### LAST GAME

Kicking off a long road trip, the Bowie Baysox broke out late again for a 9-4 win, kicking off a six-game series with the Harrisburg Senators. Bowie scored five runs in the final two innings, while collecting six extra-base hits. Connor Norby homered to open the game, while Joey Ortiz hammered his fourth home run in seven games. Hudson Haskin laced a pair of RBI triples, while John Rhodes gapped one of his own for his first Double-A hit. Ryan Watson worked five innings for his eighth-consecutive start, but took a no decision when Harrisburg tied the game late. Bowie scored five runs in the final two innings to secure the win.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The second half has not been too kind to Harrisburg, entering this series at just 10-17 in the half, partly due to an ERA 5.35. Bowie and Harrisburg have gone back-and-forth this season, after Bowie had a stretch of five wins in six games against the Senators, including a no-hitter, Harrisburg won the final five games of a seven-game series in June. Harrisburg pitching has held Bowie to just a .211 batting average this season, and sport a 3.42 ERA against the Baysox.

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Ronald Herrera has been a constant for Harrisburg this season after being signed as a Minor League Free Agent in the offseason. Last season, Herrera pitched for the New Jersey Jackals of the Frontier League. Before playing independent ball, Herrera had pitched in the minor leagues since 2012 with stints in the A's, Padres, Yankees and Rangers organizations, making the big league squad and pitching two appearances for the Yankees in 2017 (3 IP, 2 ER, 3 K) He took a no decision against Bowie back in May, surrendering two different leads, while allowing home runs to Gunnar Henderson and J.D. Mundy.

### NORBY NOT WAST TIME

Connor Norby has been the obvious choice to lead off games for Bowie since joining the team ahead of the second half. After homering to open Tuesday's game in Harrisburg, Norby raised his batting average to .350 when he is the first batter of an inning, as well as two home runs when leading off.

### STAYING UP LATE

Things have not always gone in Bowie's favor late in game this season, including seven walk-off losses in just the first half of the season. The last week has turned things around for Bowie, however, as they've got a +23 run differential in the seventh, eighth, and ninth innings over their last seven games. Entering this stretch, Bowie had a -23 run differential in that same span of innings over the season.

### COUNTRY RHODES, DRIVE THEM HOME

Baysox outfielder John Rhodes slotted right in to the lineup for his Double-A debut on Tuesday, lacing an RBI triple for his first Double-A hit, and scoring on the next pitch when Maverick Handley singled. Rhodes is ranked as the Orioles #17 overall prospect by Baseball America in their in-season prospect rankings. Rhodes slashed .259/.389/.428 in 58 games with High-A Aberdeen, hitting five home runs, 35 RBI, and going 16-for-16 in stolen base attempts.

### MAKING UP FOR LOST TIME

After Bowie had gone four-consecutive games without a home run, tied for their longest drought of the season, they turned around to slug 17 home runs in their six-game series with Altoona, their most home runs in any six-game span this season. Their five home runs on Sunday is tied for the second most in a single game by an Eastern League team this season.

### FIELD GENERALS

Thanks to Cody Roberts and Maverick Handley, Bowie has had the most feared backstops in the league. Bowie's CS% of 38% is the highest mark in the league. Additionally, Bowie has only allowed 50 stolen bases this season, the second-fewest in the minors (Omaha-47).

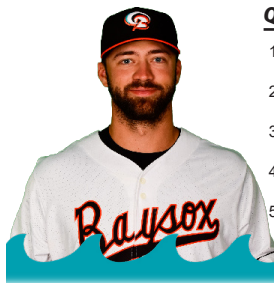

## NOTES

- Gained 27 pounds between the start of spring training and Opening Day. "Just eating and lifting. Starting to focus now on making some muscle out of it"
- Picked up tips on his changeup from Orioles starter John Means when Means made a rehab start with Bowie in 2021: "I was kind of like the little kid, just nervous to talk to him. Eventually I got the nuts to ask him about his changeup. He was the nicest, most genuine guy. He told me how he throws it, how he grips it. He was awesome about it."
- Closed 2021 with 13 consecutive scoreless innings for Bowie after allowing at least one earned run in each of his previous seven outings, including all of his outings with Bowie.
- In 2021, Aberdeen averaged eight runs in games Drew appeared in, while Bowie only averaged 5.8 runs in the same games
- Major contributor for manager Kyle Moore with the Delmarva Shorebirds in 2019. Team finished with a 90-48 record, the best in Minor League Baseball. Rom was one of eight Shorebirds named to the South Atlantic League All-Star Game.

