TODAY'S GAME: The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Single-A Houston Astros) continue a six-game road series against the Salem Red Sox (Single-A Boston Red Sox). This is the second series between the two sides this year and game eight of the 12-game season series. Fayetteville currently leads this series 1-0 after an 8-4 win on Tuesday night. Tonight, the Woodpeckers will start RHP Alex Santos and the Red Sox will hand the ball to RHP Gabriel Jackson.

LOPE GETS THE CALL: Following Sunday afternoon's ballgame, Woodpeckers OF/IF Joey Loperfido was promoted to High-A Asheville, joining Quincy Hamilton, Kenedy Corona, and Miguel Palma as one of four 2022 Fayetteville position players to receive a promotion this season. Loperfido had the fourth-highest batting average in the Carolina League (.304) at the time of his promotion and hit 9 home runs while driving in 45 runs. The former Duke Blue Devil was in the midst of one of his best stretches of his minor league career, slashing .343/.477/.714 with 3 HR and 8 RBI over his final ten games with the Woodpeckers

THE UNTOUCHABLES: The Fayetteville pitching staff has put together one of its most impressive stretches of the season last week against the Mudcats. On Wednesday night, Deylen Miley, Fabricio Reina, Nic Swanson, and Jacob DeLabio combined for 18 strikeouts, the most by the Woodpeckers in a single nine-inning game in 2022. Edinson Batista and Alex Santos followed up that performance with a combined 16 Ks in Thursday's 5-1 victory. Most recently, the trio of Valente Bellozo, Miguel Ullola, and Kasey Ford put up 17 punch outs Friday night.

THE PROSPECTS: The Woodpeckers are currently carrying three of the Astros Top-30 Prospects on their active roster. RHP Alex Santos is the highest of the trio, sitting at #9. Outfielder Tyler Whitaker sits right behind him at #10 after dropping down a couple of spots. After a red-hot start to the month of June, outfielder Logan Cerny has surged up the rankings, coming in at #24 in the most recent rankings from MLB.com. Fayetteville has also graduated nine players to higher levels in the Astros organization, two position players and seven pitchers.

THIRD HITS A CHARM: The Woodpeckers have had a handful of three-hit games as of recent. On Tuesday night in the series opener with Salem, Cody Orr, Leosdany Molina and Yeuris Ramirez each had a three hit game. It was the second straight game with three hits for Orr after going 3-5 on Sunday against Carolina, and the first three-hit game of the season for Ramirez.

RUNNING WILD: The new pitch clock and pick-off rules have led to a huge uptick in stolen bases across the league this season and multiple Woodpeckers are on-pace to steal close to 40 bases this year. With three steals last Friday night against Kannapolis, Logan Cerny became the first Woodpeckers player to touch the 30-sto-len-base mark this year and is now tied for fifth in the Carolina League with 33 stolen bases. Joey Loperfido (30) and Cody Orr (24) are the other players to swipe at least 20 bags this season. Myles Straw remains the all-time franchise record holder, swiping 36 bases for the Buies Creek Astros in 2017.

EAZY E: RHP Edinson Batista has been among the best arms in the Carolina League all season long. The Fayetteville righty now owns the fourth-lowest earned run average among qualified pitchers in the league (2.97). Batista continued his strong month of July on Thursday night with five shutout innings and eight strikeouts against the Carolina Mudcats. He has a 3-1 record and a 2.39 ERA in July over 26.1 innings.

THE PRICE IS RIGHT: Ahead of this week's series in Salem, the Woodpeckers added their first 2022 draft pick to the roster. C/OF Collin Price, who was taken in the sixth round by the Houston Astros in last month's draft, was called up from the Complex League on Tuesday. Price wrapped up his senior season at Mercer University earlier this year, hitting .315 with 18 home runs and 52 runs batted in for the Bears. Price hails from Suwanee, GA and went to Lambert High School, which coincidentally is the alma mater of former Fayetteville Woodpecker Seth Beer, who is now with the Arizona Diamondbacks.

CERNY'S HISTORIC HOMER: Logan Cerny hit his 15th homer of the season on Tuesday night in Salem, entering a tie with Jake Adams of 2019 for the most home runs in a single season in Woodpeckers history dating back to 2019. J.J. Matijevic holds the all-time single season HR record with 19 HR for the Buies Creek in 2018.

