TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST GAME'S RESULT - Mark Contreras went deep twice and Ariel Jurado tossed 3.1 perfect innings of relief, but the St. Paul Saints lost 5-3 to the Indianapolis Indians on Sunday afternoon at Victory Field. Contreras went 2-4 with two homers, three RBI, and two runs scored. Jurado tossed 3.1 perfect innings while striking out three.

WE HAVE CONTACT: For the eighth time this season a Saints hitter had a multi-homer game as Mark Contreras hit two home runs on Sunday, July 24 at Indianapolis. It's the third time in his career he has homered twice, the last time coming on August 14, 2018 vs. Charlotte when he was with Fort Myers. Last season, the Saints had nine multi-homer games by a player.

NOT PART OF HIS WORLD: Ariel Jurado was masterful on Sunday, July 24 at Indianapolis. He retired all 10 batters he faced in 3.1 perfect innings while striking out three. Adding his last outing, Jurado has retired the last 13 batter he has faced. It's the longest perfect outing by any reliever this season surpassing the 3.0 perfect innings by Tyler Viza on June 3 @ Iowa. The only outing longer without allowing a hit was Mario Sanchez' 4.0 hitless innings, where he walked one, on June 8 vs. Rochester.

THE "K" MEN: Saints pitchers struck out 11 Indianapolis Indians on Sunday, July 24. It's the 34th time Saints pitchers have fanned the opposition double-digit times. They have also struck out double-digit hitters in three straight games. It's the third time this season they have struck out double-digit hitters in three straight games. The franchise record is five straight games which they did from June 28-July 2.

END OF GAME PAIN: For the 10th time this season the Saints were walked-off on July 23. The Saints have had nine roadtrips and they have had a walk-off loss in six of the nine series. Last season the Saints were walked-off a total of nine times across 140 games.

LOCKED IN WHEN LOADED: Jermaine Palacios crushed a grand slam on July 22 @ Indianapolis. It was the sixth grand slam hit by the Saints this season and the first of Palacios' career. The six grand slams are tied with Columbus for the most in the International League and are tied for the fourth most in Minor League Baseball only behind Reno (8), Albuquerque (7) and Lake County (7).

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Saints collected two more doubles on Sunday afternoon at Indianapolis and continue to be at the top of the Minor Leagues in two batters. Overall, the Saints have collected 171 doubles, seventh in Triple-A and tied for 15th in all of Minor League Baseball.

RISPY (WITH 2 OUTS) BUSINESS: The St. Paul Saints gave up another run with runners in scoring position and two outs on Sunday night. With RISP/2 outs this season, opponents are hitting .282 against the Saints, third worst in all of Minor League Baseball. Tacoma has the highest average at .309, El Paso is second at .294.

FIRST INNING FLOP: The St. Paul Saints have allowed at least one run in the first inning in 39 of 91 games (42.9%). They have allowed 82 runs in the first, most in the International League and tied for fourth most in all of Minor League Baseball behind Albuquerque (101), Stockton (90), and Binghamton (84). Visalia has also allowed 82 runs. Their 21 home runs allowed are tied for fifth most in Minor League Baseball.

EXTRA EXTRA READ ALL ABOUT IT: The St. Paul Saints have played 91 games this season and have an extra base hit in all, but one game. They have an extra base hit in 83 consecutive games, the second longest streak in all of Minor League Baseball. The only team with a longer streak is El Paso's 93 game streak, which is also active. The lone game they didn't collect an extra base hit was the game they were no-hit on April 13 vs. Indianapolis. They have just one extra base hit in only 10 games.

FINAL FOUR: The St. Paul Saints are a part of the final four, but not a final four they care to be included in. The Saints have yet to throw a shutout in 2022. They are one of only four Minor League teams that have yet to throw a shutout. They are joined by the Chattanooga Lookouts in the Southern League, Columbia Fireflies, and the Visalia Rawhide in the California League. The Saints 5.35 ERA in the third highest of the four teams. Columbia has the best ERA at 5.24 Chattanooga's is at 5.27, while Visalia is 6.08. The Charlotte Knights and Delmarva Shorebirds took their names off the list with a shutout on July 10.

WE BELIEVE THE PROSPECTS ARE OUR FUTURE: On July 7, Spencer Steer was chosen to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium. Steer is one of two Minnesota Twins Minor Leaguers to be chosen. He joins newly promoted outfielder Matt Wallner. Steer is the first Saints player chosen to the Futures Game. Josh Winder, who was chosen in 2021, was called up to the Saints two days before the announcement, but hadn't pitched for the Saints. Wallner delivered in the game going 1-2 with a home run while Steer was 0-2.

