**SUNDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Bowie Baysox, 7-6, to avoid a three-game sweep and snapped a six-game losing streak. The Flying Squirrels fell behind, 6-0, through the first two innings. **Ricardo Genovés** started the comeback with a three-run homer in the third inning. **Brett Auerbach** hit a solo homer and **Jacob Heyward** added a two-run shot in the sixth to tie the game, 6-6. In the seventh, **Diego Rincones** moved Richmond ahead, 7-6, with an RBI single. Richmond relievers **Solomon Bates**, **Ryan Walker**, **Christ Wright**, **Cole Waites** and **Blake Rivera** combined for seven hitless, scoreless innings. Rivera worked a scoreless ninth inning to pick up his second save of his professional career.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. This series is the only set of games between the two teams this year. The Flying Squirrels went 5-7 against the Patriots last season, including a 4-2 record at The Diamond.

**TICKET PUNCHED:** The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 7-14 to open the second half. They have lost six-of-the-last-seven games after snapping a season-high six-game losing streak on Sunday afternoon. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost six and split three this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 995 strikeouts (11.1 per game) and rank second with 116 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 26-19 at home this year. Richmond is 22-18 in games decided by two-or-less runs and 8-10 overall against teams from the Northeast Division, all at The Diamond.

**THE PATRIOTS** have won four-of-the-last-five games since July 16, including a three-game sweep at home against Reading over the weekend. Somerset went 44-25 in the first half, winning the first-half division title by one game over Hartford. They won the first-half title with a walk-off homer by Anthony Volpe against Hartford in the bottom of the 10th inning on June 26. Somerset is leading the Eastern League in homers (129) and stolen bases (147). Their pitching staff has the best ERA (3.50) in the league. Somerset's roster including XX of MLB.com's top-30 prospects, including SS Anthony Volpe (No. 1, No. 8 overall), C Austin Wells (No. 4, No. 71 overall), OF Everson Pereira (No. 10), RHP Luis Medina (No. 11), RHP Randy Vasquez (No. 15), OF Brandon Lockridge (No. 17), OF Elijah Dunham (No. 26) and RHP Will Warren (No. 27).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Jake Dahlberg** makes his 17th start of the season. Today is his first start since July 14 at Altoona when he allowed six runs over four innings in a loss. He has worked at least five innings in eight-of-his-last-10 starts. Dahlberg spent parts of three seasons with the independent Chicago Dogs before signing with the Giants during the 2021 season. He joined the High-A Eugene Emeralds in July and made 10 starts, going 2-5 with a 6.60 ERA. He closed the year with two outings with Triple-A Sacramento and tossed 9.0 scoreless innings. After being named Horizon League Pitcher of the Year twice at the University of Illinois-Chicago, he was selected in the 21st round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. **For more on Dahlberg, see page two.**

**FOR SOMERSET:** Right-hander Luis Medina makes his 16th start of the season. He last pitched on July 14 at Portland and picked up a win after allowing two runs over 5.2 innings of work with three strikeouts. Medina has gone 1-2 with a 2.55 ERA in eight home starts compared to a 2-1 with 4.83 ERA in eight road starts. Medina is currently ranked as the Yankees' No. 11 prospect according to MLB.com. He reached Double-A with Somerset for the first time last season, going 4-3 with a 3.67 ERA in 15 games (14 starts). Last year, he faced the Flying Squirrels in Bridgewater on June 16 and struck out 10 batters over 5.2 innings and allowed three runs in a no-decision. Medina has made one start at The Diamond, coming on July 16, 2021, and allowed four runs (two earned) over five innings with four walks and two strikeouts.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in total attendance (268,741) and average attendance (6,108). Richmond is 14th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

**POWER SURGE:** The Richmond offense has hit 116 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (129). **Sean Roby** is first in the league with 23 homers on the season, with 19 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 178 home runs. The Flying Squirrels have already hit more homers than entire seasons in every season except 2021, including 2010 (71), 2011 (83), 2012 (76), 2013 (109), 2014 (74) and 2015 (61), 2016 (83), 2017 (93) and 2019 (84).

**GO, DIEGO, GO!** After hitting .173 (22-for-127) over his first 35 games of the season, **Diego Rincones** is batting .367 (44-for-120) with six doubles, seven homers and 28 RBIs over his last 31 games since June 7. In his three games since the mid-season break, Rincones hit .636 (7-for-11) with a homer and three RBIs. He went 4-for-4 with a homer on Saturday, his second four-hit game of the season. He added two hits on Sunday afternoon, including a game-winning single.

**SHANE TRAIN:** From May 1-June 30, **Shane Matheny** hit .315 (39-for-124) with eight homers, five doubles, a triple and 24 RBIs in 38 games. Over his last 15 games since July 1, Matheny is batting .115 (6-for-52) with two doubles and six RBIs and has walked 11 times. From May 14-June 10, he posted a 13-game hitting streak, tied for the longest in the EL this season at the time. From May 1-June 11, Matheny posted a 24-game on-base streak, which was the second-longest in the league this season. In the Eastern League this season, Matheny is ranked sixth in OBP (.388).

**ROBUST:** **Sean Roby** hit his 21st homer of the year on July 4 against the Fightin Phils, moving him ahead of **David Villar** for the most home runs in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. He added his 22nd homer on July 7 and his 23rd on July 9. Roby is first in the EL in home runs this year ahead of Erie's Kerry Carpenter (22). He has hit 19 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duvall** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

**SMITH SURGING:** In his last 11 games since July 7, **Armani Smith** is batting .300 (12-for-40) with four doubles and seven RBIs. He has collected multiple hits in four-of-his-last-nine games. Since the series before the mid-season break in Altoona, Smith has played three games at first base for the first time in his professional career. He was primarily an outfielder in college, but did play 31 games at first base with UC Santa Barbara and 18 games at first base in summer collegiate circuits.

**FITZ ON FIRE:** **Tyler Fitzgerald** had homered five times over his last nine games played since July 10. He went deep in the series finale against Reading on July 10. He added a solo homer on July 14 in Altoona, hit two solo homers on July 15 and hit another on July 17 in the series finale. He hit .391 (9-for-23) over seven games from July 9-17, but has gone 0-for-12 since returning from the mid-season break.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **Frankie Tostado** is ranked sixth in batting average (.284) and tied for seventh in hits (83). **Sean Roby** is first in homers (23) and ninth in SLG (.493). **Shane Matheny** is sixth in OBP (.388). **Mike Gigliotti** is 10th in OBP (.378), tied for eighth in walks (45) and fourth in stolen bases (22). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for ninth in homers (15).

**WHERE THE PATRIOTS RANK:** In the Eastern League, Anthony Volpe is ranked fourth in doubles (24), tied for first in extra-base hits (38), tied for seventh in total bases (143), fifth in runs scored (53) and second in stolen bases (35). Jeisson Rosario is seventh in walks (47). Elijah Dunham is third in stolen bases (26). Michael Beltre is tied for fifth in stolen bases (21). Carson Coleman is fifth in saves (5).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have five players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Ryan Murphy** (11), **Cole Waites** (19), **Ricardo Genovés** (27) and **Chris Wright** (30). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Simon Whiteman** is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Murphy (11), **Brett Auerbach** (27), Genovés (29) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.
