LAST GAME

Bowie slugged another trio of home runs to double up their perfect start to the second half, taking down Richmond for the second-consecutive night, a 12-1 final on Wednesday. After Richmond had struck Ryan Watson for an early run with two outs in the first inning, the right-hander shut down the next 15-consecutive batters, earning the win behind the first six-inning performance of his career. Bowie jumped ahead in the third inning after loading the bases against Squirrels starter Matt Frisbee, when Cesar Prieto lined his first career grand slam to right-center field. The onslaught continued against the Richmond pen in the fifth inning, as Bowie plated seven additional runs, including a three-run home run by J.D. Mundy. Mundy went yard for the second time in the seventh inning, a solo blast for his third career multi-home run game.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Richmond enters this series flying high, having punched their way into the playoffs for the first time since 2014. A tiebreak atop the Southwest Division gave Richmond the first half berth thanks to their head-to-head record over Akron. The Squirrels had an excellent June going 15-8 with a 2.66 staff ERA in the month, both marks topping the Eastern League, while they only lost consecutive games once during the month. Despite playing in one of the most pitcher-friendly parks in the Eastern League, Richmond has done plenty of their damage with home runs. Their .228 batting average is the second-lowest in the Eastern League, but their 89 home runs are the second-most. Entering the series, Richmond has already won seven of the nine meetings between these two clubs.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Just in his second professional season, Ryan Murphy did not get his 2022 underway until mid-May due to nagging back spasms, but it did not stop the high-ranking Giants prospect from attacking High-A batters to quickly earn his promotion. Murphy went 1-0 with a 2.90 for the Eugene Emeralds, striking out 47 batters in just 31 innings. Drafted in the fifth round of the 2020 draft from Division 2 Le Moyne College (the same school as Washington Nationals starter Josiah Gray), Murphy attacks hitters with his well-located low-90s fastball that can break slightly both in and out, as well as a slider, a changeup, and a curveball.

SWINGING LOGS AT BEACH BALLS

Bowie has broken through lately for some of their best contact numbers all season. Bowie's 255 total hits in the month of June leads the Eastern League. Bowie has collected at least ten hits in nine games during the month. Bowie has notched 10 or more hits in back-to-back games three times this month, having not done it in back-to-back games all season.

MUNDY MASH

Bowie first baseman J.D. Mundy may be coming into form. After hitting only one home run in a span of 32 games played from 5/4-6/24, he has three home runs in his last two games, including his third career multi-HR game on Wednesday. Named the Orioles Organization All-Star at first base by MiLB.com for his 2021 season, this is still Mundy's first season of Double-A action, as he was promoted to Bowie in 2021, but missed the final month of the year due to a fractured thumb in mid-August, and did not appear in a game for the Baysox. His .536 SLG in 2021 was the best in the Orioles system among players with at least 300 PA.

SOOTHING RELIEF

Bowie has had their ups and downs with work out of their bullpen, as their 4.67 ERA from relievers is still the highest in the Eastern League, but they've been getting strong performances from the bullpen lately. Over their last seven games, Bowie relievers have only allowed only three earned runs in 26.1 innings, a respectable 1.03 ERA

FIELD GENERALS

Thanks to Cody Roberts and Maverick Handley, Bowie has had the most feared backstops in the league. While Roberts may currently be on the Taxi Squad for Baltimore, his numbers still anchor Bowie's CS% of 42%, the highest mark in the league. Additionally, Bowie has only allowed 33 stolen bases this season, the second-fewest in the minors.

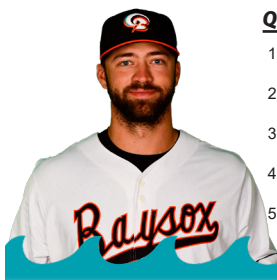

- Picked up tips on his changeup from Orioles starter John Means when Means made a rehab start with Bowie in 2021: "I was kind of like the little kid, just nervous to talk to him. Eventually I got the nuts to ask him about his changeup. He was the nicest, most genuine guy. He told me how he throws it, how he grips it. He was awesome about it."
- Closed 2021 with 13 consecutive scoreless innings for Bowie after allowing at least one earned run in each of his previous seven outings, including all of his outings with Bowie.
- In 2021, Aberdeen averaged eight runs in games Drew appeared in, while Bowie only averaged 5.8 runs in the same games
- Major contributor for manager Kyle Moore with the Delmarva Shorebirds in 2019. Team finished with a 90-48 record, the best in Minor League Baseball. Rom was one of eight Shorebirds named to the South Atlantic League All-Star Game.

What They're Saying:

Matt Blood, Orioles Dir. of Player Development: "He throws a lot of strikes. He's deceptive, he's an uncomfortable at-bat for hitters and he's still pretty young, so we're excited about that."

MLB Pipeline: "Lean and projectable, Rom hides the ball well by creating deception with his 6-foot-2 frame. He releases from a three-quarters arm slot and uses his long stride and crossfire finish to create good extension, which allows his pitches to play up and miss barrels consistently. He is comfortable throwing either off-speed pitch in fastball counts as well as mixing up arm angles; he couples this unpredictability with a quick pace and moderate effort delivery that projects durability."

Baseball America: "Rom hasn't yet developed a standout pitch, but a varied mix and precocious pitchability have helped him carve up hitters at every level. He experimented with dropping his arm slot against lefties to create different action on his two-seam fastball. Rom knows how the pitches play off one another, and pitches backwards while taking advantage of his deception and angles."