TWINS UPDATE - The Minnesota Twins hammered the Detroit Tigers 9-1 in the finale of their brief two-game series on Sunday afternoon at Comerica Park. Jose Miranda went 3-4 with two RBI while Gary Sanchez had two RBI. Jorge Polanco went 2-5 with two doubles and an RBI. Sonny Gray got the start and went 6.0 strong innings allowing one run and struck out seven.

A PITCHER YOU ROOT FOR: When Smeltzer was just nine years old, he was diagnosed with pelvic rhabdomyosarcoma (bladder cancer), as a tumor had formed against his bladder that was connected to his prostate. He underwent surgery and chemotherapy at St. Christopher's Hospital for Children in Philadelphia, PA, and sent the cancer into full remission in 2012.

PHILLIE FAN(ATIC): During his time with cancer, Devin took a photo with the Phillies Cole Hamels. He also received encouragement and an autograph from Chase Utley when he was 10 on a trip to Citizens Bank Park. Fast forward to 2018 when Hamels was in spring training with the Dodgers and who else was on that team? That's right, Chase Utley. The two reunited 13 years later at Spring Training in Arizona.

CATCH CANCER LOOKING: The lefty, who's worn glasses and a goatee for the majority of his professional career, continues to offer support to others fighting cancer through his Catch Cancer Looking apparel with his likeness. All proceeds benefit Katie's Crusaders, an organization focused on helping cover expenses for pediatric cancer survivors.

#NEVERFORGET: -Smeltzer writes the names of fellow cancer patients under the brim of his cap of both survivors and those that didn't make it. He started this at the age of 10 and did that as recently as 2018. Since then he carries a hat that has a bunch of names on it and puts it on his top shelf with all his other hats in his locker.

THE-OUT-OF-TOWNER: Believe it or not, Smeltzer had never stepped foot in New York City, that is until he pitched in Game 2 of the American League Division Series at Yankee Stadium against the New York Yankees. The New York crowd didn't phase Smeltzer as he went 3.1 scoreless innings with two hits allowed, three walks and four strikeouts in a Twins 8-2 defeat.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB: Devin made his Major League debut with the Minnesota Twins on May 28, 2019 vs. Milwaukee. All he did was go 6.0 shutout innings allowing three hits, no walks, and seven strikeouts. He became fourth Twins starter in history to throw 6.0-or-more shutout innings in his debut, joining Andrew Albers (8.1 on August 6, 2013), Anthony Swarzak (7.0 on May 23, 2009) and Eric Milton (6.0 on April 5, 1998). His seven strikeouts were one shy of the franchise record in a debut (Boof Bonser set by Boof Bonser on May 21, 2006 at Milwaukee).

FLY LIKE AN EAGLE: Following his high school career at Bishop Eustace (NJ) Preparatory School in 2014, Smeltzer was drafted in the 33rd round by the Chicago Cubs. Smeltzer elected not to sign with the Cubs and instead went to school at Florida Gulf Coast University. After one season, however, Smeltzer transferred to San Jacinto (TX) JC so that he would be eligible for the draft after two years instead of three. The moved paid off when the Los Angeles Dodgers selected him in the 5th round of the 2016 draft.

- Pitched in one game for the Minnesota Twins in 2021 before being optioned back to the alternate training site on April 25. He was recalled from the Saints on May 6, but never pitched in a game for the Twins. Was placed on 10-day Injured List on May 12 with left elbow inflammation; missed remainder of season
- Made the Twins Opening Day roster in 2020 for the first time in his career
- Earned the Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week and Southern League Pitcher of the Week April 14, 2019 after making two starts, going 2-0, 0.00 ERA (14.0 IP) with five hits allowed, two walks and 17 strikeouts
- Earned first major league win August 4, 2019 vs. Kansas City, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed, one walk and four strikeouts in a 3-0 Twins victory
- Became just the fifth Twins pitcher to record seven-or-more strikeouts in a debut on May 28, 2019, joining Bonser (8, in 20016), Yohan Pino (7 in 2014), Darrell Jackson (7 in 1978) and Bert Blyleven (7 in 1970)
- Had five overall stints with the Twins in 2019, going 2-2 with a 3.86 ERA (49.0 IP, 21 ER), 12 walks and 38 strikeouts in 11 games (6 starts)
- Traded from the Los Angeles Dodgers, along with 2B Logan Forsyth and OF Luke Raley, in exchange for 2B Brian Dozier on July 31, 2018
- Started 2017 with Low-A Great Lakes (Los Angeles Dodgers), where he pitched in 10 games (all starts), and allowed 22 earned runs in 52.1 innings pitched (3.78 ERA). He was promoted to High-A Rancho Cucamonga, where he pitched in 16 games (15 starts), amassing a 5-4 record with a 4.40 ERA (90.0 IP, 44 ER), 102 strikeouts and just 18 walks
