ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 2-0 at Modern Woodmen Park. The River Bandits broke a scoreless tie when they scored a run on a wild pitch with two outs in the bottom of the seventh. They added a run in the bottom of the eighth. Wisconsin's three-game winning streak ended as they were held to two hits and shut out for the first time this season.

ON BASE AND ON THE MOVE: Eric Brown Jr walked twice, singled, and stole two bases for the Timber Rattlers last night.

MR. SMITH: Wisconsin starting pitcher Russell Smith made his first start of the season last night and allowed one hit with three walks and five strikeouts over four scoreless innings. Smith has ten strikeouts in 6-2/3 scoreless innings over two appearances with the Rattlers this season.

DOUBLE UP: The River Bandits had two runners on with no outs in the top of the fourth inning. Smith got Juan Carlos Negret to pop out and Kale Emshoff to ground into an inning-ending 5-4-3 double play.

MAKING THEM SWEAT: Robert Moore doubled with two outs in the top of the eighth inning against River Bandits reliever Brandon Johnson, Joe Gray Jr. followed with a walk. Johnson ended the inning with a strikeout.

FEEL THE BREEZE: The pitchers for both teams combined for 26 strikeouts. For the Rattlers, Smith had five strikeouts, Michele Vassalotti had six strikeouts, and Luis Amaya and Justin King each had one. For the River Bandits, Mason Barnett had seven strikeouts, Emilio Marquez had four, and Johnson had two.

STREAK INTACT: Gray's walk in the eighth inning moved his on-base streak to nine games. He is tied with six others - including Gavin Cross, Cayden Wallace, and Carter Jensen of Quad Cities - for the second-longest on-base streak in the Midwest League. Nathan Martorella of Fort Wayne is on a ten-game onbase streak to lead the league.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JOSEPH HERNANDEZ: Acquired by Milwaukee in a trade with the Seattle Mariners on January 7, 2023 in exchange for Justin Topa.

FROM THE REPUBLIC: The Mariners originally signed Hernandez as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on July 2, 2017.

TWO YEARS ON THE ISLAND: Hernandez spent his 2018 and 2019 seasons with the Mariners affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He was 3-2 with a save and a 4.62 ERA in fifteen games – six starts – in 2018 and went 0-1 in four relief appearances in 2019. He had 28 walks and 47 strikeouts over 45 innings pitched in the DSL.

BACK AT IT: Hernandez spent most of his 201 season with the Mariners affiliate in the Arizona Complex League. He was 4-0 with a 4.35 ERA in ten games – four starts – with 49 strikeouts over 31 innings. He also made one start for Arkansas, Seattle's Double-A affiliate in the Texas League that season.

AWARD WINNING: Hernandez was 9-5 with a 3.39 ERA in 24 games – 22 starts – for the Modesto Nuts, Seattle's affiliate in the California League in 2022. He had 143 strikeouts over 116-2/3 innings pitched and was named the California League Pitcher of the Year.

LAST START: Hernandez took the <u>loss against Peoria at home on April 13</u>. He allowed three runs on four hits with two hit batsmen, three walks, and four strikeouts over four innings in the game.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Hernandez has never faced the River Bandits prior to this evening. The last time he faced an affiliate of the Kansas City Royals was in an Arizona Complex League game on August 13, 2021. He allowed one hit and struck out five over two scoreless innings of relief for a no decision.

QUAD CITIES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP TYSON GUERRERO: The Royals selected Guerrero in the twelfth round of the 2021 draft out of the University of Washington.

BEFORE WASHINGTON: Guerrero played at Washington State University in 2019 and was a two-way player with a 1-2 record and a 3.63 ERA in nineteen appearances. He transferred to Lower Columbia Community College for 2020 and made two starts and was 1-0 with a 1.80ERA with 20 strikeouts before the season was canceled.

HE'S A HUSKY: Guerrero made eleven starts for the University of Washington in 2021 and was 3-3 with a 2.96 ERA with 50 strikeouts and eighteen walks in 54-2/3 innings pitched.

BOTH SIDES: Guerrero pitched for both of the Royals' affiliates in the Arizona Complex League after signing with Kansas City and made six appearances – four starts – before joining the Columbia Fireflies in the Low-A East where he went 0-1 in three starts.

LAST SEASON: Guerrero was 0-3 with a 6.17 ERA in six starts for the River Bandits before his season ended with an injury during a start on May 10

LAST START: Guerrero lost <u>at Cedar Rapids on April 12</u>. He allowed six runs on four hits with two walks and four strikeouts over three innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Guerrero made two starts against the Timber Rattlers in 2022 and was 0-2. He lost at Wisconsin on April 23 and at Quad Cities on May 10. He allowed four nine on eight hits with nine walks and one strikeout over six innings.
