ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Cedar Rapids Kernels 7-6 at Neuroscience Group Field. Jackson Chourio and Zavier Warren each homered for the Rattlers while Joey Matulovich and James Meeker combined for five hitless, scoreless innings out of the bullpen to help the Rattlers get their second straight win.

BAKER'S DOZEN: Wisconsin and Cedar Rapids combined for twelve runs in the first two innings. The Kernels scored twice in the first. The Rattlers scored five times in their half of the first. Cedar Rapids scored four runs in the top of the second. Wisconsin tied the game with a run in the bottom of the second. Tristan Peters broke the tie with an RBI single in the fourth inning. The Kernels didn't have a hit after the second.

TOUGH START...BUT STILL: Antoine Kelly allowed six runs on six hits with four walks and six strikeouts over four innings last night. He allowed home runs to Yunior Severino and Aaron Sabato. Kelly has run his season strikeout total to 119 and he is second in High-A in that category. Only teammate Justin Jarvis (120) has more strikeouts this season at this classification.

PETERS PRINCIPLE: Peters had two doubles, a single, an RBI, and a run scored for the Timber Rattlers last night. Peters has at least two hits in each of his last six games and is 13-for-24 during the streak. This matches the longest multi-hit streak in the Midwest League this season. Jorbit Vivas of the Great Lakes Loons, who had a six-game multi-hit streak from May 17 through May 22.

SOMETHING TO SHOOT FOR: The longest streak of games with multiple hits by a Rattler since 2005 was set by Blake Allemand, who had nine straight games with at least two hits. Allemand was 22-for-38 from May 26 through June 3 during the 2016 season.

CHOURIO UPDATE: Chourio, the Milwaukee Brewers #1 prospect, went 2-for-4 with a homer and three RBI scored last night. He has at least one hit in all five games with Wisconsin and is on a nine-game hitting streak that started with his final four games at Carolina.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins – including 2022. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jackson Chourio (#1), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), and Taylor Floyd (#23). Tyler Black (#7) and Carlos Rodríguez (#21) are on the Wisconsin injured list. # WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP RUSSELL SMITH:** Selected by the Brewers in the second round (51st overall selection) of the 2021 draft out of Texas Christian University. He is rated as he #16 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline.

**AREA CODE:** Smith was picked as the Most Outstanding Player at the Area Code Games in 2016. He was also a four-year letter winner at Midlothian (TX) High School.

NO, CUBS, NO: The Chicago Cubs picked Smith in the  $38^{th}$  round of the 2017 draft. He elected to honor a commitment to TCU.

**HORNED FROGS:** Smith was 7-3 with a 3.83 ERA in fifteen starts during his final season at TCU. He had 101 strikeouts in 82-1/3 innings pitched that season

MISSING TIME: Smith missed the 2019 season due to Tommy John Surgery and most of the 2020 season due to the pandemic shutdown.

**LAST START:** Smith had a <u>no decision against Cedar Rapids on July 26</u> at home. He allowed three runs on two hits with three walks and no strikeouts over six innings. Smith left the game with the Rattlers leading 4-3, but the Kernels rallied for a 10-4 win.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Smith has made three starts against the Kernels this season. He lost at Cedar Rapids on May 26 and had a no decisions at home on July 2 and on July 26. Smith has allowed eight runs on nine hits with five walks and nine strikeouts over 15-2/3 innings versus Cedar Rapids this season.

# CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ORLANDO RODRIGUEZ: The Minnesota Twins signed Rodriguez as a Minor League Free Agent on July 13, 2021.

**NO DOUBTING THOMAS:** Rodriguez pitched three seasons for St. Thomas University, an NAIA school in Miami Gardens, Florida. He was 25-3 with 238 strikeouts in 194 innings pitched over his final two seasons with the Bobcats.

INDEPENDENCE DAYS: Rodriguez made two starts for the Schaumberg Flyers in the independent Frontier League before he signed with the Cincinnati Reds on July 6, 2019. He went 0-3 in ten games – eight starts – with 49 strikeouts over 36-2/3 innings with Billings after signing with Cincinnati.

**SET ADRIFT:** The Reds released Rodriguez on June 1, 2020. He found a spot with the Sugar Land Lightning Sloths of the Constellation Energy League and was 1-3 with a 10.38 ERA in eleven games – five starts. Rodriguez went back to Schaumberg for the 2021 season and went 4-1 with a 2.44 ERA in eight starts. He signed with the Twins on July 13, 2021.

**TWIN TIME:** Rodriguez made one start in the Florida Complex League and appeared in four games with two starts for Fort Myers in the Florida State League after signing with Minnesota. He was 1-1 with a 4.15 ERA, seven walks, and 23 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings for Fort Myers.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Rodriguez was the <u>winning pitcher in relief</u> <u>against the Timber Rattlers on July 26</u>. He allowed three hits, walked none, and struck out two over two scoreless innings.

LAST START: Rodriguez lost to Daytona as the starter Fort Myers on July 24, 2021. He allowed two runs on five hits with three walks and seven strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Rodriguez has made four relief appearances against the Timber Rattlers this season. He is 1-1 and has allowed four runs on six hits with six walks and five strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings.