## What They're Saying:

Matt Blood, Orioles Dir. of Player Development: "He throws a lot of strikes. He's deceptive, he's an uncomfortable at-bat for hitters and he's still pretty young, so we're excited about that."

MLB Pipeline: "Lean and projectable, Rom hides the ball well by creating deception with his 6-foot-2 frame. He releases from a three-quarters arm slot and uses his long stride and crossfire finish to create good extension, which allows his pitches to play up and miss barrels consistently. He is comfortable throwing either off-speed pitch in fastball counts as well as mixing up arm angles; he couples this unpredictability with a quick pace and moderate effort delivery that projects durability."

Baseball America: "Rom hasn't yet developed a standout pitch, but a varied mix and precocious pitchability have helped him carve up hitters at every level. He experimented with dropping his arm slot against lefties to create different action on his two-seam fastball. Rom knows how the pitches play off one another, and pitches backwards while taking advantage of his deception and angles."

## NOTES BY OUTING

- Apr 8 v RIC Bowie's Opening Day starter, was peppered with base hits over his three innings, six singles. Allowed three single over the first two innings, but did not allow a runner to reach third base. Once he reached the second trip through the order, Richmond started with two singles and two walks to eventually score three runs.
- Apr 14 @ BNG Five shutout frames versus the Ponies, with his only hiccup coming in the second inning, where he allowed a pair of base hits and a walk to load the bases with only one out. Those three baserunners were the only three he allowed all day.
- Apr 21 v AKR Retired 12 of the first 13 batters faced. Only baserunner was a two-out infield single in the first inning. First inning was also hampered by reaching a three-ball count on each of the first three batters. Left midway through the fifth inning after allowing the first three batters to reach on a walk and two singles. Bowie won with a walk-off in the tenth inning.
- Apr 28 @ RIC Gave up a string of five-consecutive base hits with one out in the first inning, allowing three runs to score. Labored through lengthy plate appearances for the following two innings, including stranding the bases loaded in the second inning. Only finished three innings.
- 5/4 v HBG Retired the first eight batters of the game, while striking out three. Allowed a pair of base hits with two outs in the third inning, but stranded both runners and worked a hitless fourth and fifth. In the sixth inning, allowed three singles to load the bases before being lifted from the game, and a wild pitch allowed one of the runners to score.
- 5/25 v ERI First start in three weeks following an IL stint, and was placed on a pitch limit. Allowed a solo home run to Kerry Carpenter in the first inning (Carpenter hit five home runs in the six-game series, and was named EL Player of the Week). Fired a perfect second inning with three contact outs, but allowed a double and a two-run home run with one out in the third inning before being lifted.
- 5/31 @ ALT Allowed an unearned run in the first inning after a leadoff single. Allowed two one-out singles in the second inning before rattling off seven-consecutive outs, including five of his six strikeouts. Lifted in the fourth inning after allowing a two-out double and RBI single.
- 6/5 @ ALT Lone run scored on a double, wild pitch, and sacrifice fly in the second inning. Allowed at least one hit in all four innings.
- 6/11 @ HBG Was set to finish an 11-pitch first inning, but a two-out error extended the inning, and he eventually allowed the run to score while yielding 17 more pitches. Worked scoreless the rest of the way.
- 6/17 v BNG All trouble came in the third inning, where he allowed five hits, including four-consecutive hits and three doubles.
- 6/24 @ ERI Third inning was again the trouble inning, as he loaded the bases on both hits allowed and a walk, but escaped the jam. Struck out three batters in the second and third innings.
- 6/30 v RIC Allowed a career-high three home runs, but all were solo shots. Also allowed only one baserunner, an individual base hit, in each of six innings pitched.
- 7/6 @ SOM Tried to stretch into the sixth inning again after opening with five scoreless, but after two outs allowed a home run, and three more baserunners before being lifted.
- 7/13 v AKR Struck out four of the first six batters faced. Allowed runners into scoring position in each of the next three innings, but no runs. Allowed two runs in the fifth, including a solo home run.
- 7/23 @ RIC Struck out six of the first eight batters faced. Only batter to reach second base was a leadoff double in the fifth inning, did not allow a runner to reach third base.
- 7/28 v ALT Was the first Bowie starting pitcher to allow more than three runs since July 2nd. Allowed two home runs late, but Bowie had a five-run third inning.
