ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Cedar Rapids Kernels 4-0 at Neuroscience Group Field. Justin Jarvis, Taylor Floyd, and Robbie Baker combined on a two-hit shutout and the Rattlers snapped a ten-game losing streak.

JUSTIN CREDIBLE: Jarvis allowed one hit, walked two, and struck out eight over six innings for his eighth win and eighth quality start of the season. Jarvis leads the High-A Classification (Midwest, Northwest, and South Atlantic) in starts (20), innings pitched (104), and strikeouts (120).

STRIKEOUT STANDINGS: Jarvis leads Shane Drohan (Greenville - 118), Mason Montgomery (Bowling Green - 118), Robert Gasser (Fort Wayne -115), and Chayce McDermott (Asheville - 114). Antoine Kelly, tonight's starting pitcher for the Rattlers, is sixth in High-A with 113 strikeouts this season.

TWO STEPS FORWARD...AGAIN: Tristan Peters had two doubles, a walk, and a run scored for the Timber Rattlers last night. Peters has two hits in each of his last five games and is 10-for-20 during the streak. The longest multi-hit streak in the Midwest League this season is by Jorbit Vivas of the Great Lakes Loons, who had a six-game multi-hit streak from May 17 through May 22. Peters is tied for second in the league in runs (60), third in the league in hits (96), and fourth in the league in average (.298).

A PRESENCE NOT FELT SINCE: Last night was Wisconsin's fifth shutout of the season. It was their first since May 4 when they beat Fort Wayne 4-0.

PETERS PRINCIPAL: Tristan Peters had two more hits last night. He has 25 multi-hit games this season. Peters also scored two runs on Wednesday. Peters is third in the Midwest League in hits (94).

CHOURIO UPDATE: Jackson Chourio, the Milwaukee Brewers #1 prospect, went 1-for-2 with a walk, an RBI on a sacrifice fly, and run scored last night. He has at least one hit in all four games with Wisconsin and is on a eight-game hitting streak that started with his final four games at Carolina.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins – including 2022. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jackson Chourio (#1), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), and Taylor Floyd (#23). Tyler Black (#7) and Carlos Rodríguez (#21) are on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has four current Cedar Rapids players on their Top 30 list of Twins prospects: Aaron Sabato (#13), Alerick Soularie (#20), Cade Povich (#22), and David Festa (#29). ALL-TIME SERIES:

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ANTOINE KELLY: Selected by the Brewers in the second round of the 2019 draft out of Wabash Valley College in Mt. Carmel, Illinois. He is rated as the #14 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. *Baseball America* places Kelly at #10 for their in-season update of Milwaukee prospects.

WARRIORS...COME OUT TO PLAY: Kelly was 9-0 with 112 strikeouts in thirteen starts for the Warriors prior to the draft. He allowed 21 hits, 19 earned runs, and 31 walks over 52-2/3 innings pitched at Wabash Valley College

SAYING NO TO SAN DIEGO: The San Diego Padres selected Kelly in the thirteenth round of the 2018 draft after his senior season at Maine East High School in Park Ridge, Illinois. Kelly chose junior college over signing with the Padres.

THE BOYHOOD DREAM COMES TRUE: Kelly has been a Milwaukee Brewers fan since he was young.

WHAT'S BREWING? Kelly made his pro debut in the AZL with the Brewers Blue and made one start for the Rattlers in 2019. He spent 2020 with the Brewers Alternate Training Site. He underwent surgery for Thoracic Outlet Syndrome on November 5, 2020 and has worked his way back to Wisconsin after a relief appearance in Arizona and seven starts with Carolina before joining the Rattlers near the end of the 2021 season.

INTO THE FUTURE: Kelly participated in the 2022 SiriusXM Futures Game in Los Angeles on July 17. He retired both batters he faced in the game

LAST START: Kelly lost to Beloit at home on July 24 in game one of a doubleheader. He allowed an unearned run on four hits with three walks and seven strikeouts over five innings. The Sky Carp won the game 1-0.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS (2022): Kelly is 0-1 in two starts against the Kernels this season. He lost at Cedar Rapids on May 28 and had a no decision at home on July 1. Kelly has allowed ten runs – nine earned – on four hits, eleven walks, five hit batsmen, and fourteen strikeouts over nine innings against the Kernels this season.

CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TRAVIS ADAMS: The Minnesota Twins selected Adams in the sixth round of the 2021 draft out of Sacramento State.

SAC STATE: Adams was 10-6 with a 3.75 ERA in 33 games – 27 starts – over three seasons with the Hornets. He has 130 strikeouts over 151 innings pitched.

JUNIOR: Adams was 6-3 with a 4.31 ERA in fourteen starts in his final season at Sacramento State. He walked sixteen and struck out 72 over 79-1/3 innings pitched. Adams had two complete games as a junior.

LIFE RAFT: Adams was 3-0 with a 1.64 ERA in nine games – seven starts – for the Wisconsin Rapids Rafters during the 2020 Northwoods League season. Adams walked eight and struck out 41 in 33 innings with the Rafters.

SUNSHINE STATE: Adams made one start for the Florida Complex League team in 2021 after signing with the Twins. He started the 2022 season with the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels and was 4-5 with a 3.50 ERA in fifteen starts. Tonight is his first start as a Kernel.

LAST START: Adams had a <u>no decision at Dunedin on July 24</u>. He allowed a run on six hits with no walks and five strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Adams has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
