Series Record:

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 6-2 at Neuroscience Group Field. Cedar Rapids scored four runs in the first inning to send the Rattlers to their tenth straight loss.

DOWN EARLY ... AGAIN: Opponents have scored in the first inning in five straight games against the Timber Rattlers. Last night, Cedar Rapids had the bases loaded with one out. Wisconsin starting pitcher Israel Puello struck out Yunior Severino on a 3-2 pitch for the second out. Then, Puello walked Pat Winkel on four straight pitches, Wander Javier drove in two runs with a single, and Will Holland drove in a run with a double.

FIGHTING BACK...AGAIN: Wisconsin scored single runs in the first and second inning to cut into the deficit. Wes Clarke had an RBI double in the first and Jose Acosta knocked in a run with a fielder's choice in the second. The Rattlers loaded the bases in the third inning, but did not score

REVENGE OF YUNIOR: Severino hit a solo home run in the top of the fifth. It was the 109th home run of the season for Cedar Rapids. The Kernels are second in the Midwest League in homers with the Dayton Dragons (111) as the leaders in that category.

IT'S A BEAUT: Clarke was 3-for-3 with two doubles, a single, and a walk last night. This was the second time Clarke has hit two doubles in a game. The walk was his 50th of the season.

CHANCES WERE: The Timber Rattlers went 1-for-13 with runners in scoring position last night. They are 3for-27 with runners in scoring position with eighteen runners left on base in the last two games.

PETERS PRINCIPAL: Tristan Peters had two more hits last night. He has 25 multi-hit games this season. Peters also scored two runs on Wednesday. Peters is third in the Midwest League in hits (94).

CHOURIO UPDATE: Chourio, the Milwaukee Brewers #1 prospect, went 1-for-5 with a run scored last night. He has at least one hit in all three games with Wisconsin and is on a seven-game hitting streak that started with his final four games at Carolina.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins – including 2022. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jackson Chourio (#1), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), and Taylor Floyd (#23). Tyler Black (#7) and Carlos Rodríguez (#21) are on the Wisconsin injured list. PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JUSTIN JARVIS: Selected by Milwaukee in the 5th round of the 2018 draft out of Lake Norman High School in Mooresville, North Carolina.

THE SENIOR SEASON: In his final season of high school, Jarvis was 8-2 with a 1.60ERA, and 95 strikeouts. Former Major Leaguer Ty Wigginton was his head coach.

A PERFECT DAY: Jarvis pitched a perfect game with 18 strikeouts in a game against East Rowan High School early in his senior season of high school.

NOT ON CAMPUS: Jarvis signed with the Brewers over a commitment to UNC-Wilmington.

YEAR ONE: Jarvis was 1-2 with a 6.63ERA in ten games – three starts – for Milwaukee's Arizona League affiliate after signing with Milwaukee. He walked four and struck out 18 over 19 innings pitched in the Arizona League.

2019: Jarvis was 4-1 with a 3.50 ERA in 18 games – eleven starts – for the Timber Rattlers in 2019. He had 52 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings.

2021: Jarvis was 1-7 with a 5.40 ERA in seventeen starts for the Timber Rattlers in 2021. He had 62 strikeouts over 63-1/3 innings.

LAST START: Jarvis <u>lost to Beloit on July 24</u> in game two of a doubleheader at home. He allowed five runs on seven hits with two walks and three strikeouts over four innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS (2022): Jarvis is 2-0 in two starts against the Kernels this season. He won at Cedar Rapids on May 25 and at home on June 29. Jarvis has allowed one run on three hits and five walks with nineteen strikeouts over 11-2/3 innings against Cedar Rapids this season.

CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP CADE POVICH: The Minnesota Twins selected Povich in the third round of the 20-21 draft out of Nebraska. MLB Pipeline rates Povich as the #26 prospect in the Minnesota minor league system.

SOUTHWEST: Povich pitched a season at South Mountain Community College in Phoenix, Arizona and was 10-1 with a 1.52 ERA. He had eight complete games and pitched five shutouts.

HUSKY: Povich transferred to Nebraska for the 2020 season and made four appearances before the shutdown. He was a First Team All-Big Ten selection in 2021 after he went 6-1 in fifteen starts. Povich had 88 strikeouts over 81 innings during his final season at Nebraska.

STARTING OUT: Povich pitched in the Florida Complex League and for Fort Myers after signing with the Twins. He had no record and allowed one earned run over ten innings in four games – three starts in those two levels.

LAST START: Povich <u>lost to Peoria at home on July 23</u>. He allowed eight runs on six hits, including two home runs, walked four, and struck out two over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Povich is 0-2 in two starts against Wisconsin This season. He has lost to the Timber Rattlers at Cedar Rapids on $\underline{\text{May 25}}$ and in the Fox Cites on $\underline{\text{June 30}}$. He has allowed five runs on eight, including two homers, with three walks and twelve strikeouts over eleven innings pitched against the Timber Rattlers.
