TODAY'S GAME: The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Low-A Astros) look to rebound after dropping the series opener to the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers (Low-A Astros) the night before. Kannapolis snuck away with a 1-0 win Tuesday night after a bases-loaded walk in the ninth inning pushed across the only run of the contest. RHP Alex Santos will vie for that elusive first win of 2022 for Fayetteville while LHP Brooks Gosswein will try to do the same for the Cannon Ballers.

THE OPPONENTS: The Cannon Ballers are in their 21st season playing as the White Sox Low-A affiliate in Kannapolis, NC. The club spent the first 19 years as the Kannapolis Intimidators, paying homage to the nickname of seven-time NASCAR Cup Series Champion Dale Earnhardt. Prior to 2001, the Cannon Ballers were the Philadelphia Phillies' Low-A affiliate as the Piedmont Boll Weevils for five seasons and the Piedmont Phillies in 1995.

HISTORIC 5-HIT NIGHT: On Thursday night against Delmarva, Joey Loperfido finished 5-for-6 with a 2B, 3B, 3 R, and 3 RBI, becoming the first Fayetteville hitter with a five-hit game in franchise history. He is the fifth player this season in the Carolina League with a five-hit game. Delmarva's Isaac Bellony also accomplished the feat on 5/29/22 @ CSC. No Woodpeckers hitter had a five-hit game during the 2021 season or the 2019 season. On top of that, no player during the Buies Creek Astros era in 2017 and 2018 had a five-hit game.

THE PROSPECTS: The Woodpeckers are currently carrying three of the Astros Top-30 Prospects on their active roster. RHP Alex Santos is the highest of the trio, sitting at #9. Outfielder Tyler Whitaker sits right behind him at #10 after dropping down a couple of spots. After a red-hot start to the month of June, outfielder Logan Cerny has surged up the rankings, coming in at #24 in the most recent rankings from MLB.com.

SLUGGERS OF THE CAROLINAS: Over the first 57 games of the regular season, the Woodpeckers lead the Carolina League with 59 long-balls, averaging over a home run per game. 24 of Fayetteville's homers have been hit at Segra Stadium compared to 35 on the road, the most road homers of any team in the league. In May, the Woodpeckers hit 27 home runs and are currently on pace to shatter that mark in June with 13 round-trippers in nine games. Fayetteville has also taken advantage of the long ball with runners on base, hitting 30 multi-run home runs compared to 29 solo home runs.

SURGING CERNY: Outfielder Logan Cerny has picked it up at the plate in late May and early June. In last Tuesday's series opener against Delmarva, Cerny hit his eighth HR of the season and finished 3-for-5 with 3 RBI. He followed it up on Thursday with the first 5 RBI game from any Fayetteville player this season. Across the last ten games played, he is 16-for-38 (.421 AVG) with 4 HR, 3 2B, 19 RBI, 5 BB, 7 K. Since May 27th, Cerny has raised his overall batting average from .175 to .242 and overall OPS from .629 to .837. Cerny also launched a seventh-inning go-ahead grand slam on Saturday night, the first grand slam hit by a Woodpecker in 2022.

GOOD WITH THE BAD: The Woodpeckers pitching staff has issued a Carolina League-high 321 walks so far in 2022. However, they have made up for it by missing bats, striking out the second-most batters in the league with 637. Additionally, in the month of June the Woodpeckers have given up the third-fewest hits in the league (83).

HEAT WAVE: The weather has heated up in the month of June and so have the Woodpeckers at the plate. Since the start of the month, Fayetteville has driven in the second-most runs (67) and have the third-highest slugging percentage (.413) in the entire Carolina League. In 11 games so far in June, the Woodpeckers have also scored at least six runs in seven of those games. To put it in perspective, Fayetteville only accomplished that feat eight times in the entire month of May (26 games).

MOST LEADS ARE SAFE: Fayetteville has done an exceptional job maintaining leads down the stretch in games this season. The Woodpeckers are 22-2 when leading after seven innings and 24-1 when taking a lead into the ninth inning. However, on the flip side, Fayetteville has never won a game in which they have trailed after seven innings with an 0-22 record in that situation. Extra innings also have not been kind to the Woodpeckers, who are 1-5 in games that have gone past nine innings, but they did pick up their first extra-innings victory on May 26 in a 5-3 road win against the Down East Wood Ducks.

15 Joe Thon

Manager

Thon makes his return to Fayetteville and begins his first season as Woodpeckers manager after serving as a development coach in 2021. As the development coach, Thon helped coach Woodpeckers hitters and fielders, as well as assist with lineup planning and creating reports on individual athletes on the team.

Prior to joining the Astros as a full-time coach, Thon served as a summer intern with the organization during the 2019 summer. He helped analyze and balance revenue summaries, verified accounts for reconciling payments and processed and organized invoices for the Astros and Astros Foundation.

Following his intership, Thon broke into the coaching ranks by joining the University of Houston Baseball program in August 2019 as a student assistant coach before becoming the volunteer assistant prior to the 2020 season. After one season with UofH, Thon returned to the Astros in a full-time coaching role.

The former Minor League infielder enjoyed a seven-year minor league playing career. Thon was drafted in the 5th round (pick 156) by the Toronto Blue Jays in 2010 out of Academia Perpetuo Socorro in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He played in the Blue Jays organization until 2016 when he signed to join the St. Louis Cardinals. Thon played in the Cardinals farm system through 2017, reaching as high as Double-A with the Springfield Cardinals. His playing career concluded in 2017 in the Independent Atlanta League with the Sugar Land Skeeters, now the Triple-A Affiliate of the Astros. In total, Thon appeared in over 500 games across his MiLB career, posting a .243/.356/.318 slash line with 79 doubles, 17 triples, 27 home-runs and 178 RBI. Thon also played for Liga de Beisbol Profesional Roberto Clemente in Puerto Rico from 2010 through December 2016.

Thon comes from a deep baseball background. He is the son of former Astros shortstop Dickie Thon, a 1983 All-Star with Houston who enjoyed a 15-year MLB career with the California Angels, Astros, Padres, Phillies, Rangers and Brewers. Joe and his fiancé Erika spend their offseason living in Houston with their dogs.

23 Jose Puentes

Hitting Coach

Joining the Woodpeckers for his first season with the franchise and third season in the Astros organization is hitting coach Jose Puentes.

Puentes started his career with the Astros as a hitting coach in the Dominican Summer League and most recently served as hitting coach with the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021.

He has coached at the high school level at MacArthur High School, Johnson High School, Steele High School and Wagner High School. From 2006-2007, he was the head baseball coach at St. Anthony Catholic High School. Puentes has owned and operated two hitting academies, Gap to Gap Academy and Cardinals Select Baseball Academy.

Pitching Coach

John Kovalik takes over as the third pitching coach in Woodpeckers history, bringing three years of coaching experience to the Woodpeckers staff.
