ABOUT WEST MICHIGAN: The West Michigan Whitecaps joined the Midwest League in 1994 when the Madison Muskies moved to Grand Rapids, Michigan following the 1993 season. The Whitecaps started play in the league as an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. They became Low-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers for the 1997 season. The Whitecaps won six Midwest League Pennants (1996, 1998, 2004, 2006, 2007, and 2015) before getting the bump up to the High-A Affiliate of the Tigers going into the 2021 season. Notable former Whitecaps include Nick Castellanos, Joel Zumaya, Fernando Rodney, Brandon Inge, Cameron Maybin, and Willy Adames.

ABOUT THE TIGERS: Detroit has been affiliated with the Whitecaps since 1997. The Tigers had just one other stint in the Midwest League prior to their current partnership. They were with the Clinton Pilots from 1971 through 1975.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jacob Misiorowski (#4), Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Eduardo García (#19), Matthew Wood (#24), and Joseph Hernandez (#25). Hendry Mendez (#13) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. MLB Pipeline has six West Michigan players on their list of Top 30 Tigers prospects: Jace Jung (#2), Izaac Pacheco (#12), Robert Brooks (#13), Troy Melton (#17), Josh Crouch (#24), and Danny Serretti (#29). ## PITCHING MATCHUP

### WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JACOB MISIOROWSKI: Selected by Milwaukee in the second round of the 2022 draft out of Crowder (MO) Junior College.

**THE UNDEFEATED:** Misiorowski made fifteen starts in his only season at Crowder. He was 10-0 with a 2.72 ERA and 136 strikeouts over 76 innings as he helped the Roughriders to the NJCAA College World Series in Grand Junction, Colorado.

**THAT SCHOOL SOUNDS FAMILIAR:** Former Timber Rattler Aaron Ashby was drafted in the fourth round of the 2018 draft out of Crowder.

**DID YOU KNOW?** Misiorowski and current teammate Tyler Woessner were the opposing starting pitchers on May 29, 2022 in a College World Series Game. Misiorowski allowed three runs on three hits with two walks and ten strikeouts over six innings for a no decision. Crowder won the game 5-4 in ten innings over Woessner's Central Arizona College in Misiorowski's final junior college appearance.

GOING TO CAROLINA: Misiorowski made two brief starts for Carolina in 2022 after signing with Milwaukee. He joined the Mudcats to start this season and was 1-1 with a 3.04 ERA in nine starts. Misiorowski walked twelve and struck out 46 in 26-2/3 innings pitched for the Mudcats before his promotion to Wisconsin on June 6.

**LAST START:** Misiorowski had a no decision at Lynchburg on May 31 in his final start for the Mudcats. He allowed a run on a hit with three walks and five strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WEST MICHIGAN: Misiorowski has never faced the Whitecaps prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Detroit Tigers.

#### WEST MICHIGAN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP WILLIANDER MORENO: The Detroit Tigers signed Moreno as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 12, 2018.

THE BEFORE TIMES: Moreno pitched in the Dominican Summer League in 2018 and in the Gulf Coast League in 2019. He went 3-7 with six saves in 26 appearances – nine starts during those two seasons. He walked 22 and struck out 52 in 65-2/3 innings.

**COMING BACK STRONG:** Moreno spent the entire 2021 season with Lakeland in the Florida State League. He was 3-3 with a 3.16 ERA and 67 strikeouts over 57 innings in 25 games – two starts.

SPLITTING TIME: Moreno started the 2022 season with West Michigan with no record and a 4.91 ERA in five relief appearances before going back to Lakeland where he was 4-4 with four saves and a 2.98 ERA in 25 games – six starts. Moreno started the 2023 season the Whitecaps, went to Erie, Detroit's Eastern League affiliate, with no record and an ERA of 20.25 in two relief appearances before being sent back to West Michigan.

**LAST START:** Moreno had a <u>no decision at Dayton on June 2</u>. He allowed two runs on four hits with no walks and two strikeouts in three innings

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Moreno has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. The only times he has pitched against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers were in the Dominican Summer League with a relief appearance on <u>June 15, 2018</u> and a start on <u>July 2, 2018</u>.
