LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox were handed their second-consecutive one-run loss on Thursday night, and their 16th of the season as they fell just short to the Erie SeaWolves 3-2. Bowie once again struck in the first inning, but a key trio of hits for the SeaWolves in the fifth broke a 1-1 tie, ruining Bowie's chances. Ahead early after a pair of leadoff base hits and an RBI grounder by Cody Roberts, Bowie was held without by Wilmer Flores after that, as Flores eventually finished five innings while striking out seven batters. Ryan Watson climbed the hill for Bowie, but was unable to hold the early 1-0 lead given to him, as Andre Lipcius drilled an 0-2 pitch to dead center field in the first inning for a solo home run to tie the game. With one out in the bottom of the fifth, Chris Rabago tripled to left field to drive in a run, and Gage Workman singled to bring in Rabago, putting Erie ahead 3-1. Zach Watson cut into the lead in the sixth inning when he drilled an opposite field solo home run off of Adam Wolf, but it would turn out to be the last Bowie run.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The final week of the first half is an important one for the SeaWolves, as they hope to overcome a scant two-game deficit in the Southwest Division to clinch their first berth in the Eastern League playoffs since 2013. While much of their offense has been league-average, their numbers are carried heavily by early MVP candidate Kerry Carpenter, as the outfielder leads all of Minor League Baseball with 22 home runs, a number that trails only Aaron Judge's 25 among all of baseball. Carpenter hit five home runs against Bowie in May, and 13 total in the month of May. As a staff, Erie has put together some of the best pitching numbers in the league, including the fewest walks allowed, and the second-best ERA. Their starting rotation has been the best in the league, with a 3.07 ERA.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Chance Kirby has been on a slow climb up in the Tigers organization after being drafted out of UTSA in 2018. A mid-season callup to Double-A in 2021, Kirby was handled mostly relief roles with Erie to start this season, but shifted back into the rotation around mid-May, with no change to his numbers. Currently holding the league's best ERA, Kirby has gone 3-1 with a 2.65 ERA when working as a starter, including a five inning scoreless performance against the Baysox last month. After being tagged for five runs in five innings by Richmond on June 8, Kirby has only allowed one run and four hits over his following 10 innings of work.

HASKIN HAMMERS EARLY

Outfielder Hudson Haskin has made the most starts for Bowie at the top of the lineup this season, and his numbers have benefited from that. Haskin owns a 1.000 OPS when stepping up as the first batter in an inning, and has 10 extra-base hits in his 70 plate appearances to lead off an inning. Of his eight home runs this season, four have been at the start of an inning.

SHUTOUT STATISTICS

Drew Rom and Noah Denoyer combined to toss Bowie's sixth shutout of the season on Friday. Shutouts have comprised nearly one quarter of Bowie's wins this season (6/26, 23%) and has them nearly on pace to match their shutout total from 2021. Bowie tossed 13 shutouts in 2021, while the number was reached in only 120 games, 18 fewer games than scheduled in 2022.

NO NEED TO DASCH TO FIRST

First baseman Andrew Daschbach has had a curious relationship with full counts and walks this season. While currently on pace to eclipse his 42 walks from 2021, Daschbach is also on pace to strike out 163 times, nearly 30 more times than 2021. Most interesting of his approach to the plate has been Daschbach's ability to draw a full count. He has worked 48 plate appearances full this season, the fifth-most in the league. He does not have a single base hit on a full count. No other batter among the top 50 for most full counts in the league has gone hitless on full counts.

FIELD GENERALS

Erie picked the right moments to strike on the basepaths against Bowie's catchers on Thursday, becoming the first team all season to steal three bases in a single game. Bowie's CS% of 42% from their catchers is the highest mark in the league. Additionally, Bowie has only allowed 32 stolen bases this season, the second-fewest in the minors.

- Initially drafted by the Angels in the sixth round of the 2019 draft out of Winthrop, but did not appear in a game for the organization before being dealt to Baltimore
- Full Trade: (Dec. 4, 2019) Orioles receive: RHP Isaac Mattson, RHP Kyle Bradish, RHP Kyle Brnovich and RHP Zach Peek. Angels receive: RHP Dylan Bundy
- Friday starter at Winthrop for his junior campaign, leading both Winthrop and the Big South Conference with 91 strikeouts. Also logged eight quality starts.
- Earned a four-inning save in his High-A debut in 2021, despite allowing four runs. Had an 8-1 lead, to still win 8-5. Also struck out seven batters in his four innings.

What They're Saying:

Peek, on offseason improvements: "Before last spring training my offseason goal was to move better with the lower half....move better with the hips. This offseason my goal was to be more rotational into arm path. Last year my arm was climbing a little bit with the elbow so I'd get to a point so then my elbow would come up and then down, so we just worked on smoothing that out to have more of a rotational movement." Notes by Outing ^

- 4/12 at BNG All three runs allowed in just first two innings. After striking out the first batter of the day, allowed a single and two doubles for tow runs, and later a solo home run to Antoine Duplantis in the second inning. After allowing three baserunners in the third inning, retired the final seven batters faced. Was the first Bowie pitcher of the season to complete five innings.
- 4/19 v AKR Allowed a string of three consecutive batters to reach with one out in the first inning, but only one run would score as he would get out of the inning. Would take long breaks on the bench, as Bowie scored eight runs in the first inning, and then four runs in the second inning.
- 4/24 v AKR Struck out three batters over two scoreless innings to start the outing, but allowed three consecutive batters to reach base to start the third, and two runs total. Drew to fly balls and a ground out for a perfect fourth inning to finish the night.
- 4/30 @ RIC Opened with two scoreless innings on all contact, four groundouts and two flyouts. Allowed a run in the third inning on a double, a stolen base, and a wild pitch. Struck out three of the final four batters he faced.
- 5/26 v ERI Allowed a pair of leadoff singles in the first inning, but used a double play to keep a scoreless frame. Allowed a two more singles and a walk in the second inning, and was lifted with two outs at a pitch limit. Reliever allowed a grand slam.
- 6/1 @ ALT Allowed one single in all four innings worked, and eliminated each of the first three singles on double plays
- 6/7 @ HBG Faced the minimum over the first three innings thanks to a caught stealing after a two-out single in the second inning, struck out four batters over the stretch. Allowed a leadoff double in the fourth inning, but Peek caught the runner stealing third base. Only run allowed was a solo home run to Wilson Garcia later in the fourth inning. Garcia would hit four home runs in the seven-game series.
- 6/12 @ HBG Allowed a single on the first pitch thrown, but faced the minimum over his first four innings thanks to a double play, while striking out five batters. Allowed a leadoff double in the fifth inning, but stranded the runner. Only worked one three-ball count.
- 6/18 v BNG Career-high six innings. Allowed a solo home run in the first inning to Ronny Mauricio, but also struck out three batters. Allowed an unearned run on a fielding error in the third inning. Only allowed two baserunners through the end of the game.

He played three seasons with the Cubs organization, making it to Double-A in 2016. The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
