TODAY'S GAME: The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Single-A Houston Astros) try to stop a three-game losing skid against the Carolina Mudcats (Single-A Milwaukee Brewers) at Segra Stadium. The Mudcats have been dominant in the season series, winning 10 of the 14 games between the two teams and each of the last six. Fayetteville hands the ball over to RHP Edinson Batista, who has an earned run average of 0.84 against Carolina this year. Meanwhile the Mudcats send RHP Stiven Cruz to the hill who has been equally impressive in the season series. holding the Woodpeckers scoreless over nine innings so far in 2022.

THE OPPONENT: The Carolina Mudcats are in their second season as the Milwaukee Brewers' Single-A affiliate and their fifth season overall with the Brewers. Prior to 2021, the Mudcats spent nine years in High-A with three different organizations, including the Atlanta Braves and Cleveland Guardians. From 1991 through 2011, Carolina was in Double-A, winning a pair of league titles in 1995 and 2003. Former Red Sox starting pitcher Tim Wakefield, then in the Pittsburgh Pirates farm system, earned the first home victory in franchise history on April 19, 1991 over the Greenville Braves.

THE UNTOUCHABLES: Despite a 7-5 loss Wednesday night against the Carolina Mudcats, the Woodpeckers had one of their best games of the season when it came to striking out batters. As a team, Fayetteville fanned 18 Mudcat hitters, tying the most strikeouts as a team since Opening Night on April 8 in Kannapolis. Woodpeckers starter Deylen Miley picked up six strikeouts, reliever Nic Swanson added five to the total, and Jacob Delabio went 2.2 perfect innings while whiffing a season-high six batters.

THE PROSPECTS: The Woodpeckers are currently carrying three of the Astros Top-30 Prospects on their active roster. RHP Alex Santos is the highest of the trio, sitting at #9. Outfielder Tyler Whitaker sits right behind him at #10 after dropping down a couple of spots. After a red-hot start to the month of June, outfielder Logan Cerny has surged up the rankings, coming in at #24 in the most recent rankings from MLB.com. Fayetteville has also graduated nine players to higher levels in the Astros organization, two position players and seven pitchers

HALLMARK MOMENTS: In the seventh inning of Wednesday night's game in Myrtle Beach, Jaxon Hallmark hit a solo home run over the left field wall that gave the Woodpeckers a 3-1 lead. The blast was the first in Hallmark's professional career since signing with the Astros as an undrafted free agent in 2021 out of the University of Nebraska where he was a first-team All-Big Ten player during the 2021 season. Hallmark is the first player this season to hit his first professional home run with the Woodpeckers. He also homered on Thursday night, making it consecutive games with a homer after going without one over his first 47 games played. Over the last ten games, Hallmark is batting .344 with 2 HR, 2B, 5 RBI, 5 BB, and 5 SB.

RUNNING WILD: The new pitch clock and pick-off rules have led to a huge uptick in stolen bases across the league this season and multiple Woodpeckers are on-pace to steal close to 40 bases this year. With three steals on Friday night against Kannapolis, Logan Cerny became the first Woodpeckers player to touch the 30-stolen-base mark this year and is now tied for sixth in the Carolina League with 31 stolen bases. Joey Loperfido (25) and Cody Orr (24) are the other players to swipe at least 20 bags this season. Myles Straw remains the all-time franchise record holder, swiping 36 bases for the Buies Creek Astros in 2017.

EAZY E: RHP Edinson Batista has been among the best arms in the Carolina League over the last two months. Since May 25, Batista has appeared in ten games and has posted a 2.39 ERA over 49 innings while striking out 50 batters, allowing just 18 walks. Additionally, opponents have hit just .184 against the 20-year-old over that period of time.

A DAZZLING DEBUT: On Tuesday night, for the first time all season, a lefthanded pitcher took the mound for the Fayetteville Woodpeckers. It was former Central Florida hurler Colton Gordon and he did not disappoint in his full-season minor league debut. Gordon got the start for the Woodpeckers and pitched four efficient innings, surrendering just one earned run on three hits. He did not allow any walks and struck out five Carolina batters. The Astros ninth-round pick in the 2021 Draft completed his recovery from Tommy John surgery earlier in the year and had six impressive outings in the Complex League before joining Fayetteville on July 21.

