THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On August 2, 2019, Tim Dillard pitched a complete game as the Sounds beat Albuquerque, 7-3, in front of 10,581 fans at First Horizon Park. Dillard faced 30 batters, striking out four and allowing three runs on four hits. Nick Solak hit a 3-run homer in the 3rd inning and led the team with 4 RBI.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds begin a six-game series tonight at Harbor Park against the Norfolk Tides. The Sounds and Tides have split their 12 games this season. Right-hander Caleb Boushley starts for Nashville against left-hander DL Hall for Norfolk.

Caleb Boushley: 28-year-old Caleb Boushley starts for Nashville tonight. The right-hander is 10-2 with a 3.71 ERA (99.1 IP/41 ER) in 19 starts this year. Boushley last pitched in a start against Charlotte on July 27 and earned his 10th win of the season despite allowing five runs in 5.0 innings. He yielded six hits and a pair of walks to go with four strikeouts. The Hortonville, Wis. native is among International League leaders in wins (1st), starts (2nd), innings pitched (2nd), ERA (5th), WHIP (1.25, 8th) and opponent average (.243, 8th). The Brewers drafted Boushley in the Triple-A Phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft from San Diego. The UW-La Crosse alum was selected by San Diego in the 33rd Round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

DL Hall: 23-year-old DL Hall starts for the Tides in the series opener. The left-hander is 2-5 with a 4.45 ERA (60.2 IP/30 ER) in 16 starts for Norfolk this season. He has also made one start each for Double-A Bowie and Advanced-A Aberdeen. Overall in 2022, Hall is 2-6 with a 4.21 ERA in 18 starts. He has 114 strikeouts compared to 37 walks in 68.1 innings. He last pitched on July 26 and was tagged with the loss at Memphis (0.2 IP, 6 H, 6 R, 6 ER, 1 K). Hall is currently rated as the No. 4 prospect in the Orioles system, according to MLB Pipeline. He went 2-0 with a 3.13 ERA in seven starts with the Bowie Baysox last season. The lefty was selected by Baltimore in the First Round (21st Pick) of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Valdosta (GA) High School.

Superlatives: Sunday's loss dropped the Sounds to 41-6 when out-hitting the opponent...43-17 when hitting at least one home run...34-20 at First Horizon Park...11-6 in series finales...38-7 when the opponent scores 3 or fewer runs.

Here Come the Kids: The Brewers announced today a trio of promotions for 22-year-old Sal Frelick, 23-year-old Joey Wiemer and 23-year-old Garrett Mitchell from Double-A Biloxi to Nashville. Additionally, 23-year-old Esteury Ruiz, who was acquired yesterday via trade with San Diego, was optioned from Milwaukee to Nashville. According to MLB Pipeline, Frelick is Milwaukee's #2 prospect, Wiemer #3, Mitchell #4 and Ruiz checks in at #9.

That's a First: With today's roster additions, the Sounds currently have six former first round draft picks on the roster, all drafted by Milwaukee. Sal Frelick was drafted 15th overall in 2021, Garrett Mitchell was the 20th overall pick in 2020, Ethan Small was drafted 28th overall in 2019, Brice Turang was drafted 21st overall in 2018, Keston Hiura was the 9th overall pick in 2017 and Corey Ray was the 5th overall draft pick in the 2016 Draft.

11 Straight: Brice Turang has hit safely in 11 consecutive games, marking the second time this year he has put together an 11-game hitting streak (also, April 19-May 3). During Turang's current 11-game hitting streak, he's batting .350 (14-for-40) with 12 runs, 4 doubles, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, 10 walks and 4 stolen bases. He has also reached safely in 18 straight games. Among active streaks in the International League, the hitting streak is tied for the 3rd-longest and the on-base streak is the 2nd-longest.

Turn the Page: The Sounds finished the month of July with a 15-9 record in 24 games despite their starters posting a 5.53 ERA. Nashville finished among International League leaders in several hitting categories in July, including walks (1st, 122), on-base percentage (1st, .365), runs (2nd, 138), home runs (2nd, 38), total bases (3rd, 379), slugging percentage (3rd, .468) and OPS (3rd, .833).

Among League Leaders: Shortstop Brice Turang continues to climb several hitting categories. Amongst all International League hitters, Turang is tied for 3rd in hits (106), 4th in runs (60) and is 6th in stolen bases (22).

On the Road Again: The Sounds take to the road where they will play 18 of their next 24 games in a 27-day stretch. Nashville is 25-19 on the road

200-Plus: Rick Sweet won his 206th game as Nashville's manager on Friday night, good for 5th-most in franchise history. Don Money has the 4th-most wins in franchise history with 223. As well as Nashville, Sweet has 200+ wins with four other Triple-A teams: 1993-95 Tucson (251), 2001-03 Portland (212), 2005-11 Louisville (539) and 2015-18 Colorado Springs (282).

LAST OUTING: Boushley last pitched on Wednesday, July 27 vs. Charlotte. He picked up his 10th-consecutive win, going 5.0 innings in his first start after the All-Star break. Boushley yielded five runs (all earned) on six hits and two walks while striking out four. He totaled 101 pitches and 60 strikes.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Boushley has two career starts against Norfolk, both this season. He finished with a no-decision in Nashville's 4-3 on May 5 against the Tides (4.2 IP, 7 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 1 BB, 3 K). He had a quality start in his last outing against Norfolk on June 10 with 6.0 scoreless innings (5 H, 3 BB, 3 K).
