THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this date in 1999, Chad Hermansen hit his 55th career home run, setting a new franchise record. He would finish his Sounds career with 92 homers.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Charlotte Knights play game four of a six-game set at First Horizon Park. Nashville has won the first three games in the series, including last night's 3-1 win. Right-hander Freddy Peralta makes a rehab start the Sounds against left-hander John Parke for the Knights.

Freddy Peralta: 26-year-old Freddy Peralta starts for the Sounds tonight. The right-hander is 3-2 with a 4.42 ERA (38.2 IP/19 ER) in eight starts with Milwaukee this season. Peralta made his first rehab start with Nashville on July 24 at Louisville and threw 33 pitches (2.0 IP, 1 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 3 K). He landed on Milwaukee's injured list on May 23 with a strained right lat. Peralta was a Major League All-Star in 2021 when he logged a 10-5 record and 2.81 ERA in 28 outings (27 starts) for the Brewers. Across parts of five Major League seasons, Peralta is 29-15 in 106 games (58 starts). Milwaukee acquired Peralta in a trade in December of 2015 from Seattle in a trade. The Moca, Dominican Republic native was originally signed by the Mariners in 2013.

John Parke: 27-year-old John Parke starts for the Knights in game four of the series tonight. The left-hander is 2-10 with a 7.09 ERA (92.2 IP/73 ER) in 18 games (16 starts) with Charlotte this year. Opposing International League batters are hitting .318 against Parke in 2022. The southpaw last pitched on July 22 at Jacksonville (3.0 IP, 6 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 2 BB, 2 K) and was tagged with his 10th loss of the season. Parke pitched against Nashville on April 23 in a relief appearance and allowed six runs (five earned) on six hits in 5.0 innings. He yielded four walks, a home run, and struck out six. In his minor league career, Parke is 29-33 with a 4.03 ERA in 110 games (102 starts). The White Sox drafted him in the 21st round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of the University of South Carolina.

2022 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2022: First: 93, Second: 11, Third: 3, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 1, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

Superlatives: Last night's win improved the Sounds to 33-18 at First Horizon Park...53-0 when leading after 8 innings...9-4 when tied after 7 innings...10-27 when they are out-hit...41-11 when scoring first.

Through the Quad and up to the Gymnasium: Infielders Brice Turang (15 games) and Pablo Reyes (14 games) have on-base streaks in the top 10 current International League streaks. Turang's 15-game on-base streak is the 5th-longest active streak in the league and Reyes' 14-game streak is tied for the 6th-longest. Turang is hitting .357 (20-for-56) with 17 runs, 6 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs, 10 RBI, 11 walks and 8 steals while Reyes is hitting .423 (22-for-52) with 9 runs, 6 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, 11 RBI, 9 walks and 4 steals.

Among League Leaders: Shortstop Brice Turang continues to climb several league leading categories. Amongst all International League hitters, Turang ranks 4th in hits (103), 5th in runs scored (58), 6th in stolen bases (22) and 10th in batting average (.288).

That's BIG Jon: First baseman Jon Singleton clubbed his 18th home run of the season on Wednesday night. Singleton's 18 homers is tied for 6th-most in the International League and his 71 walks is tied for first with Will Benson of Columbus.

We Own the Knight: The Sounds and Knights are halfway through their 18 scheduled games in 2022. By winning the first three of the current series, Nashville holds an 8-1 series lead. Brice Turang (.485, 16-for-33) and Mark Mathias (.455, 10-for-22) are each hitting over .400 against Charlotte this year.

It's Trevor Time: Reliever Trevor Kelley notched his fifth save in as many chances last night with a 1-2-3 ninth. The right-hander has pitched in 21 games with Nashville and owns a 0.41 ERA (22.0 IP/1 ER). He has 29 strikeouts and opponents are hitting just .167 against him.

Welcome Back, Julio Mosquera: The Charlotte Knights' acting manager is 50-year-old Julio Mosquera. The Panama native played in 64 games for the 2005 Nashville Sounds. Mosquera hit .258 (62-for-240) with 32 runs, 18 doubles, 4 home runs and 30 RBI while helping the Sounds to the 2005 Pacific Coast League Championship.

200-Plus: Rick Sweet won his 205th game as Nashville's manager last night, good for 5th-most in franchise history. Don Money has the 4th-most wins in franchise history with 223. As well as Nashville, Sweet has 200+ wins with four other Triple-A teams: 1993-95 Tucson (251), 2001-03 Portland (212), 2005-11 Louisville (539) and 2015-18 Colorado Springs (282).

He allowed one hit, a leadoff home run to Jose Barrero. Peralta walked one and struck out three in the no-decision.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Peralta is facing Charlotte for the first time in his career.
