MAY. 2025:

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Peoria Chiefs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 9-5 at Dozer Park. The Chiefs scored four runs in the bottom of the first inning and had a 7-1 lead after six innings. The Timber Rattlers scored four runs in the top of the seventh inning to pull to within two runs but could not make up the difference. Graysen Tarlow drove in four runs for Peoria. Yhoswar Garcia had two hits, drove in a run, and scored a run for Wisconsin.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: Peoria scored four runs on one hit in the bottom of the first inning against Wisconsin starting pitcher Anthony Flores. All four runs scored after two outs in the inning. The Chiefs had runners at second and third with two away when Won-Bin Cho singled to knock in both runners. An error kept the inning alive, and a walk loaded the bases. Then, Flores hit Tarlow to force in a run and committed a balk to let

HARD EIGHT: Blake Burke went 1-for-3 with a walk last night to extend his current hitting streak to eight games, his longest of the season. He is 11-for-33 (.333) during the streak. Burke is also on a fifteengame on-base streak (21-for-60, .993 OPS)

THAT WAS A FIRST: Wisconsin infielder Jadher Areinamo was ejected after a disagreement with plate umpire Jarred Neal on a called third strike in the top of the sixth inning. Areinamo is the first Rattler ejected from a game this season.

BACK IN THE FIGHT: Wisconsin sent nine men to the plate in the top of the seventh inning and scored four runs on two hits. There were four walks in the frame. The Rattlers plated their runs on an RBI single by Daniel Guilarte, a bases loaded walk to Eduardo Garcia, a balk, and an RBI grounder by Luiyin Alastre. Wisconsin batters took eleven walks in the game.

UNEARNED: A dropped fly ball with two outs in the bottom of the seventh inning allowed two Peoria runs to score for the 9-5 lead. Four of Peoria's runs in last night's game were unearned.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his third year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Bishop Letson (#14), Blake Burke (#16), Jadher Areinamo (#23), Juan Baez (#26), and Manuel Rodriguez (#29). MLB Pipeline has three active Peoria players on their list of Top 30 Cardinals prospects: Darlin Saladin (#17), Ryan Campos (#18), and Zach Levenson (#28). Zack Showalter (#19) is currently on Peoria's Developmental List.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RYAN BIRCHARD: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Birchard in the  $5^{\text{th}}$  round of the 2023 draft out of the Niagara County Community College.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR: Birchard was name the Western New York Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2023. He was 8-0 in ten games – nine starts – with a 1.08 ERA and 95 strikeouts over fifty innings pitched. Birchard was also named a First Team All-NJCAA Division III All-American in 2023.

**QUICK TRIP TO TRENTON:** Birchard made four appearances – two starts – for Trenton in the MLB Draft League after the end of his college season. He allowed one run, walked one, and struck out sixteen over nine innings before signing with Milwaukee.

**DELAYED START:** Birchard did not pitch professionally in 2023. He made a start for the Carolina Mudcats on April 6, 2024 (4.0IP, H, R, 0ER, 2BB, 6K) but was placed on the IL after that game. He next pitched with the ACL Brewers on July 16 and July 22. Birchard rejoined Carolina for appearances on July 28 and August 3 before being sent to Wisconsin on August 13.

AS A RATTLER (2024): Birchard made five regular season starts for Wisconsin last season. He was 0-3 with an 8.71 ERA. He walked fourteen and struck out thirteen in 10-1/3 innings with the Timber Rattlers

**LAST START:** Birchard had a no decision at Peoria on May 6 in game one of this series. He allowed five runs – four earned – on eight hits with no walks and four strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. PEORIA:** Prior to the start at Dozer Park on May 6, Birchard made two starts against Peoria at home – August 13 and August 19 – in 2024. He was 0-1 and allowed five runs – four earned – on eight hits with two walks and four strikeouts over four innings.

### PEORIA STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CHEN-WEI LIN: The St. Louis Cardinals signed Lin as a Minor League Free Agent on July 3, 2023.

WORLD TRAVELER: Lin, a native of Taiwan, pitched for Kenosha in the Northwoods League in 2022 going 0-1 in nine games – four starts – with a 12.06 ERA, 24 walks, and sixteen strikeouts over 15-2/3 inning. He also went to Frederick in the MLB Draft League in 2023 with ten walks, fifteen strikeouts, a 3.24 ERA, and a 2-0 record in four starts prior to signing with St. Louis.

**PROSPECT TALK:** Lin is the #13 prospect in the St. Louis system according to MLB Pipeline. He has a fastball that can reach triple digits and usually sits from 95-98 mph.

**LAST SEASON:** Lin was 10-5 with a 2.79 ERA in 22 starts for the Palm Beach Cardinals of the Florida State League in 2024. He walked 36 and struck out 123 in 116 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** Lin, who started this season on Peoria's IL, pitched two scoreless innings for Palm Beach in a rehab start on May 4. He walked one, struck out four, and didn't allow a hit for a no decision.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Lin has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
