Friday: Brett Baty's magical month of July continued as he went 3-5 with two home runs and seven RBI as the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (7-17, 35-58) defeated the New Hampshire Fisher Cats 12-8 on Friday night at Mirabito Stadium. Baty is now hitting .375 with 33 hits, eight homers and 27 RBI in the month of July and extended his hit-streak to 12 games. Baty drove in runs nine, 10, 11 and 12 with a grand slam in the eighth inning which put the Ponies ahead 12-5. He also added a mammoth solo home run in the first over the batter's eye and a two-run single capping off a six-run fourth which put Binghamton ahead 7-4. Matt Winaker registered the first RBI in the fourth on a bases loaded hit-by-pitch and Carlos Cortes scored on a wild pitch. Matt O'Neill tied the game at four with an RBI single and Nick Meyer's RBI single gave the Ponies a 5-4 lead they wouldn't relinquish. Meyer also walked in eighth with the bases loaded which brought home a run.


Baty's Video Game Numbers: Rumble Ponies 3B Brett Baty went 3-5 in Wednesday's game with a career high seven RBI. In the month of July alone, Baty has been on a tear batting .375 with 33 hits, eight homers, 27 RBI and an OPS of 1.155. He is also riding a 12-game hit streak, his second 10-plus game hit streak of the season. During the 12-game hit streak, he has recorded nine multi-hit games including three games with three hits. The left-handed infielder is currently batting .442 (23/52) with five home runs and 19 RBI dating back to July 12th.

Number 22 Moves to Number Two: Brett Baty now sits in second in franchise history with seven RBI in a game. He only trails Jhoan Urena who holds the franchise mark for most RBI's with nine in a 12-2 win at Hartford on August 27th, 2018. Urena hit two grand slams and a solo home run in the game.

High Octane Petroleum: Jose Butto has struck out 26 batters in 23.2 innings pitched this month. In addition to the strikeout total, opposing hitters are hitting just .205 against him and the right hander is 2-0 with a 2.28 ERA.

Coming Up: The Ponies will conclude their series against New Hamsphire. Sunday's matinee will begin at 1:05 PM as right-hander Jose Chacin will get the start in the series finale.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 1st season with Binghamton - 3rd year in the Mets organization. Brignac comes to Binghamton after serving as the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021. He appeared in parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

Jerome Williams - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - Williams also held the same position on Brignac's staff with St. Lucie and is entering his fourth season in the Mets organization following a 20-year playing career. He pitched for 11 years in the major leagues with the Giants, Angels, Cubs, Cardinals, Rangers, Phillies, Nationals and Astros compiling a 52-66 record with a 4.59 ERA in 236 career games.

Tommy Joseph - Hitting Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Joseph joins Brignac and Williams in being promoted from the same position in St. Lucie to Double-A Binghamton. He is entering his second season with the Mets organization after retiring from his playing career following the 2020 season. He spent two seasons in the major leagues with the Phillies in 2016-17 hitting .247 with 43 home runs and 116 RBI in 249 major league games.

Mariano Duncan - Bench Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - arrives in the Southern Tier after serving as the bench coach for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) in 2020.
