THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this date in 1999, the Nashville Sounds set a franchise record with 6 home runs in a game at Memphis. The Sounds finished with a franchise-high 183 homers that season.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Charlotte Knights face off in game five of the six-game series tonight. The Sounds won their fourth-straight with a 4-2 win last night. Right-hander Josh Lindblom will start for Nashville and left-hander Steven Moyers will make a spot start for Charlotte.

Josh Lindblom: 35-year-old Josh Lindblom starts for the Sounds tonight. The right-hander is 3-6 with a 5.09 ERA (81.1 IP/46 ER) in 17 games (15 starts) with Nashville this season. Lindblom entered in relief on July 24 at Louisville and took the loss (1.2 IP, 5 H, 6 R, 4 ER, 1 BB, 2 K). He has faced Charlotte once this season, taking the loss in a start on April 21st at First Horizon Park. Lindblom allowed three runs in that outing but added eight strikeouts in five innings pitched. In 2021, he was named a MiLB.com Organization All-Star after going 5-4 with a 3.10 ERA in 22 games (20 starts) with the Sounds last season. Lindblom was signed by Milwaukee after the 2019 season. This is his 15th season in professional baseball. The Lafayette, Ind. native was originally selected by the Dodgers in the Second Round of the 2009 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Purdue University.

Steven Moyers: 28-year-old Steven Moyers starts for the Knights in game five of the series tonight. The left-hander is 1-1 with a 7.13 ERA (24.0 IP/19ER) in 12 outings with Charlotte. He has made one prior start for the Triple-A affiliate of the White Sox. Moyers began 2022 in the starting rotation with Double-A Birmingham, going 5-3 with a 5.61 ERA (43.1 IP/27 ER) in 9 games (8 starts). The southpaw entered in relief in game two of the series and allowed five runs in 2.0 innings (5 H, 2 BB, 1 K). Moyers was picked up by the White Sox as a minor league free agent on February 25, 2022. He spent 2021 in the Mariners organization, finishing 4-2 with a 2.83 ERA in 21 games (7 starts) for Double-A Arkansas. The Connecticut native was signed as an undrafted free agent out in 2016 out of the University of Rhode Island.

2022 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2022: First: 94, Second: 11, Third: 3, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 1, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

Superlatives: Last night's win improved the Sounds to 34-18 at First Horizon Park...54-0 when leading after 8 innings...5-31 when trailing after 7 innings...11-27 when they are out-hit...51-14 when scoring 4+ runs.

Back on the Mend: Rehabbing Brewer hurlers Freddy Peralta and Jake Cousins appeared for the Sounds in last night's win. Peralta threw 52 pitches (38 strikes) in his 3.1 innings of work, striking out five in the process. Jake Cousins finished with 26 pitches in his inning of work (2 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 2 K).

I Need a Hiura: Infielder Keston Hiura came through in the clutch for a 3-run blast in the eighth inning. In 11 games with the Sounds this season, Hiura has 16 RBI and is batting .341 (14-for-41) with five homers.

Among League Leaders: Shortstop Brice Turang continues to climb several league leading categories. Amongst all International League hitters, Turang is tied for 3rd in runs (59) and ranks 4th in hits (104) and 6th in stolen bases (22).

Another Big Fly for BIG Jon: First baseman Jon Singleton clubbed his 19th home run of the season last night. Singleton's 19 homers is tied for 5th-most in the International League and his 72 walks is second in the league, trailing only Columbus' Will Benson with 73.

We Own the Knight: The Sounds and Knights are just over halfway through their 18 scheduled games in 2022. By winning the first four of the current series, Nashville holds a 9-1 series lead. Brice Turang (.459, 17-for-37) and Mark Mathias (.455, 10-for-22) are each hitting over .400 against Charlotte this year.

It's Trevor Time: Reliever Trevor Kelley notched his sixth save in as many chances last night with a 1-2-3 ninth. The right-hander has pitched in 22 games with Nashville and owns a 0.39 ERA (23.0 IP/1 ER). He has 30 strikeouts and opponents are hitting just .160 against him.

Welcome Back, Julio Mosquera: The Charlotte Knights' acting manager is 50-year-old Julio Mosquera. The Panama native played in 64 games for the 2005 Nashville Sounds. Mosquera hit .258 (62-for-240) with 32 runs, 18 doubles, 4 home runs and 30 RBI while helping the Sounds to the 2005 Pacific Coast League Championship.

200-Plus: Rick Sweet won his 206th game as Nashville's manager last night, good for 5th-most in franchise history. Don Money has the 4th-most wins in franchise history with 223. As well as Nashville, Sweet has 200+ wins with four other Triple-A teams: 1993-95 Tucson (251), 2001-03 Portland (212), 2005-11 Louisville (539) and 2015-18 Colorado Springs (282).

LAST OUTING: Lindblom last pitched on July 24 at Louisville, entering in relief. He pitched 1.2 innings, allowing six runs (4 ER) on five hits and a walk in the Sounds' 9-5 loss. He struck out a pair of Bats on 49 pitches (28 strikes).

AGAINST OPPONENT: Lindblom has faced Charlotte four times in his career - once in 2017, twice last season and once this season. He took a loss his last outing against the Knights, allowing three runs (all earned) on six hits back on April 21.
