**TODAY'S GAME:** The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Single-A Houston Astros) conclude a short three-game road series against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers (Single-A Chicago White Sox) at Atrium Health Ballpark. The series is tied 1-1 following a 5-4 loss on Saturday for the Woodpeckers. This is also the final game between the two clubs in the regular season, wrapping up a 24-game season series. Today, the Woodpeckers will send RHP Carlos Calderon to the mound for the start and Kannapolis counters with RHP Jared Kelley.

**THE OPPONENT:** The Kannapolis Cannon Ballers are in their second season in the Carolina League. They were previously known as the Kannapolis Intimidators from 2001-2019 and have been an affiliate of the White Sox since 2001. The Intimidators were a member of the South Atlantic League, winning the league championship in 2005. Over the last two seasons, the Woodpeckers carry a 29-24 overall record against the Cannon Ballers. Fayetteville has won the last seven games played at Atrium Health Ballpark, and with Friday's win, secured the upper-hand in the 2022 season series.

**CERNY NAMED ASTROS POTM:** The Houston Astros recently announced that Woodpeckers OF Logan Cerny has been named the organizational Minor League Player of the Month for June. During June, the 22-year-old Cerny batted .337 (29-for-86) with seven doubles, 5 HR's, 27 RBI and a 1.011 OPS (.418 OBP/.593 SLG) in 23 games. This is the second award that Cerny has received this season, also being named the Carolina League Player of the Week back on June 13th. He is having a similarly strong July, slashing .317/.431/.561 and enjoyed the first four-hit game of his career on Friday night against the Cannon Ballers.

**THE PROSPECTS:** The Woodpeckers are currently carrying three of the Astros Top-30 Prospects on their active roster. RHP Alex Santos is the highest of the trio, sitting at #9. Outfielder Tyler Whitaker sits right behind him at #10 after dropping down a couple of spots. After a red-hot start to the month of June, outfielder Logan Cerny has surged up the rankings, coming in at #24 in the most recent rankings from MLB.com. Fayetteville has also graduated nine players to higher levels in the Astros organization, two position players and seven pitchers.

**HALLMARK MOMENTS:** In the seventh inning of Wednesday night's game in Myrtle Beach, Jaxon Hallmark hit a solo home run over the left field wall that gave the Woodpeckers a 3-1 lead. The blast was the first in Hallmark's professional career since signing with the Astros as an undrafted free agent in 2021 out of the University of Nebraska where he was a first-team All-Big Ten player during the 2021 season. Hallmark is the first player this season to hit his first professional home run with the Woodpeckers. He also homered on Thursday night, making it consecutive games with a homer after going without one over his first 47 games played. Over the last two weeks Hallmark is batting and even .400 (8-for-20, 2 HR, 2B, 4 RBI, 3 BB, 10 K).

**RUNNING WILD:** The new pitch clock and pick-off rules have led to a huge uptick in stolen bases across the league this season and multiple Woodpeckers are on-pace to steal close to 40 bases this year. With three steals on Friday night against Kannapolis, Logan Cerny became the first Woodpeckers player to touch the 30-stolen-base mark this year and is now tied for third in the Carolina League with 21 stolen bases. Joey Loperfido (24) and Cody Orr (22) are the other players to swipe at least 20 bags this season. Myles Straw remains the all-time franchise record holder, swiping 36 bases for the Buies Creek Astros in 2017.

**SOUTHPAWS BEWARE:** Left-handed pitchers have struggled this season facing the Woodpeckers' offense. Fayetteville leads the league in batting average vs. LHP (.246) and also has the highest slugging percentage (.406) and second-highest OPS (.733) against lefties. Joey Loperfido has led the way for the Woodpeckers with a .345 average versus southpaws, the third-highest in the Carolina League.

**WRONG SIDE OF HISTORY:** On Sunday night in Myrtle Beach, in the final game before the 2022 All-Star Break, the Pelicans used five pitchers (Tyler Shalaffer, Luis Rodriguez, Gregori Montano, Angel Hernandez & Alfredo Zarraga) to no-hit the Woodpeckers over nine innings for the first time in franchise history. The Woodpeckers only base-runners in the game came on five walks and a hit batsman. The offense went a combined 0-for-26 in the game and struck out 16 times.