The Woodpeckers made things interesting though as Tyler Whitaker launched a two-run home run to bring the deficit within three. In the ninth, Guilamo and Jaxon Hallmark reached with nobody out but Carolina's Jeferson Figueroa shook off a throwing error and struck out the side to clinch the Mudcats' fourth straight victory.

15 Joe Thon Manager Vincent Blue

Thon makes his return to Fayetteville and begins his first season as Woodpeckers manager after serving as a development coach in 2021. As the development coach. Thon helped coach Woodpeckers hitters and fielders, as well as assist with lineup planning and creating reports on individual athletes on the team.

Prior to joining the Astros as a full-time coach, Thon served as a summer intern with the organization during the 2019 summer. He helped analyze and balance revenue summaries, verified accounts for reconciling payments and processed and organized invoices for the Astros and Astros Foundation.

Following his intership, Thon broke into the coaching ranks by joining the University of Houston Baseball program in August 2019 as a student assistant coach before becoming the volunteer assistant prior to the 2020 season. After one season with UofH, Thon returned to the Astros in a full-time coaching role.

The former Minor League infielder enjoyed a seven-year minor league playing career. Thon was drafted in the 5th round (pick 156) by the Toronto Blue Jays in 2010 out of Academia Perpetuo Socorro in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He played in the Blue Jays organizationuntil 2016 when he signed to join the St. Louis Cardinals. Thon played in the Cardinals farm system through 2017, reaching as high as Double-A with the Springfield Cardinals. His playing career concluded in 2017 in the Independent Atlanta League with the Sugar Land Skeeters, now the Triple-A Affiliate of the Astros. In total, Thon appeared in over 500 games across his MiLB career, posting a .243/.356/.318 slash line with 79 doubles, 17 triples, 27 home-runs and 178 RBI. Thon also played for Liga de Beisbol Professional Roberto Clemente in Puerto Rico from 2010 through December 2016.

Thon comes from a deep baseball background. He is the son of former Astros shortstop Dickie Thon, a 1983 All-Star with Houston who enjoyed a 15-year MLB career with the California Angels, Astros, Padres, Phillies, Rangers and Brewers. Joe and his fiance Erika spend their offseason living in Houston with their dogs.

23 Jose Puentes Hitting Coach

Joining the Woodpeckers for his first season with the franchise and third season in the Astros organization is hitting coach Jose Puentes.

Puentes started his career with the Astros as a hitting coach in the Dominican Summer League and most recently served as hitting coach with the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021.

He has coached at the high school level at MacArthur High School, Johnson High School, Steele High School and Wagner High School. From 2006-2007, he was the head baseball coach at St. Anthony Catholic High School. Puentes has owned and operated two hitting academies, Gap to Gap Academy and Cardinals Select Baseball Academy.

He earned his bachelor's degree in Spanish and Master's degree in teaching from University of Incarnate Word along with a Master's degree in education from the University of Texas at San Antonio.

16 John Kovalik Pitching Coach

John Kovalik takes over as the third pitching coach in Woodpeckers history, bringing three years of coaching experience to the Woodpeckers staff. The 30-year-old enters his fourth season in the Astros organization after serving as the pitching coach for the Tri-City Valley Cats in 2019, along with the pitching coach for the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021. While with the Valley Cats, Kovalik coached Astros farmhands and future big leaguers Luis Garcia, Jose Urquidy and Shawn Dubin along with other high-level pitching prospects.

Prior to his time with the Astros, Kovalik spent three seasons as pitching coach (2016-2018) at Slippery Rock University, where he oversaw all aspects of the team's pitching program.

Kovalik earned his bachelor's degree from Slippery Rock, where he also pitched for the baseball team. Following his college career he played four seasons in the Independent leagues for the Frontier Grevs and the Gary-Southshore Railcats. Kovalik trained at Driveline Baseball during the 2016 and 2017 offseasons.
