TODAY'S GAME: The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Single-A Houston Astros) open up a six-game series with the Carolina Mudcats (Single-A Milwaukee Brewers) at Segra Stadium, the Woodpeckers' first home game since July 10. The Mudcats took five out of six games in the previous series between the two teams. LHP Colton Gordon makes his Fayetteville Woodpeckers debut after being called up from the FCL Astros on Thursday while RHP Alexander Cornielle makes his third start against Fayetteville this season for Carolina.

THE OPPONENT: The Carolina Mudcats are in their second season as the Milwaukee Brewers' Single-A affiliate and their fifth season overall with the Brewers. Prior to 2021, the Mudcats spent nine years in High-A with three different organizations, including the Atlanta Braves and Cleveland Guardians. From 1991 through 2011, Carolina was in Double-A, winning a pair of league titles in 1995 and 2003. Former Red Sox starting pitcher Tim Wakefield, then in the Pittsburgh Pirates farm system, earned the first home victory in franchise history on April 19, 1991 over the Greenville Braves.

CERNY NAMED ASTROS POTM: The Houston Astros recently announced that Woodpeckers OF Logan Cerny has the been named the organizational Minor League Player of the Month for June. During June, the 22-year-old Cerny batted .337 (29-for-86) with seven doubles, 5 HR's, 27 RBI and a 1.011 OPS (.418 OBP).593 SLG) in 23 games. This is the second award that Cerny has received this season, also being named the Carolina League Player of the Week back on June 13th. He is having a similarly strong July, slashing .292/.417/.500 and enjoyed the first four-hit game of his career on Friday night against the Cannon Ballers.

THE PROSPECTS: The Woodpeckers are currently carrying three of the Astros Top-30 Prospects on their active roster. RHP Alex Santos is the highest of the trio, sitting at #9. Outfielder Tyler Whitaker sits right behind him at #10 after dropping down a couple of spots. After a red-hot start to the month of June, outfielder Logan Cerny has surged up the rankings, coming in at #24 in the most recent rankings from MLB.com. Fayetteville has also graduated nine players to higher levels in the Astros organization, two position players and seven pitchers

HALLMARK MOMENTS: In the seventh inning of Wednesday night's game in Myrtle Beach, Jaxon Hallmark hit a solo home run over the left field wall that gave the Woodpeckers a 3-1 lead. The blast was the first in Hallmark's professional career since signing with the Astros as an undrafted free agent in 2021 out of the University of Nebraska where he was a first-team All-Big Ten player during the 2021 season. Hallmark is the first player this season to hit his first professional home run with the Woodpeckers. He also homered on Thursday night, making it consecutive games with a homer after going without one over his first 47 games played. Over the last two weeks Hallmark is batting and even .400 (8-for-20, 2 HR, 2B, 4 RBI, 3 BB, 10 K).

RUNNING WILD: The new pitch clock and pick-off rules have led to a huge uptick in stolen bases across the league this season and multiple Woodpeckers are on-pace to steal close to 40 bases this year. With three steals on Friday night against Kannapolis, Logan Cerny became the first Woodpeckers player to touch the 30-stolen-base mark this year and is now tied for sixth in the Carolina League with 31 stolen bases. Joey Loperfido (25) and Cody Orr (24) are the other players to swipe at least 20 bags this season. Myles Straw remains the all-time franchise record holder, swiping 36 bases for the Buies Creek Astros in 2017.

EASY EDDY: RHP Edinson Batista has been among the best arms in the Carolina League over the last two months. Since May 25, Batista has appeared in ten games and has posted a 2.39 ERA over 49 innings while striking out 50 batters, allowing just 18 walks. Additionally, opponents have hit just .184 against the 20-year-old over that period of time.

WRONG SIDE OF HISTORY: On Sunday night in Myrtle Beach, in the final game before the 2022 All-Star Break, the Pelicans used five pitchers (Tyler Shalaffer, Luis Rodríguez, Gregori Montano, Angel Hernandez & Alfredo Zarraga) to no-hit the Woodpeckers over nine innings for the first time in franchise history. The Woodpeckers only base-runners in the game came on five walks and a hit batsman. The offense went a combined 0-for-26 in the game and struck out 16 times.

