Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Charlotte Knights play the series finale of a six-game set tonight at First Horizon Park. Nashville won the first four of the series before Charlotte won last night's game. Left-hander Ethan Small starts for the Sounds against left-hander Kyle Kubat for the Knights.

Ethan Small: 25-year-old Ethan Small starts for Nashville in the finale. The left-hander is 6-4 with a 3.34 ERA (72.2 IP/27 ER) in 15 starts with the Sounds in 2022. The southpaw has also started two games with Milwaukee and sports a 7.11 ERA (6.1 IP/5 ER). He last pitched on July 26 in a start for Milwaukee against Minnesota. He got a no-decision despite allowed three runs (all earned) on four hits and four walks in 3.2 innings. He is currently ranked as the No. 8 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. Small split his 2021 campaign between Biloxi and Nashville, finishing 2-2 with a 1.96 ERA in eight starts with the Shuckers and 2-0 with a 2.06 ERA in nine starts for the Sounds. Milwaukee took Small in the First Round (28th overall) of the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Mississippi State.

Kyle Kubat: 29-year-old Kyle Kubat starts for the Knights in the series finale. The left-hander is 4-3 with a 5.34 ERA (60.2 IP/36 ER) with Charlotte in 26 games (seven starts). Kubat last pitched in the series opener on July 26 (5.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 6 K). The southpaw has pitched against Nashville three times in 2022 and is 0-0 with a 7.04 ERA (7.2 IP/6 ER). In addition to the July 26 game, Kubat pitched against Nashville on April 20 and April 22 and got a no-decision in both games. Kubat was originally signed by the Kansas City Royals in 2015 after attending the University of Nebraska.

Superlatives: Last night's loss dropped Nashville to 51-15 when scoring 4+ runs...9-15 when allowing 10+ hits...18-27 when the opponent scores first...34-19 at First Horizon Park...18-14 vs. left-handed starters.

Against Kubat: The Sounds have faced tonight's starter, Kyle Kubat, three times (one start) in 2022. The following active Nashville batters have faced him: Mario Feliciano: 1-for-4; Keston Hiura: 0-for-1, BB; Mark Mathias: 2-for-2, HR, RBI; Brian Navarrete: 0-for-1, K; Corey Ray: 1-1, 3B, 3 RBI; Pablo Reyes: 0-for-2, K; Jon Singleton: 0-for-4, 3 K; Brice Turang: 1-for-3; Tyler White: 0-for-2, RBI, K; Garrett Whitley: 1-for-2, 2B, RBI, BB, K; Weston Wilson: 0-for-2, BB, K.

Run, Brice, Run: Since 1998 when the Sounds entered the Pacific Coast League, only three players have had more runs in a single month than Brice Turang's current tally of 27 runs in July. Curtis Pride had 30 in June of 2002, Andy Ibanez had 29 in August of 2019 and Aramis Ramirez had 29 in May of 1999. Turang is tied for 4th-most with Corey Hart who had 27 in June of 2005.

10-Pack: Brice Turang has hit safely in 10 consecutive games, marking the second time this year he has put together a 10+ game hitting streak (11 games, April 19-May 3). During Turang's current 10-game hitting streak, he's batting .361 (13-for-36) with 12 runs, 4 doubles, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, 10 walks and 4 stolen bases. He has also reached safely in 17 straight games.

Big Jon's July: First baseman Jon Singleton has 24 RBI in the month of July. Since 1998, Chad Hermansen has the highest monthly RBI total for the Sounds with 33 in July of 1999. Singleton needs two RBI today to match Matt Olson (May of 2017) and Mat Gamel (June of 2011) for 10th-most in a single month.

I Need a Hiura: Infielder Keston Hiura came through in the clutch for a 3-run blast in the eighth inning on Friday night. In 11 games with the Sounds this season, Hiura has 16 RBI and is batting .341 (14-for-41) with five homers.

Among League Leaders: Shortstop Brice Turang continues to climb several hitting categories. Amongst all International League hitters, Turang is tied for 3rd in runs (60) and ranks 4th in hits (105) and 6th in stolen bases (22).

We Own the Knight: The Sounds and Knights are just over halfway through their 18 scheduled games in 2022. By winning the first four of the current series, Nashville holds a 9-2 series lead. Brice Turang (.462, 18-for-39) and Mark Mathias (.455, 10-for-22) are each hitting over .400 against Charlotte this year.

200-Plus: Rick Sweet won his 206th game as Nashville's manager on Friday night, good for 5th-most in franchise history. Don Money has the 4th-most wins in franchise history with 223. As well as Nashville, Sweet has 200+ wins with four other Triple-A teams: 1993-95 Tucson (251), 2001-03 Portland (212), 2005-11 Louisville (539) and 2015-18 Colorado Springs (282).

LAST OUTING: Small made his second Major League start on July 26 vs. Minnesota. He yielded three runs (all earned) on four hits and four walks in 3.2 innings. The southpaw struck out three Twins in his American Family Field debut.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Small is facing Charlotte for the third time in his career and second time this season. He pitched 5.0 one-hit innings in Nashville's win on April 22, totaling six strikeouts and five walks on 82 pitches (51 strikes).
