**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels were blanked by the Patriots, 6-0, in the series opener. Somerset opened the scoring with two runs in the second inning. In the seventh, Jesus Bastidas extended the lead to 3-0 with a solo homer. Austin Wells hit a three-run homer in the top of the ninth to extend the lead to 6-0. Richmond was held to two hits in the loss.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the second and third of a six-game series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. This series is the only set of games between the two teams this year. The Flying Squirrels went 5-7 against the Patriots last season, including a 4-2 record at The Diamond.

**TICKET PUNCHED:** The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 7-15 to open the second half. They have lost seven-of-the-last-eight games, including a season-high six-game losing streak from July 14-23. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost six and split three this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 1,005 strikeouts (11.1 per game) and rank third with 117 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 26-20 at home this year. Richmond is 22-18 in games decided by two-or-less runs and 8-11 overall against teams from the Northeast Division, all at The Diamond.

**THE PATRIOTS** have won five-of-the-last-six games since July 16, including a three-game sweep at home against Reading over the weekend. Somerset went 44-25 in the first half, winning the first-half division title by one game over Hartford. They won the first-half title with a walk-off homer by Anthony Volpe against Hartford in the bottom of the 10th inning on June 26. Somerset is leading the Eastern League in homers (131) and stolen bases (150). Their pitching staff has the best ERA (3.47) in the league. Somerset's roster including nine of MLB.com's top-30 prospects, including SS Anthony Volpe (No. 1, No. 8 overall), C Austin Wells (No. 4, No. 71 overall), OF Everson Pereira (No. 10), RHP Luis Medina (No. 11), RHP Randy Vásquez (No. 15), OF Brandon Lockridge (No. 17), OF Elijah Dunham (No. 24), RHP Will Warren (No. 25) and RHP Deivi García (No. 26).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Wil Jensen** makes his second Double-A start in Game 1. He last pitched on July 16 at Altoona for his Double-A debut and picked five scoreless innings with five strikeouts in a no-decision. He began the season with High-A Eugene, going 6-3 with a 2.84 ERA in 15 starts and three relief outings. Over his last four High-A starts, Jensen went 4-0 with a 1.46 ERA (4 ER/24.2 IP) and struck out 30 batters. He last pitched last Saturday at Hillsboro and matched a season high with seven innings pitched, holding the Hops to two runs (one earned) with nine strikeouts. It was his second straight start working seven innings and striking out nine. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, Jensen ranked tied for second in the Northwest League in wins (6) and tied for seventh in strikeouts (77). After four years at Peppercorn, Jensen signed as an undrafted free agent with the Giants in 2020. Jensen was born in Phoenix but grew up near Salt Lake City. **For more on Jensen, see page two.**

Right-hander **Matt Frisbee** makes his 18th start of the season in Game 2. Last time out, he allowed two runs over 4.2 innings in a no-decision against the Baysox on Friday night and struck out six, his most strikeouts in an outing since May. Today's start is the first of his career against the Patriots. Last year, he began the season with the Flying Squirrels and went 4-1 with a 1.24 ERA in five starts in the month of May, earning a promotion to Triple-A Sacramento on June 3. In 11 outings (nine starts) with the River Cats, he went 1-6 with a 7.64 ERA and was assigned back to Richmond on August 6. He made six more starts to finish the season with the Flying Squirrels, going 1-3 with a 6.16 ERA. On May 13, 2021 at Harrisburg, Frisbee worked six perfect innings and combined with **Joey Marciano**, **Matt Seelinger** and **Patrick Ruotolo** for the first nine-inning no-hitter in Flying Squirrels franchise history. Frisbee was drafted in the 15th round in 2018 by the Giants out of UNC Greensboro. **For more on Frisbee, see page three.**

**FOR SOMERSET:** Right-hander Deivi García makes his first Double-A start of the season in Game 1 and his first overall start since May 26, when he was with Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. García made seven starts with the RailRiders to open the year, going 0-3 with a 10.38 ERA. He was placed on the 7-day IL on May 31 and reinstated today and assigned to Somerset. He is currently rated by MLB.com as the Yankees' No. 26 prospect. García first reached Double-A for one game with Trenton in 2018 and returned to the Thunder for the 2019 season. That year, he faced the Flying Squirrels at The Diamond on May 8, 2019 and worked five scoreless innings with five strikeouts. He pitched against Richmond again in Trenton on June 18, 2019 and threw six scoreless innings, allowing one hit with 15 strikeouts. His 15 strikeouts are the most ever against the Flying Squirrels, ahead of 14-strikeout performances by Harrisburg's Brad Peacock (May 13, 2011) and Somerset's Glenn Otto (June 15, 2021). At the time, it was also the most strikeouts in a game in the Eastern League since Reading's Jesse Biddle struck out 16 in a game on April 22, 2013. Only four Eastern League pitchers -- García, Biddle, Joel Zumaya (15, ERI vs. HAR, 2005) and Adam Warren (15, TRN vs. BOW, 2010) have recorded 15-or-more strikeouts in a game since at least 2005.

