LAST OUTING: Peralta last pitched on July 24 in his first rehab start with Nashville against the Louisville Bats in Kentucky. The right-hander threw 33 pitches (22 strikes) and worked 2.0 innings. He allowed one hit, a leadoff home run to Jose Barrero. Peralta walked one and struck out three in the no-decision.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Peralta is facing Charlotte for the first time in his career.
