## TODAY'S HEADLINES

**LAST GAME'S RESULT** - Devin Smeltzer pitched 5.0 strong innings, but the offense could only muster a couple of runs in a 6-2 loss to the Iowa Cubs on Tuesday evening at CHS Field. Smeltzer pitched 5.0 innings allowing one run on four hits while walking one and striking out six. Tim Beckham collected two hits and an RBI while Jermaine Palacios also went 2-4.

**BAT IT LIKE BECKHAM:** Since Tim Beckham joined the Saints and played his first game on June 1, he has been on fire. Across 30 games, Beckham has 18 multi-hit games which includes four, three-hit games and a four-hit game. Since June 1, he leads the International League with a .414 average, a full 50 points better than a familiar name, Travis Blankenhorn of Syracuse, who began 2021 with the Saints. Beckham also leads the league in OBP (.485), and OPS (1.080) and is fifth in slugging (.595) during that time.

**THE "K" MEN:** Saints pitchers struck out 10 Iowa Cubs on Tuesday. It's the 35th time Saints pitchers have fanned the opposition double-digit times. They have also struck out double-digit hitters in four straight games. It's the second time this season they have struck out double-digit hitters in four straight games. The franchise record is five straight games which they did from June 28-July 2.

**END OF GAME PAIN:** For the 10th time this season the Saints were walked-off on July 23. The Saints have had nine roadtrips and they have had a walk-off loss in six of the nine series. Last season the Saints were walked-off a total of nine times across 140 games.

**NOT PART OF HIS WORLD:** Ariel Jurado was masterful on Sunday, July 24 at Indianapolis. He retired all 10 batters he faced in 3.1 perfect innings while striking out three. Adding his last outing, Jurado has retired the last 13 batter he has faced. It's the longest perfect outing by any reliever this season surpassing the 3.0 perfect innings by Tyler Viza on June 3 @ Iowa. The only outing longer without allowing a hit was Mario Sanchez' 4.0 hitless innings, where he walked one, on June 8 vs. Rochester.

**LOCKED IN WHEN LOADED:** Jermaine Palacios crushed a grand slam on July 22 @ Indianapolis. It was the sixth grand slam hit by the Saints this season and the first of Palacios' career. The six grand slams are tied with Columbus for the most in the International League and are tied for the fourth most in Minor League Baseball only behind Reno (8), Albuquerque (7) and Lake County (7).

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Saints collected one double on Tuesday evening against Iowa and continue to be at the top of the Minor Leagues in two baggers. Overall, the Saints have collected 172 doubles, tied for 16th in all of Minor League Baseball.

**RISPY (WITH 2 OUTS) BUSINESS:** The St. Paul Saints managed to not give up a run with a runner in scoring position and two outs on Tuesday night. With RISP/2 outs this season, opponents are hitting .278 against the Saints, fourth worst in all of Minor League Baseball. Tacoma has the highest average at .308, El Paso is second at .294, and Memphis is third at .280.

**FIRST INNING FLOP:** The St. Paul Saints have allowed at least one run in the first inning in 39 of 92 games (42.4%). They have allowed 82 runs in the first, most in the International League and tied for fourth most in all of Minor League Baseball behind Albuquerque (102), Stockton (90), and Binghamton (84). Visalia has also allowed 82 runs. Their 21 home runs allowed are sixth most in Minor League Baseball.

**EXTRA EXTRA READ ALL ABOUT IT:** The St. Paul Saints have played 92 games this season and have an extra base hit in all, but one game. They have an extra base hit in 84 consecutive games, the second longest streak in all of Minor League Baseball. The only team with a longer streak is El Paso's 94 game streak, which is also active. The lone game they didn't collect an extra base hit was the game they were no-hit on April 13 vs. Indianapolis. They have just one extra base hit in only 10 games.

**FINAL FOUR:** The St. Paul Saints are a part of the final four, but not a final four they care to be included in. The Saints have yet to throw a shutout in 2022. They are one of only four Minor League teams that have yet to throw a shutout. They are joined by the Chattanooga Lookouts in the Southern League, Columbia Fireflies in the Carolina League, and the Visalia Rawhide in the California League. The Saints 5.35 ERA in the third highest of the four teams. Chattanooga has the best ERA at 5.23, Columbia is second at 5.24, while Visalia is 6.06. The Charlotte Knights and Delmarva Shorebirds took their names off the list with a shutout on July 10.

**WE BELIEVE THE PROSPECTS ARE OUR FUTURE:** On July 7, Spencer Steer was chosen to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium. Steer is one of two Minnesota Twins Minor Leaguers to be chosen. He joins newly promoted outfielder Matt Wallner. Steer is the first Saints player chosen to the Futures Game. Josh Winder, who was chosen in 2021, was called up to the Saints two days before the announcement, but hadn't pitched for the Saints. Wallner delivered in the game going 1-2 with a home run while Steer was 0-2.

