**SUNDAY:** The Flying Squirrels' homestand finale against the Patriots was canceled due to rain. The game will not be made up. Richmond is now scheduled to play 137 games this year. The Flying Squirrels went 1-4 in the series and 2-6 on the homestand.

**WHIFF:** On Saturday night, the Flying Squirrels' pitching staff set a franchise record with 21 strikeouts. It tied the most strikeouts by one team in the Eastern League since the Bowie Baysox struck out 24 against the Flying Squirrels in 2011 in an 18-inning game. The 21 strikeouts for Richmond were the most strikeouts in 11-or-less innings in an Eastern League game since at least 2005. **Kai-Wei Teng** and **Randy Rodriguez** each picked up six strikeouts, **Ryan Walker** had three, **Nick Avila** and **Cole Waites** had two each and **Blake Rivera** and **Clay Helvey** each struck out one batter.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. This series is the only set of games between the two teams this year. The Flying Squirrels and Fisher Cats have not played each other since 2019. That year, the Flying Squirrels won the first head-to-head game in Manchester, 14-5, on June 7 before dropping the final two of the series and all three games at The Diamond from June 14-16. This series marks the first set for the Flying Squirrels on the road against an opponent from the Northeast Division this season.

**WE ARE HEADED NORTH:** The Flying Squirrels are in the first leg of a 12-game road trip to New England, their first visit to the league's two northernmost cities since the 2019 season. The two series against New Hampshire and Portland are the Flying Squirrels' only two sets this year on the road against Eastern League Northeast Division Richmond does not visit Binghamton, Hartford, Somerset or Reading this season, although all four of those teams have played or will play in Richmond. New Hampshire is the only Eastern League team that does not visit The Diamond this season.

**TICKET PUNCHED:** The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 8-18 to open the second half. They have lost 10-of-the-last-12 games, including a season-high six-game losing streak from July 14-23 and three straight before Friday night's win over the Patriots. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost seven and split three this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 1,043 strikeouts (11.0 per game) and rank fourth with 120 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 21-24 on the road this year. Richmond is 22-18 in games decided by two-or-less runs and 9-14 overall against teams from the Northeast Division, all at The Diamond.

**THE FISHER CATS** have won five-of-seven since July 23, including winning four-of-six in last week's series at Binghamton. New Hampshire's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 prospects (four active), including INF Orelvis Martinez (No. 2), RHP Adam Kloffenstein (No. 11), RHP Hagen Danner (No. 17 - on IL), RHP Yosver Zulueta (No. 19), RHP Trent Palmer (No. 23 - on IL), RHP Joey Murray (No. 24 - out for season) and OF Sebastian Espino (No. 25).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Jake Dahlberg** makes his 18th start of the season. He last pitched on Wednesday afternoon against the Patriots and allowed two runs over 5.1 innings in a loss. The Flying Squirrels have lost each of his last eight starts since June 10 despite Dahlberg allowed three-or-less runs in six of them. He is currently ranked 10th in the Eastern League in innings pitched (85.1). Dahlberg spent parts of three seasons with the independent Chicago Dogs before signing with the Giants during the 2021 season. He joined the High-A Eugene Emeralds in July and made 10 starts, going 2-5 with a 6.60 ERA. He closed the year with two outings with Triple-A Sacramento and tossed 9.0 scoreless innings. After being named Horizon League Pitcher of the Year twice at the University of Illinois-Chicago, he was selected in the 21st round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. **For more on Dahlberg, see page two.**

**FOR NEW HAMPSHIRE:** Right-hander Alejandro Melean makes his second Double-A start. He made his Double-A debut last Tuesday at Binghamton and allowed one run over 2.2 innings. Melean started the season with High-A Vancouver, where he went 2-1 with a 1.69 ERA in nine outings, including five starts. He signed with the Blue Jays as an international free agent in 2017. He spent his first year at the full-season level in 2021, beginning the year with Low-A Dunedin, where he went 3-5 with a 5.29 ERA in 19 games (10 starts). He was promoted to High-A Vancouver at the end of August and made four starts for the Canadians, going 1-1 with a 4.74 ERA.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in total attendance (296,258) and average attendance (6,172). Richmond is 14th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

**MOVING UP:** On Friday, Flying Squirrels infielder **Shane Matheny** was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento. He left Richmond ranked fifth in the Eastern League in OBP (.391), eighth in walks (46) and 10th in wRC+ (132). In his last at-bat prior to the promotion, Matheny hit a two-run homer on Friday night, his 10th of the year. From May 14-June 10, he posted a 13-game hitting streak, tied for the longest in the EL this season at the time. From May 1-June 11, Matheny posted a 24-game on-base streak, which was the second-longest in the league this season. He made his Triple-A debut for the River Cats on Saturday at Round Rock and went 1-for-5.

**POWER SURGE:** The Richmond offense has hit 120 home runs this season, which is fourth in the Eastern League. **Sean Roby** is second in the league with 23 homers on the season, with 19 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 173 home runs. The Flying Squirrels have already hit more homers than entire seasons in every season except 2021, including 2010 (71), 2011 (83) 2012 (76), 2013 (109), 2014 (74) and 2015 (61), 2016 (83), 2017 (93) and 2019 (84).

**GO, DIEGO, GO!** After hitting .173 (22-for-127) over his first 35 games of the season, **Diego Rincones** is batting .317 (44-for-139) with six doubles, seven homers and 28 RBIs over his last 36 games since June 7. He went 4-for-4 with a homer last Saturday, his second four-hit game of the season. He added two hits on Sunday afternoon, including a game-winning single. Rincones is 0-for-19 in five games in this week's series against the Patriots.

**ROBUST:** **Sean Roby** hit his 21st homer of the year on July 4 against the Fightin' Phils, moving him ahead of **David Villar** for the most home runs in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. He added his 22nd homer on July 7 and his 23rd on July 9. Roby is second in the EL in home runs this year behind New Hampshire's Orelvis Martinez (24). He has hit 19 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duvall** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

**FITZ ON FIRE:** **Tyler Fitzgerald** homered five times, all solo shots, over a six-game span from July 10-17 heading into the mid-season break. In that stretch, he hit .421 (8-for-19). He went deep in the series finale against Reading on July 10. He added a solo homer on July 14 in Altoona, hit two solo homers on July 15 and hit another on July 17 in the series finale. In his first four games out of the mid-season break from July 22-27, he went 0-for-14, but he has picked up four hits in his last four games, including a three-run homer on Saturday night.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **Frankie Tostado** is ranked sixth in batting average (.284). **Sean Roby** is second in homers (23) and ninth in SLG (.493). **Shane Matheny** is fifth in OBP (.391). **Mike Gigliotti** is 10th in OBP (.375), tied for eighth in walks (47) and tied for fourth in stolen bases (23). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for ninth in homers (16). **Ryan Walker** is tied for sixth in games pitched (32).

**WHERE THE FISHER CATS RANK:** In the Eastern League, Spencer Horwitz is fourth in batting average (.297), first in OBP (.413), seventh in SLG (.517) and third in OPS (.930). Orelvis Martinez is ranked first in homers (24), tied for fourth in RBIs (60), tied for sixth in extra-base hits (37) and ninth in total bases (150). Rafael Lantigua is second in doubles (27) and tied for eighth in runs scored (52). Parker Caracci is tied for sixth in games pitched (32).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have five players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Ryan Murphy** (11), **Cole Waites** (19), **Ricardo Genoves** (27) and **Chris Wright** (30). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. Waites is listed as having the "Best Fastball." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Murphy (11), **Brett Auerbach** (27), Genoves (29) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 21 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 24 overall prospect.
