SUNDAY AFTERNOON: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers split a doubleheader with the South Bend Cubs at Four Winds Field to wrap up the series. Wisconsin won the opener 5-2. South Bend won the nightcap 3-2.

GAME ONE: South Bend had a 2-1 lead after four innings. Then, Alex Hall and Jose Acosta hit back-to-back homers to start the top of the fifth to give the Rattlers a lead they never gave up. Shane Smith pitched two scoreless innings for the win and Tanner Shears worked a scoreless seventh for the save.

GAME TWO: Luis Devers allowed two hits and struck out eight over five innings for the win. Wisconsin was held to three hits in the second game of the twinbill.

WALKING IN SOUTH BEND: Brock Wilken, the #1 pick of the Milwaukee Brewers in the 2023 Draft, walked five times on Sunday. He drew three free passes in game one and walked twice in the nightcap.

ORGANIZATIONAL DEBUT: Bradley Blalock was the starting pitcher for the Timber Rattlers in game one of the doubleheader. Blalock, who was acquired from the Boston Red Sox in exchange for Luis Urias on August 1, allowed two runs on two hits and three walks with six strikeouts over four innings for a no decision in his first appearance as a Brewers farmhand.

COLLECTING GOOSE EGGS: Smit's scoreless streak has reached 11-1/3 innings. In his eight appearances with Wisconsin since his promotion from Carolina on June 28, Smith has allowed one run over 14-2/3 innings.

ABOUT DAYTON: The Dayton Dragons entered the Midwest League when the Rockford Reds moved to Ohio for the 2000 season. Dayton has been an affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds since 2000. Joey Votto, Johnny Cueto, Adam Dunn, Homer Bailey, Didi Gregorius, Nick Senzel, and Elly De La Cruz are just a few MLB players to play for the Dragons. The Dragons finished the first half 33-33 and missed the playoffs. Bryan LaHair is in his second season as the manager of the Dragons. LaHair appeared in 67 games with the Timber Rattlers during the 2004 season. He hit .279 with 24 doubles, five homers, and 28 RBI.

ABOUT THE REDS: The Cincinnati Reds have been the Major League parent club for the Dragons since 2000. The Reds had two MWL affiliates in 1999 (Rockford and Clinton) and 2000 (Dayton and Clinton). Cincinnati's first Midwest League affiliate was the Cedar Rapids Red Raiders in 1963 and 1964. The Reds left the Midwest League in 1964 before returning to Cedar Rapids in 1980 where they stayed until the end of the 1992 season. The Reds left the MWL for four seasons before returning to partner with the Burlington Bees in 1997 for two seasons before the partnership with Clinton and Rockford started.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](https://www.mlb.com/mlb-pipeline) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Robert Moore (#8), Hendry Mendez (#13), Bradley Blalock (#15), Eduardo Garcia (#20), and Matthew Wood (#25). Eric Brown Jr (#6) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. [MLB Pipeline](https://www.mlb.com/mlb-pipeline) has five Dayton players on their list of Top 30 Reds prospects: Edwin Arroyo (#2), Chase Petty (#6), Jay Allen II (#8), Austin Hendrick (#17), and Tyler Callihan (#26).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP NATE PETERSON: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Peterson in the eighth round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Illinois-Chicago.

STILL WATER: Peterson started his collegiate career at Oklahoma State University. He made sixteen relief appearances with no record and a save during the 2019 and 2020 seasons for the Cowboys. He walked ten and struck out nineteen over 15-2/3 innings at OSU.

IN THE CLOUD: Peterson pitched two seasons for the St. Cloud Rox of the Northwoods League during the 2020 and 2021 seasons. He was 2-2 with a save in 24 games – three starts – with 72 strikeouts over 52 innings pitched.

SWEET HOME CHICAGO: Peterson transferred to Illinois-Chicago for 2022 and was named First Team All-Horizon League in his lone season with the Flames. Peterson went 4-5 with a 3.89ERA in fourteen starts for the Flames. He had 102 strikeouts over 88 innings pitched.

MAKE IT A MUDCAT: Peterson did not pitch professionally after signing with Milwaukee last year. He made his pro debut with the Carolina Mudcats this season. Peterson was 4-1 with a 2.98 ERA in eleven games – four starts – with seventeen walks and 52 strikeouts over 42-1/3 innings before joining Wisconsin on July 19.

LAST START: Peterson lost at South Bend on [August 1](#). He allowed six runs on eight hits with a walk and two strikeouts over 2-2/3 innings. The Cubs hit two homers off Peterson in the game.

VS. DAYTON: Peterson has never faced Dayton prior to this evening. Tonight is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds.

DAYTON SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP KEVIN ABEL: The Cincinnati Reds selected Abel in the seventh round of the 2021 draft out of Oregon State.

DID YOU KNOW? The San Diego Padres picked Abel in the 35th round of the 2017 draft out of James Madison High School in San Diego. Abel chose Oregon State over signing with the Padres.

BUSY BEAVER: Abel was 13-6 with a save and an ERA of 3.31 with 242 strikeouts and 116 walks over 179-2/3 innings in 42 games – 26 starts from 2018 through 2021 at Oregon State. Abel did not pitch with the Beavers in 2020. In his final season of college baseball, Abel was 3-5 with a 3.62 ERA, 109 strikeouts, and 61 walks over 82 innings in sixteen starts. He was on the mound for Oregon State to close out a College World Series in Omaha in 2018.

STARTING OUT: Abel made three brief starts in the Arizona Complex League in 2021 after signing with the Reds. He began the 2022 season in the ACL and was 1-0 in two games – one start – before a promotion to the Daytona Tortugas in the Florida State League on June 16, 2022. Abel was 1-3 with a 6.97 ERA with 29 walks and 52 strikeouts over 31 innings pitched in eleven games – five starts to finish 2022.

SUNNY FLORIDA: Abel started the 2023 season with Daytona. He was 3-2 with a 4.69ERA in twelve games – seven starts. Abel walked 32 and struck out 61 over 40-1/3 innings before his promotion to Dayton on July 14.

LAST START: Abel had a no decision against Beloit at home on [August 1](#). He allowed four runs on six hits with two walks and five strikeouts over six innings. The Sky Carp hit a pair of homers against Abel in the game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Abel had a no decision against the Timber Rattlers in Dayton on [July 18](#). He allowed five runs on six hits with two walks and two strikeouts over 3-1/3 innings. Wisconsin scored all five runs off Abel in the fourth inning of that game and rallied for a 9-8 win over the Dragons.
