LAST GAME

For the second-consecutive night, the Baysox broke a 4-4 tie late to capture a win against the Harrisburg Senators. Joey Ortiz continued his strong run for Bowie, going 2-for-5 at the plate with a trio of RBI, including the go-ahead knock in the seventh inning. Carrying their strong run recently, the Bowie bullpen kept Harrisburg from breaking the tie, as Tyler Burch and Shelton Perkins logged scoreless outings, while Conner Loeprich earned his third save of the year with two scoreless innings.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The second half has not been to kind to Harrisburg, entering this series at just 10-17 in the half, partly due to an ERA 5.35. Bowie and Harrisburg have gone back-and-forth this season, after Bowie had a stretch of five wins in six games against the Senators, including a no-hitter, Harrisburg won the final five games of a seven-game series in June. Harrisburg pitching has held Bowie to just a .211 batting average this season, and sport a 3.42 ERA against the Baysox.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Luis Reyes opened the season with Triple-A Rochester, but struggled to find consistency, only reaching the fifth inning once in four starts, and allowing 21 earned runs in just 13.1 innings. The 27-year-old has been with the Nationals organization for nearly a decade, after signing as an international free agent in August of 2012. Reyes made two starts against Bowie in 2021, and was hammered for 13 runs in 9.1 innings. His luck turned around against the Baysox this June, as he spun six innings of one-hit ball. He's allowed plenty of contact this season, only striking out 55 batters in 62 innings.

SOOTHING RELIEF

Bowie has had their ups and downs with work out of their bullpen, as they sported 4.78 ERA over the first half of the season. For much of the first half, Bowie relievers were among the top-three in the Eastern League for highest ERA. In the second half, however, Bowie relievers are sporting a 2.48 ERA, and have shrunk their overall ERA to 4.12, the fifth-lowest in the league.

HURRY UP HUDSON

Bowie outfielder Hudson Haskin has been a big fan of the early attack. One of the most liable to attack the first pitch, Haskin has put the first pitch of a plate appearance into play 49 time this season, the most by any Baysox player. He's carried a little bit of patience at the plate as well, as he's drawn five walks in his last seven games. Coupled with three triples over his last two games, Haskin has broken though into the top-10 in the Eastern League for OPS.

NORBY NOT WAST TIME

Connor Norby has been the obvious choice to lead off games for Bowie since joining the team ahead of the second half. After singling to open Wednesday's game in Harrisburg, Norby raised his batting average to .357 when he is the first batter of an inning, as well as two home runs when leading off.

STAYING UP LATE

Things have not always gone in Bowie's favor late in game this season, including seven walk-off losses in just the first half of the season. The last week has turned things around for Bowie, however, as they've got a +25 run differential in the seventh, eighth, and ninth innings over their last eight games. Entering this stretch, Bowie had a -23 run differential in that same span of innings over the season.

FIELD GENERALS

Thanks to Cody Roberts and Maverick Handley, Bowie has had the most feared backstops in the league. Bowie's CS% of 38% is the highest mark in the league. Additionally, Bowie has only allowed 50 stolen bases this season, the second-fewest in the minors (Omaha-47).

*RELIEF ADDEADANCE

- Shifted to the bullpen in July after spending the first three months of the season in the Bowie rotation, but hit a snag in June, allowing a total of 43 ER and 53 hits in just 17.0 IP across six games from 5/27-6/28. Bowie lost every game he started during the span, while
- Stallings was the losing pitcher in five of the six.

 Second batter he faced as a reliever hit a solo home run, but Stallings went on to strike out a career-high ten batters in that same outing, while starting a 16-inning scoreless streak, the longest of the season for a Baysox pitcher.
- Spent his time following the 2020 draft at the Angels alternate site at Long Beach State before being dealt to Baltimore the same
- Initially drafted by the Angels in the 5th round of 2020 out of the University of Tennessee, but did not appear in a game for the
- Orioles EVP/GM Mike Elias had targeted Stallings in the 2020 draft, but was taken earlier by the Angels. Threw two complete game shutouis in his junior season at Tennessee. He earned two SEC Pitcher of the Week awards, and was also named to the 2019 SEC All-Defensive team

Baseball America (2021): "Stallings is a polished righthander who mixes his pitches, limits his walks and lasts deep into his starts. His fastball sits 90-92 mph and his short, sharp mid-80s slider is his best secondary offering. Stallings mixes in an average low-80s changeup he commands well and a big, upper-70s curveball he is trying to throw for more strikes early in the count. He has a smooth, up-tempo delivery that is easy to repeat and allows him to command and sequence his four-pitch repertoire effectively. Stallings has a chance to move fast because of his command, advanced feel for pitching and business-like approach. His lack of a plus pitch limits his ceiling to a back-of-the-

Baysox Pitching Coach Josh Conway - Working with Stallings at Aberdeen in 2021: "He's a gamer. As far as the stuff goes, he's not going to blow up the radar gun, but he knows how to use what he's got....He's always in the zone....a very efficient guy pounding the zone, coming right after you and basically daring you to hit him, which is nice. And he takes his strikeouts as needed. He found himself in a ton of 0-2, 1-2 counts this year, just being ahead of hitters, attacking guys in four pitches or less. Really had that mentality of, "I'm just going to go right after you." It was intriguing to see. He did a great job."