**TWINS UPDATE** - The Minnesota Twins dropped their first game of the series to the Milwaukee Brewers 7-6 on Tuesday night at American Family Field. Byron Buxton hit his 24th homer and Gio Urshela hit his ninth. Jose Miranda was 3-4 with two RBI.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** 7/15 vs. TOL...pitched 5.2 innings allowing four runs on five hits, giving up one home runs, while striking out four...received the loss in a 7-3 Mud Hens victory.

**APPEARANCE PRIOR:** 7/9 @ LOU...tossed 6.0 innings allowing three runs on six hits, giving up one home run, while striking out four...did not receive a decision in a 10-9, 10 inning Bats victory.

**SAILING ON THE SAME SHIP:** Aaron's step Dad, Mike Shipley, was selected twice by the California Angels in 1976. Once in the 10th round of the January Draft-regular phase and then again in June-secondary phase. Shipley, however, would never pitch for the Angels organization because he suffered a left shoulder injury.

**HEARD IT THROUGH THE GRAPEVINE:** The city of Barstow, California, once known as Grapevine, is the birthplace of Aaron Sanchez. He is believed to be the first ever Major Leaguer born in Barstow. After his debut and successful first season in the Majors in 2014, the Barstow City Council declared October 20, 2014 to be "Aaron Sanchez Day"

**WALKS DON'T ALWAYS WARE ON YOU:** Aaron Sanchez recorded his first win as a Major League starter on April 22, 2015. He became the first Blue Jays pitcher to win despite walking seven since Jeff Ware in 1995. He pitched 5.1 innings allowing two runs on two hits while walking seven and striking out four.

**BIG GAME PITCHER:** In the 2015 ALDS, Sanchez appeared in all five game of the 2015 Division Series against the Texas Rangers and did not allow a run in 5.1 IP. He got the win in Game 5 of the ALDS, the game Bautista hit the memorable bat flip homer.

**HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR:** In 2016, Aaron Sanchez was one of the more dominant pitchers in the American League. Despite his amazing numbers, he wasn't selected to the All-Star game...initially. That was until Craig Kimbrel needed surgery on a torn miniscus. Sanchez got his first, and only, Major League All-Star nod. Sanchez got Wil Meyers to ground out, walked Buster Posey, gave up a single to Anthony Rizzo, an RBI single to Marcel Ozuna, a lineout by Carlos Gonzalez, and a groundout by Addison Russel.

**ALL I DO IS WIN:** On July 25, 2016 Sanchez won his 10th straight decision becoming the first Blue Jay since Roy Halladay in 2003 to win at least 10 consecutive decisions.

**POR ME:** At the end of the 2016 season, Aaron Sanchez led the American League in ERA at 3.00. Despite going 15-2 with a 3.00 ERA and fanning 161 in 192.0 IP he finished seventh in the Cy Young balloting. Rick Porcello of the Boston Red Sox, who went 22-4 with a 3.15 ERA and 189 strikeouts in 223.0 IP, took the award. He edged out Justin Verlander 137.0-132.0. Sanchez wasn't even the highest Cy Young finisher on his own team. J.A. Happ finished sixth going 20-4 with a 3.18 ERA and 163 strikeouts in 195.0 innings pitched.

**GONE FISHING:** When Aaron Sanchez walked into the Saints clubhouse, there was a face he should have recognized. On July 31, 2019, Sanchez was traded from the Blue Jays to the Houston Astros along with RHP Joe Biagini and OF Cal Stevenson in exchange for OF Derek Fisher, current Saints outfielder.

**GREAT FIRST IMPRESSION:** Following the trade to the Astros, in Sanchez' first start he went 6.0 no-hit innings. The Astros would finish off a combined no-hitter as Will Harris (1.0 IP), Joe Biagini (1.0 IP), who was a part of the trade, and Chris Devenski (1.0 IP) finished it off.

- Signed a Minor League contract with the Washington Nationals on March 16, 2022
- Joined San Francisco near the start of Spring Training in 2021. Pitched fewest Major League innings (35.2 IP) since appearing in eight games with Toronto in 2017
- Missed the 2020 season recovering from a shoulder injury to repair a torn capsule in his throwing shoulder that he suffered in September of 2019
- Began the 2019 season with Toronto posting a 3-14 record in 23 games
- Posted a 4-6 record in his final full season with the Blue Jays in 2017. Toronto won seven of the last nine starts Sanchez made with the Major League team. Pitched 6.0 IP or more in 10 of his 20 Major League starts
