LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox opened their seven-game series with the Harrisburg Senators strong on Tuesday night, cruising to a 6-1 win at FNB Field. Bowie pitching held the Senators to only five hits, while allowing only one walk. It was the first game for Bowie in June decided by more than two runs. Bowie plated two runs in the fifth inning on back-to-back RBI knocks by Joey Ortiz and Greg Cullen, and broke through for four more runs in the seventh inning on an RBI double by Cullen, and a three-run home run by Andrew Daschbach, his eighth of the season. Zach Peek tossed four innings on the mound for Bowie while striking out a season-high six batters, while Clayton McGinness earned the win in his Double-A debut with a scoreless fifth inning. Conner Loeprich put together his best outing of the season by piecing together four scoreless innings, allowing only one baserunner to earn the save.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The first month of 2022 belonged to Harrisburg, as the Senators held the top spot in the Southwest Division for most of April, but have not found much success since. After opening the season at 12-9, they have gone 9-20 entering this week at FNB Field. Most of Harrisburg's struggles have been at the plate, as their 209 runs scored (4.3/G) is the third-fewest in the league. Harrisburg makes plenty of contact to run their offense, as they have the second-fewest strikeouts at the plate, and the fewest walks drawn in the league. The back end of this road trip could be a good lift for Bowie, as Harrisburg is only 9-15 at home at the start of this series, the second-lowest winning percentage in the league.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Game one will see right-hander Franklyn Kilome will get the nod for Harrisburg. No stranger to the league, Kilome is with his third different EL team, after originally starting his career with the Phillies organization. He went 5-9 over two seasons with Reading, before being traded to the Mets in the Asdrubal Cabrera deal. With Binghamton in 2018, Kilome went 0-3 with a 4.03 ERA in seven starts. He made his major league debut with the Mets in 2020, going just 0-1 in relief with an ERA north of 10. After spending all of 2021 with Triple-A Syracuse, Kilome elected free agency and signed with Washington at the end of April. After a brief ramp-up, Kilome made his Harrisburg debut in late May, and has fired 12 innings, allowed five earned runs, and struck out 13 batters. His fastball hovers in the mid-90s and can reach a bit higher at points, while also dipping into his curveball and slider often. He also has a changeup.

SWINGING LOGS AT BEACH BALLS

Bowie has broken through for some of their best contact numbers all season, as they have logged 71 hits over their current road trip, the most in the league over the span. Bowie has collected at least 10 hits in seven of their last nine games, including a stretch of six-consecutive games, tied for the longest team streak in the Eastern League this season, only Somerset has an equal stretch. Prior to this streak, Bowie had not collected at least 10 hits in back-to-back games all season.

¡BIENVENIDO CÉSAR!

Breakout international prospect César Prieto singled up the middle in the seventh inning of Tuesday's game extending his hit streak to a team-long eight consecutive games. When including the tail end of his time with High-A Aberdeen, Prieto has collected hits in 20 of his last 21 games. Ranked as the Orioles #12 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, and the #15 prospect in the Baseball America in-season rankings, Prieto is still in just his first professional season, and played for parts of four seasons in the Cuban National Series, the primary professional league in the country, and most of his career with Elefantes de Cienfuegos in his hometown. In his complete foreign career, he slashed .370/.433/.520 with 11 home runs and 93 runs driven in over 157 games. He opened the year with High-A Aberdeen, and slashed .340/.381/.619 with seven home runs and 20 RBI in 25 games.

FIELD GENERALS

Bowie's catchers have been a strong asset this season. Bowie's CS% of 45% from their catchers is the highest mark in the league. Additionally, Bowie has only allowed 23 stolen bases this season, the fewest in the minors.

NO-NO? YES-YES!

There's already some positive precedent for Garrett Stallings starting a doubleheader game against Harrisburg. Garrett Stallings and Morgan McSweeney joined Baysox history on Sunday, May 8, combining for the team's 11th No-Hitter, a seven-inning win over Harrisburg. Of Bowie's 11 No-Hitters in franchise history, five of them have now been thrown against Harrisburg. Expanding on the coincidence of the beltway affiliates, each of Bowie's last four no-hitters, stretching back to 2007, have all been against the Senators.

Career Notes

- In 2021, led the Wind Surge in strikeouts (130), second in starts (21) and third in innings pitched (91.0 IP). Finished second in the league in strikeouts. Struck out eight-plus batters in seven different outings, including a season-high of nine three times: June 11 at Tulsa, June 27 at Midland and September 1 at Arkansas.
- Pitched three seasons at Mercyhurst College (PA), going 21-8 with a 2.54 ERA (166.2 IP, 47 ER), 268 strikeouts and 75 walks in 36 games (25 starts).

What They're Saying:

Baseball America: "His fastball sits in the 92-93 mph range and has been up to 95-96, and analysts love the metrics beyond the velocity, especially the extreme carry and vertical break of the offering. His go-to secondary and most effective pitch this year was a mid-80s slider with spin in the 2,500 rpm range and solid sweeping action. The 6-foot-5 righty also throws an upper-70s curveball and a low-80s changeup. All his offerings have average or a tick better potential, but he needs to take a big step forward with the consistency of his command against upper-level bats. The Twins have developed Vallimont as a starter, and he has a deep arsenal and the physical frame, but his control might make him a better fit for the pen, where perhaps his velocity could tick up."

BOWIE BAYSOX GAME NOTES

What They're Saying:

Baseball America (2021): "Stallings is a polished righthander who mixes his pitches, limits his walks and lasts deep into his starts. His fastball sits 90-92 mph and his short, sharp mid-80s slider is his best secondary offering. Stallings mixes in an average low-80s changeup he commands well and a big, upper-70s curveball he is trying to throw for more strikes early in the count. He has a smooth, up-tempo delivery that is easy to repeat and allows him to command and sequence his four-pitch repertoire effectively. Stallings has a chance to move fast because of his command, advanced feel for pitching and business-like approach. His lack of a plus pitch limits his ceiling to a back-of-the-rotation starter."

Baysox Pitching Coach Josh Conway - Working with Stallings at Aberdeen in 2021: "He's a gamer. As far as the stuff goes, he's not going to blow up the radar gun, but he knows how to use what he's got....He's always in the zone.....a very efficient guy pounding the zone, coming right after you and basically daring you to hit him, which is nice. And he takes his strikeouts as needed. He found himself in a ton of 0-2, 1-2 counts this year, just being ahead of hitters, attacking guys in four pitches or less. Really had that mentality of, 'I'm just going to go right after you.' It was intriguing to see. He did a great job."

Notes by Outing*

- 4/13 @ BNG Allowed three baserunners in the first inning, but no runs across thanks to a double play. Struck out two batters in a perfect second inning, but allowed two runs across in the third on consecutive two-out doubles. Followed with a perfect fourth on a pop out and two ground outs. Bowie had an early three-run home run, Binghamton would tie the game, and Bowie would sneak a run across in the seventh to win.
- 4/20 v AKR Allowed a two-out single to Brayan Rocchio in the first inning, the only hit in the game for Akron. Logged two strikeouts looking in the second inning, part of a string of nine consecutive outs after the single. Allowed a two-out walk in the fourth inning, then again in the fifth inning. Ryan Watson piggybacked with four perfect innings. Tied for the longest scoreless outing of his career.
- 4/26 @ RIC Struck out the first two batters of the game, but allowed a solo home run to Sean Roby. Loaded the bases to start the second inning on a walk, a hit-by-pitch, and an error, but retired the next eight batters and worked a double play to avoid more runs. Bowie was shutout.

Manager: Kyle Moore
