ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 8-0 at Modern Woodmen Park.](#)

Zavier Warren and Ethan Murray both drove in three runs and Justin Bullock allowed two hits over six scoreless innings for the win. The Timber Rattlers have won three of their last four games.

THE SCORING: Murray gave the Timber Rattlers a 1-0 lead with an RBI double in the top of the fourth inning. Warren followed with an RBI triple. Jose Acosta made it 3-0 with an RBI single. Murray added a two-out, two-run double in the fifth inning for a 5-0 lead. Warren knocked in two runs with a double and Acosta capped the scoring with an RBI grounder in the seventh.

TRIPLE DECKER: Warren had two triples and a double last night. Those were his first two triples of the season. Warren became the second Rattler with two triples in a game this season. Tristan Peters accomplished the feat at Quad Cities on May 12. Joe Gray Jr added a triple last night, too. The Rattlers also had three triples in that game on May 12 against the River Bandits.

QUALITY IS JOB ONE: Bullock earned his first win with the Rattlers this season. He walked one and struck out four over his six innings to earn a quality start. The only Quad Cities hits last night were a single by Cam Williams in the third and a two-out single by Peyton Wilson in the sixth.

PERFECT RELIEF: Robbie Baker and Ryan Middendorf combined to pitch three perfect innings in relief to close out the game. Baker pitched the seventh and eighth with three strikeouts. Middendorf, in his Timber Rattlers debut, retired Quad Cities in order in the ninth with two strikeouts. Last night was the sixth shutout of the season for the Timber Rattlers pitching staff and their second in the last four games.

STILL SAFE: The longest streak of games with multiple hits by a Rattler since 2005 was set by Blake Allemand, who had nine straight games with at least two hits. Allemand was 22-for-38 from May 26 through June 3 during the 2016 season.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo from 1969-1976, Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) puts five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jackson Chourio (#1), Joe Gray Jr. (#15), Russell Smith (#17), Xavier Warren (#18), and Taylor Floyd (#24). Tyler Black (#7) and Carlos Rodriguez (#22) are on the Wisconsin injured list. [MLB Pipeline](#) has five current River Bandits on their Top 30 list of Royals prospects: Beck Way (#12), Peyton Wilson (#13), Luca Tresh (#24), Diego Hernandez (#29), and Chandler Champlain (#30).

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ISRAEL PUELLO: Acquired by Milwaukee as a player to be named later from in a trade that sent David Phelps to the Philadelphia Phillies on August 31, 2020. Puella, Juan Geraldo, and Brandon Ramey were announced at the PTBNL on September 18, 2020.

ORIGIN STORY: Puella was signed by the Phillies out of the Dominican Republic on July 2, 2017.

FIGHTIN' PHIL: Puella pitched two seasons (2018 and 2019) for the Phillies White affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He went 4-6 with a 4.52 ERA in fourteen starts in 2018 and 2-1 with a 1.92 ERA in fifteen starts in 2019. Puella had 143 strikeouts over 131-1/3 innings pitched. Puella was named a DSL All-Star in 2019.

WHAT'S BREWING? Puella was 1-4 with a 4.94 ERA in ten starts for the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League in 2021. He walked nine and struck out 37 over 27-1/3 innings pitched.

SWEET CAROLINA: Puella was 3-7 in thirteen games – six starts – with a 5.51 ERA and 61 strikeouts over 49 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats before joining the Timber Rattlers on June 28. Puella was 0-2 in four games – two starts in June...BUT, he had a 3.38 ERA, opponents were hitting just .192 against him, and he had sixteen strikeouts over sixteen innings in June.

LAST START: Puella [lost to Cedar Rapids at home on July 28](#). He allowed five runs on five hits with six walks and five strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Puella has never faced the River Bandits prior to this evening. He made the start against Columbia, the Carolina League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals, [on June 15](#). Puella allowed a run on three hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over five innings and was charged with the loss.

QUAD CITIES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN: The Kansas City Royals acquired Champlain in a trade with the New York Yankees on July 27, 2022. Kansas City sent Andrew Benintendi to New York in exchange for Champlain, Beck Way, and TJ Sikkema. Champlain is now the #30 prospect in the Royals system according to MLB Pipeline.

LIKE THE LAKE? The Yankees selected Champlain in the ninth round of the 2021 draft out of the University of Southern California.

TROJAN HORSE: Champlain was 4-4 with a 5.06 ERA in fifteen starts in his final season at USC. He walked 22 and struck out 69 over 74-2/3 innings pitched during the 2021 college season. Champlain did not pitch professionally after signing with the Yankees.

GONE FISHING: Champlain made his professional debut with the Tampa Tarpons in the Florida State League this year. He was 2-5 with a 4.30 ERA in sixteen games – fifteen starts. Champlain had 94 strikeouts and twenty walks over 74-1/3 innings pitched with Tampa before the trade.

LAST START: Champlain had a no decision for Tampa in a game against Lakeland [on July 23](#). He pitched a scoreless, hitless first inning with a strikeout. Champlain was removed from the game after a lightning delay halted play in the bottom of the first inning for almost two hours.

LAST APPEARANCE: Champlain made his Quad Cities debut with a scoreless inning as a reliever at Beloit on [July 31](#). He walked one and struck out one without allowing a hit in that game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Champlain has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