Recap: The Woodpeckers put up 14 hits on the Red Sox to win the series opener .8-4. Yeuris Ramirez, Cody Orr and Leosdany Molina all contributed with three hit games. Jose Alvarez put the Woodpeckers ahead with a two-run triple in the seventh inning and Logan Cerny provided insurance with a two-run homer, his team-leading 15th of the season. Kasey Ford closed out the game with two scoreless innings of relief work and Deylen Miley earned his first winning decision since April 28th.

15 Joe Thon Manager Vincent Blue

Thon makes his return to Fayetteville and begins his first season as Woodpeckers manager after serving as a development coach in 2021. As the development coach. Thon helped coach Woodpeckers hitters and fielders, as well as assist with lineup planning and creating reports on individual athletes on the team.

Prior to joining the Astros as a full-time coach, Thon served as a summer intern with the organization during the 2019 summer. He helped analyze and balance revenue summaries, verified accounts for reconciling payments and processed and organized invoices for the Astros and Astros Foundation.

Following his intership, Thon broke into the coaching ranks by joining the University of Houston Baseball program in August 2019 as a student assistant coach before becoming the volunteer assistant prior to the 2020 season. After one season with UofH, Thon returned to the Astros in a full-time coaching role.

The former Minor League infielder enjoyed a seven-year minor league playing career. Thon was drafted in the 5th round (pick 156) by the Toronto Blue Jays in 2010 out of Academia Perpetuo Socorro in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He played in the Blue Jays organizationuntil 2016 when he signed to join the St. Louis Cardinals. Thon played in the Cardinals farm system through 2017, reaching as high as Double-A with the Springfield Cardinals. His playing career concluded in 2017 in the Independent Atlanta League with the Sugar Land Skeeters, now the Triple-A Affiliate of the Astros. In total, Thon appeared in over 500 games across his MiLB career, posting a .243/.356/.318 slash line with 79 doubles, 17 triples, 27 home-runs and 178 RBI. Thon also played for Liga de Beisbol Professional Roberto Clemente in Puerto Rico from 2010 through December 2016.

Thon comes from a deep baseball background. He is the son of former Astros shortstop Dickie Thon, a 1983 All-Star with Houston who enjoyed a 15-year MLB career with the California Angels, Astros, Padres, Phillies, Rangers and Brewers. Joe and his fiance Erika spend their offseason living in Houston with their dogs.

23 Jose Puentes Hitting Coach

Joining the Woodpeckers for his first season with the franchise and third season in the Astros organization is hitting coach Jose Puentes.

Puentes started his career with the Astros as a hitting coach in the Dominican Summer League and most recently served as hitting coach with the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021.

He has coached at the high school level at MacArthur High School, Johnson High School, Steele High School and Wagner High School. From 2006-2007, he was the head baseball coach at St. Anthony Catholic High School. Puentes has owned and operated two hitting academies, Gap to Gap Academy and Cardinals Select Baseball Academy.

He earned his bachelor's degree in Spanish and Master's degree in teaching from University of Incarnate Word along with a Master's degree in education from the University of Texas at San Antonio.

16 John Kovalik Pitching Coach

John Kovalik takes over as the third pitching coach in Woodpeckers history, bringing three years of coaching experience to the Woodpeckers staff. The 30-year-old enters his fourth season in the Astros organization after serving as the pitching coach for the Tri-City Valley Cats in 2019, along with the pitching coach for the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021. While with the Valley Cats, Kovalik coached Astros farmhands and future big leaguers Luis Garcia, Jose Urquidy and Shawn Dubin along with other high-level pitching prospects.

Prior to his time with the Astros, Kovalik spent three seasons as pitching coach (2016-2018) at Slippery Rock University, where he oversaw all aspects of the team's pitching program.

Kovalik earned his bachelor's degree from Slippery Rock, where he also pitched for the baseball team. Following his college career he played four seasons in the Independent leagues for the Frontier Grevs and the Gary-Southshore Railcats. Kovalik trained at Driveline Baseball during the 2016 and 2017 offseasons.

Jones previously worked as an assistant strength and conditioning coach with Missouri State University from October 2020-July 2021. He was also a strength and conditioning intern with TCU from August 2020-October 2020 and a volunteer assistant strength and conditioning coach at UC Irvine.

He earned his bachelor's degree in Kinesiology and Exercise Science from California State Polytechnic University-Pomona in 2016 and his master's degree in Kinesiology and exercise science from Concordia University Irvine in 2019. Matt resides in Costa Mesa, California during the offseason.