Recap: The Cannon Ballers took the rubber match of the series in convincing fashion Sunday afternoon. DJ Gladney led the way offensively for Kannapolis, collecting three hits and driving in five runs. The big blow came from Gladney in the bottom of the eighth when he launched a grand slam off of Jacob DeLabio for his league-leading 16th homer of 2022. It was also Gladney's second grand slam against the Woodpeckers this season. Fayetteville grabbed their lone run in the fourth on a Jose Alvarez RBI single, who has two hits in each of his first two Single-A games.

15 Joe Thon Manager Vincent Blue

Thon makes his return to Fayetteville and begins his first season as Woodpeckers manager after serving as a development coach in 2021. As the development coach. Thon helped coach Woodpeckers hitters and fielders, as well as assist with lineup planning and creating reports on individual athletes on the team.

Prior to joining the Astros as a full-time coach, Thon served as a summer intern with the organization during the 2019 summer. He helped analyze and balance revenue summaries, verified accounts for reconciling payments and processed and organized invoices for the Astros and Astros Foundation.

Following his intership, Thon broke into the coaching ranks by joining the University of Houston Baseball program in August 2019 as a student assistant coach before becoming the volunteer assistant prior to the 2020 season. After one season with UofH, Thon returned to the Astros in a full-time coaching role.

The former Minor League infielder enjoyed a seven-year minor league playing career. Thon was drafted in the 5th round (pick 156) by the Toronto Blue Jays in 2010 out of Academia Perpetuo Socorro in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He played in the Blue Jays organizationuntil 2016 when he signed to join the St. Louis Cardinals. Thon played in the Cardinals farm system through 2017, reaching as high as Double-A with the Springfield Cardinals. His playing career concluded in 2017 in the Independent Atlanta League with the Sugar Land Skeeters, now the Triple-A Affiliate of the Astros. In total, Thon appeared in over 500 games across his MiLB career, posting a .243/.356/.318 slash line with 79 doubles, 17 triples, 27 home-runs and 178 RBI. Thon also played for Liga de Beisbol Professional Roberto Clemente in Puerto Rico from 2010 through December 2016.

Thon comes from a deep baseball background. He is the son of former Astros shortstop Dickie Thon, a 1983 All-Star with Houston who enjoyed a 15-year MLB career with the California Angels, Astros, Padres, Phillies, Rangers and Brewers. Joe and his fiance Erika spend their offseason living in Houston with their dogs.

23 Jose Puentes Hitting Coach

Joining the Woodpeckers for his first season with the franchise and third season in the Astros organization is hitting coach Jose Puentes.

Puentes started his career with the Astros as a hitting coach in the Dominican Summer League and most recently served as hitting coach with the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021.

He has coached at the high school level at MacArthur High School, Johnson High School, Steele High School and Wagner High School. From 2006-2007, he was the head baseball coach at St. Anthony Catholic High School. Puentes has owned and operated two hitting academies, Gap to Gap Academy and Cardinals Select Baseball Academy.

He earned his bachelor's degree in Spanish and Master's degree in teaching from University of Incarnate Word along with a Master's degree in education from the University of Texas at San Antonio.

16 John Kovalik Pitching Coach

John Kovalik takes over as the third pitching coach in Woodpeckers history, bringing three years of coaching experience to the Woodpeckers staff. The 30-year-old enters his fourth season in the Astros organization after serving as the pitching coach for the Tri-City Valley Cats in 2019, along with the pitching coach for the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021. While with the Valley Cats, Kovalik coached Astros farmhands and future big leaguers Luis Garcia, Jose Urquidy and Shawn Dubin along with other high-level pitching prospects.

Prior to his time with the Astros, Kovalik spent three seasons as pitching coach (2016-2018) at Slippery Rock University, where he oversaw all aspects of the team's pitching program.