Right-hander Randy Vásquez makes his 17th start of the season in Game 2. He last pitched on July 17 at Portland and allowed a season-high eight runs in one inning in a no-decision in a back-and-forth game won by the Sea Dogs, 12-11. Over his last three starts since July 6, Vásquez has gone 0-1 with a 14.73 ERA. In his first 13 starts of the year, Vásquez posted a 2.73 ERA. He was signed by the Yankees in their 2017-18 international class and joined Double-A Somerset for the first time last August.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in total attendance (274,939) and average attendance (6,110). Richmond is 14th of the 120 MLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

**POWER SURGE:** The Richmond offense has hit 116 home runs this season, which is third in the Eastern League behind Somerset (131) and Erie (117). **Sean Roby** is first in the league with 23 homers on the season, with 19 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 176 home runs. The Flying Squirrels have already hit more homers than entire seasons in every season except 2021, including 2010 (71), 2011 (83), 2012 (76), 2013 (109), 2014 (74) and 2015 (61), 2016 (83), 2017 (93) and 2019 (84).

**GO, DIEGO, GO!** After hitting .173 (22-for-127) over his first 35 games of the season, **Diego Rincones** is batting .358 (44-for-123) with six doubles, seven homers and 28 RBIs over his last 32 games since June 7. In his three games since the mid-season break, Rincones hit .500 (7-for-14) with a homer and three RBIs. He went 4-for-4 with a homer on Saturday, his second four-hit game of the season. He added two hits on Sunday afternoon, including a game-winning single.

**SHANE TRAIN:** From May 1-June 30, **Shane Matheny** hit .315 (39-for-124) with eight homers, five doubles, a triple and 24 RBIs in 38 games. Over his last 16 games since July 1, Matheny is batting .109 (6-for-55) with two doubles and six RBIs and has walked 12 times. From May 14-June 10, he posted a 13-game hitting streak, tied for the longest in the EL this season at the time. From May 1-June 11, Matheny posted a 24-game on-base streak, which was the second-longest in the league this season. In the Eastern League this season, Matheny is ranked seventh in OBP (.386).

**ROBUST:** **Sean Roby** hit his 21st homer of the year on July 4 against the Fightin' Phils, moving him ahead of **David Villar** for the most home runs in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. He added his 22nd homer on July 7 and his 23rd on July 9. Roby is first in the EL in home runs this year ahead of Erie's Kerry Carpenter (22). He has hit 19 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duvall** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

**FITZ ON FIRE:** **Tyler Fitzgerald** has homered five times over his last 10 games played since July 10. He went deep in the series finale against Reading on July 10. He added a solo homer on July 14 in Altoona, hit two solo homers on July 15 and hit another on July 17 in the series finale. He hit .391 (9-for-23) over seven games from July 9-17, but has gone 0-for-14 since returning from the mid-season break.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **Frankie Tostado** is ranked sixth in batting average (.284) and eighth in hits (83). **Sean Roby** is first in homers (23) and ninth in SLG (.493). **Shane Matheny** is seventh in OBP (.386). **Mike Gigliotti** is 10th in OBP (.373) and fourth in stolen bases (22). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for ninth in homers (15).

**WHERE THE PATRIOTS RANK:** In the Eastern League, Anthony Volpe is ranked fourth in doubles (24), tied for first in extra-base hits (38), tied for seventh in total bases (144), fifth in runs scored (54) and second in stolen bases (37). Jeisson Rosario is seventh in walks (47). Elijah Dunham is third in stolen bases (27). Michael Beltre is tied for fifth in stolen bases (21). Carson Coleman is fifth in saves (8).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have five players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Ryan Murphy** (11), **Cole Waites** (19), **Ricardo Genovés** (27) and **Chris Wright** (30). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Simon Whiteman** is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Murphy (11), **Brett Auerbach** (27), Genovés (29) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.
