erie took the lead for good in the extra frame with consecutive RBI singles, while Bowie was held to only one hit over their last four innings.

#### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The SeaWolves have been starting to piece things together. After a 2-6 stretch starting on 5/8, Erie strung together four-consecutive wins against New Hampshire in their most recent series. The SeaWolves have been heavily reliant on their pitching staff this season, and their 3.50 team ERA entering this series is the second-best in the Eastern League. Most of the damage is done by their starting rotation as well, with a league-leading 2.61 ERA, along with 213 strikeouts from starters. Offensively, Erie's plate discipline has been middle of the road, as they sit in the middle of the league in home runs, while only drawing the third-fewest walks, and striking out the second-most times.

#### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Reese Olson is in his first full season as a Tigers farmhand after being traded over from the Brewers organization in 2021 in exchange for big league lefty Daniel Norris. After five starts with Erie at the tail end of 2021, Olson has blown by opposing batters in his eight starts with the SeaWolves this season. In his eight starts with Erie this year, Olson has struck out at least seven batters in four of them, including back-to-back double-digit strikeouts performances entering his start today. He's got a four-pitch mix with a mid-90s fastball, a heavy fading changeup, as well as a slider and a curveball.

#### TOP GUNNAR

Infielder Gunnar Henderson is on a stellar stretch in May. This month, Gunnar has hit .344 with an 1.101 OPS. He's also drawn 37 walks and only struck out 27 times. Gunnar has increased his walk rate from just 12.1% across three levels played last season up to over 20% so far this season. Henderson is ranked as the Orioles #3 prospect and Minor League Baseball's #64 overall prospect entering the 2022 season according to MLB Pipeline. Listed as #4 for the Orioles and #57 in MiLB by Baseball America. He was named the Orioles Organization All-Star at third base by MiLB.com for his 2021 season.

#### TALK TO ME, GOOSE

Had to make a least one joke about it this season. Baysox catcher Maverick Handley is flying high lately. Handley currently sports the highest batting average by a Baysox player over their last ten games. Handley has gone 11-for-34 (.324) in his last 10 games for the Baysox, with two doubles, a home run, and four each of RBI, runs scored, walks, and strikeouts.

#### GET 'EM ON, GET 'EM OVER, FORGOT THE LAST ONE

The Baysox left another 11 runners on base in Wednesday's game, behind ten hits and three walks at the plate. It was the fifth Bowie loss this season when they out-hit their opponent, and continued a tough trend of leaving runners on base. Bowie has stranded at least 7 runners on base in each of their last four games. They lead the league 299 total runners left on base this season, an average of about 7.7 per game.

#### WAIT, HOW DOES THAT HAPPEN?

While the Baysox do lead the league with 299 runners left on base this season, they surprisingly have the second-highest on-base percentage and OPS with two outs in the league this season. Bowie sports a .333 OBP and a .719 OPS with two outs this year, which is mostly buoyed by their walk numbers, as Bowie only has just a .227 batting average with two outs, only the sixth-highest mark in the league.

## Notes by Outing

4/12 at BNG All three runs allowed in just first two innings. After striking out the first batter of the day, allowed a single and two doubles for tow runs, and later a solo home run to Antoine Duplantis in the second inning. After allowing three baserunners in the third inning, retired the final seven batters faced. Was the first Bowie pitcher of the season to complete five innings.

4/19 v AKR Allowed a string of three consecutive batters to reach with one out in the first inning, but only one run would score as he would get out of the inning. Would take long breaks on the bench, as Bowie scored eight runs in the first inning, and then four runs in the second inning.

4/24 v AKR Struck out three batters over two scoreless innings to start the outing, but allowed three consecutive batters to reach base to start the third, and two runs total. Drew to fly balls and a ground out for a perfect fourth inning to finish the night.

4/30 @ RIC Opened with two scoreless innings on all contact, four groundouts and two flyouts. Allowed a run in the third inning on a double, a stolen base, and a wild pitch. Struck out three of the final four batters he faced.

## Coaching Staff

### Manager: Kyle Moore

The 2022 season will be the 13th season for Moore in the Orioles organization. He played 29 games over two seasons (2010-11) before becoming a coach. He played three seasons with the Cubs organization, making it to Double-A in 2016. The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
