WINNING WAYS: With today's game, the Omaha Storm Chasers have a chance to do two things that have not yet been done this season. Omaha has not been three games above .500 this season, going two games above .500 two times before this week, most recently after a 6-1 win against Toledo on July 7. With last night's 10-4 win, Omaha has won consecutive games on the road, something that has only been done twice before this week. If the Chasers win today, their three-game road winning streak will be the longest of the season away from Werner Park. Each of the last two times that Omaha has won back-to-back on the road were to close out a series, with this week being the first time that Omaha heads into game three on the road with a series lead. The Storm Chasers are looking to get their first road series outright win this week, coming into the week with a series record of 0-3-4.

THREE'S COMPANY: OF Drew Waters had a magnificent game in yesterday's 10-4 win at Syracuse. Waters reached base all five times that he stepped to the plate, going 3-for-3 with three runs scored, three RBIs, three stolen bases and two walks. Waters hit a home run in the second inning, off Jacob deGrom, who was making his second rehab start at the Triple-A level. In the seventh inning, Waters manufactured a run by himself, hitting a single and stealing second and third before scoring on a wild pitch. Waters, the Royals No. 8 prospect according to MLB.com, has hit leadoff in all 11 games that he has played in a Storm Chasers uniform, reaching base in all 11 of those games. His 11-game on-base streak is the longest active streak on the team, with the next longest on-base streak on the team at six games.

RUNNING WILD: Three Chasers combined for five stolen bases yesterday, highlighted by **OF Drew Waters'** three stolen bases. **INF Iván Castillo** and **INF Clay Dungan** were the other two with a stolen base for Omaha. Waters' three stolen bases marked the third time that a Storm Chaser swiped three bags in a single game. **OF Brewer Hicklen** attempted to steal his 20th base of the season but was caught for the first time this season, starting the year with 19 consecutive successful attempts. The Chasers lead Triple-A with a stolen-base success rate of .870, ahead of Memphis who has a .851 stolen base percentage. Omaha's 107 stolen bases are the sixth most in all of Triple-A and the third most in the International League, behind Buffalo and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

THRIVING ON THURSDAYS: The Storm Chasers' pitching staff holds the best ERA on games played on Thursdays in the International League at 3.33. Omaha has allowed 93 hits and a .205 batting average against; both also lead the league. The Chasers' 1.06 WHIP is the second lowest in the league. Offensively, Omaha hits .258 on Thursday's, the fifth best in the International League.

FOR OMAHA: LHP Austin Cox gets the ball for his 16th start and 19th overall appearance for the Storm Chasers. In his last start, Cox went 5.2 innings, allowing three earned runs on five hits and two walks with two strikeouts. Despite getting tagged with the loss, the start was one out short of being his fourth quality start of the season. His last quality start came on June 23, against Columbus when he threw 6.2 scoreless innings, tying a season-high in strikeouts with six. On the road, Cox has struggled, holding an ERA of 6.28 away from Werner Park and a 1-5 record. Cox allows a .329 batting average against on the road, compared to .239 at home. Cox has started a pair of games and come out of the bullpen once during July, earning a 6.23 ERA and 2-1 record this month.

FOR SYRACUSE: LHP Nate Fisher heads to the mound to make his ninth start and 10th overall appearance for the S-Mets this season. In his last start, he went 4.1 innings, allowing three earned runs on six hits with no walks and five strikeouts. Fisher's last outing was a 2.0-inning relief appearance, allowing run with two strikeouts and no walks. Fisher started the season with Double-A Birmingham before making the jump to Triple-A Syracuse on May 31. Fisher held a record of 0-1 with a 3.77 ERA the with Rumble Ponies before joining the S-Mets. The 26-year-old's longest outings of the season came in consecutive games, throwing 5.0 innings on June 28 and July 3, both at home against Lehigh Valley. When playing inside NBT Bank Stadium, Fisher holds a 1.56 ERA that jumps to 5.87 away from home.
