Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fourth in a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. The Nuts are 7-8 vs. the Loons and 3-6 at Dow Diamond after losing two of the first three games of this series, including each of the last two nights.

Starting Matchup: Towering Penn State product Kyle Virbitsky, who made his pro debut last year for the Nuts, returns to the Midwest League from Stockton for his 2022 Lugnuts debut, opposing Loons right-hander Nick Nastrini, who struck out seven Nuts in five innings on May 21 and then fanned seven more Lugnuts in six shutout innings on July 9.

Last Night: Loons 7, Lugnuts 2. Catcher Diego Cartaya slugged a pair of two-run homers off Lugnuts starter Joey Estes (who admittedly also struck out seven batters in three innings), powering Great Lakes to the Thursday night victory. Lansing's runs were supplied by a pair of consecutive bases-loaded walks issued by Emmet Sheehan, who walked five batters in four

Blue Chippers: The Lugnuts' offense is headlined by 19-year-old SS Max Muncy, the 25th overall pick in the 2021 draft (Thousand Oaks H.S., Thousand Oaks, Calif.) and the No. 4 prospect in the Athletics' organization, and 20-year-old Tyler Soderstrom, the 26th overall pick in the 2020 draft (Turlock H.S., Turlock, Calif.) and the A's No. 2 prospect. In six games together, Muncy is 7-for-24 (1.024 OPS) with four doubles, one triple, one homer, six runs scored and five RBIs while Soderstrom is 8-for-23 (1.189 OPS) with one double, three homers, five runs scored and nine RBIs.

Transaction: Shortly before yesterday's game, UT Joshwan Wright was placed on the Covid-IL. He is the third Lugnut (Jared McDonald in May, Kevin Richards in July), excluding the broadcast team, to go on the Covid-IL this year.

Soder Pop: C/1B Tyler Soderstrom ranks 1st in the league with 70 RBIs, 2nd with 41 extra-base hits, tied for 3rd with 19 homers (most in the Athletics' organization), 3rd with 166 total bases, 5th with a .512 slugging percentage, tied for 8th with 19 doubles and 9th with 84 base hits

Hot in July: The Lugnuts' top hitters this month include Jack Winkler (.351/.419/.519...938 OPS, seven doubles, two HRs and 15 RBIs in 21 games): UT Joshwan Wright (.350/.400/.500, .900 OPS, two doubles, two triples, one HR in 18 games) and Tyler Soderstrom (.328/.400/.719, 1.119 OPS, five doubles, one triple, six homers, 21 RBIs in 18 games). Winkler has raised his batting average from .221 to .274 and his OPS from .606 to .741 and Wright has raised his average from .214 to .262 and his OPS from .530 to .659.

Roster Crunch: When Kyle Virbitsky takes the mound tonight, he'll become the 41st different player used this year and 17th different starting pitcher.

RiSPy Business: Though the Nuts have lost each of the last two games, they left more runners on base than the Loons each night (12-5 LOB on Wednesday, 7-6 LOB last night). The difficulty for the Lugnuts has been hitting with runners in scoring position, going 2-for-14 in Wednesday's 8-6 loss and 0-for-6 last night in the 7-2 defeat.

Strong Relief: On the other hand, through three games of this series, the Lugnuts' bulloen has worked 15 innings and allowed only two runs, a 1.20 ERA. Four different relievers - Shohei Tomioka and Angello Infante (Tuesday), Diego Granado (Wednesday) and Brock Whittlesey (yesterday) - have

Clean Baseball: Yesterday's game, like the majority of the Lugnuts' games as of late, was completed without Lansing's defense committing an error. It was the Lugnuts' fifth straight errorless game and the 18th errorless game of the second half after 30 errorless games were played in the first half. The Nuts have committed only six errors in 21 games played this month. Lansing's 69 errors total ranks fourth lowest in the Midwest League.

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2012: Trailing 10-8 to the South Bend Silver Hawks in the bottom of the 9th, the Lugnuts loaded the bases with none out. Kevin Patterson and K.C. Hobson struck out, but Kipp Schutz - a minor league free agent - came through with a three-run double to walk off the Silver Hawks, 11-10. South Bend starter Archie Bradley struck out 11 batters in 4 2/3 innings, but also gave up five hits, four walks and five runs, plus two HBPs and one balk. The game had 34 total hits (19 by South Bend) in addition to 21 total runs.

After joining the Nuts directly after signing last year as the Athletics' 17th-round selection and making seven appearances, three starts, the towering Virbitsky rejoins the Lugnuts after excelling in Stockton's rotation, replacing the demoted Stevie Emanuels. He is the 17th different Nuts starter this year.

Turning Pro: Virbitsky's first time being drafted was in 2021, taken 518th overall by the Oakland Athletics... signed for \$50,000... also from Penn State: Mike Scioscia, David Aardsma, and Hall of Famer John "Monte" Montgomery Ward... both of Kyle's parents attended Penn State.

Glory Days: Attended Episcopal Academy, where he pitched against Dayton's Michael Siani (William Penn Charter School), who also was the first player faced as a pro (Siani tripled)... named a Top-25 baseball player in Pennsylvania by PennLive.com... 2016 Perfect Game Underclass high honorable mention... 2017 Rawlings-Perfect Game honorable mention All-America... as a junior, posted 1.76 ERA with 66 strikeouts while hitting three home runs... as a senior was named Team MVP of the Episcopal baseball team, honored as the No. 8 right-handed pitcher in Pennsylvania by Perfect Game... also named Team MVP of the Episcopal football team (tight end and defensive lineman), and was honored as first-team all-league and all-area at TE and DL.