**Recap:** Norge Vera and Miguel Ullola both pitched four scoreless innings in their starts. The Woodpeckers jumped out to a three-run lead in the top of the fifth inning on an RBI double from Yeuris Ramirez, a Jaxon Hallmark sac fly and an RBI single by Logan Cerny. Kannapolis went on to score four unanswered runs on Valente Bellozo. Joey Loperfido tied the game with an RBI single in the seventh, but the Cannon Ballers delivered the final blow with a Veras RBI double in the bottom of the seventh. Liam Jenkins worked around a pair of walks in the ninth to earn his first save.

## WOODPECKERS FIELD STAFF

### 15 Joe Thon

Manager

Thon makes his return to Fayetteville and begins his first season as Woodpeckers manager after serving as a development coach in 2021. As the development coach, Thon helped coach Woodpeckers hitters and fielders, as well as assist with lineup planning and creating reports on individual athletes on the team.

Prior to joining the Astros as a full-time coach, Thon served as a summer intern with the organization during the 2019 summer. He helped analyze and balance revenue summaries, verified accounts for reconciling payments and processed and organized invoices for the Astros and Astros Foundation.

Following his internship, Thon broke into the coaching ranks by joining the University of Houston Baseball program in August 2019 as a student assistant coach before becoming the volunteer assistant prior to the 2020 season. After one season with UofH, Thon returned to the Astros in a full-time coaching role.

The former Minor League infielder enjoyed a seven-year minor league playing career. Thon was drafted in the 5th round (pick 156) by the Toronto Blue Jays in 2010 out of Academia Perpetuo Socorro in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He played in the Blue Jays organization until 2016 when he signed to join the St. Louis Cardinals. Thon played in the Cardinals farm system through 2017, reaching as high as Double-A with the Springfield Cardinals. His playing career concluded in 2017 in the Independent Atlanta League with the Sugar Land Skeeters, now the Triple-A Affiliate of the Astros. In total, Thon appeared in over 500 games across his MiLB career, posting a .243/.356/.318 slash line with 79 doubles, 17 triples, 27 home-runs and 178 RBI. Thon also played for Liga de Beisbol Profesional Roberto Clemente in Puerto Rico from 2010 through December 2016.

Thon comes from a deep baseball background. He is the son of former Astros shortstop Dickie Thon, a 1983 All-Star with Houston who enjoyed a 15-year MLB career with the California Angels, Astros, Padres, Phillies, Rangers and Brewers. Joe and his fiancé Erika spend their offseason living in Houston with their dogs.

### 23 Jose Puentes

Hitting Coach

Joining the Woodpeckers for his first season with the franchise and third season in the Astros organization is hitting coach Jose Puentes.

Puentes started his career with the Astros as a hitting coach in the Dominican Summer League and most recently served as hitting coach with the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021.

He has coached at the high school level at MacArthur High School, Johnson High School, Steele High School and Wagner High School. From 2006-2007, he was the head baseball coach at St. Anthony Catholic High School. Puentes has owned and operated two hitting academies, Gap to Gap Academy and Cardinals Select Baseball Academy.

He earned his bachelor's degree in Spanish and Master's degree in teaching from University of Incarnate Word along with a Master's degree in education from the University of Texas at San Antonio.

### 16 John Kovalik

Pitching Coach

John Kovalik takes over as the third pitching coach in Woodpeckers history, bringing three years of coaching experience to the Woodpeckers staff. The 30-year-old enters his fourth season in the Astros organization after serving as the pitching coach for the Tri-City Valley Cats in 2019, along with the pitching coach for the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021. While with the Valley Cats, Kovalik coached Astros farmhands and future big leaguers Luis Garcia, Jose Urquidy and Shawn Dubin along with other high-level pitching prospects.

Prior to his time with the Astros, Kovalik spent three seasons as pitching coach (2016-2018) at Slippery Rock University, where he oversaw all aspects of the team's pitching program.
