### ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers rallied past the Peoria Chiefs for a 14-9 victory at Dozer Park.](#)

Wisconsin scored seven runs in the seventh inning to take a 10-8 lead. The Rattlers added a run in the eighth and three more in the ninth for their highest run total of the season. Eduardo Garcia and Blake Burke both had three hits for Wisconsin. The Rattlers are 7-0 when scoring five or more runs in a game this season.

**POWER UP:** Garcia had a double, two homers, two walks, two stolen bases, and three runs scored. Last night was his second two-homer game as a Rattler. Garcia hit two homers against Beloit at home on September 9, 2022.

**KING OF TRIOS:** Burke has three three-hit games this season. Last night he had a single in the third, a two-run double in the seventh to put Wisconsin ahead 10-8, and an RBI single in the ninth for three RBI.

**WHERE THE WILD THINGS ARE:** Seven Peoria pitchers combined to walk fifteen Timber Rattlers last night. There was also a hit batsman, and three wild pitches by the Chiefs hurlers. Daniel Guilarte walked four times last night for Wisconsin.

**HOW DID THAT HAPPEN?** There was one out in the seventh inning with Wisconsin down 8-3. Then, Matt Wood doubled to start a string of seven straight Rattlers reaching base, including Luiyin Alastre being hit with the bases loaded and consecutive bases loaded walks to Guilarte, Yhoswar Garcia, and Hedbert Perez. Jadher Areinamo tied the game with a sacrifice fly. Burke followed with his two-run double, and the Rattlers had scored seven runs on two hits in the seventh to take the lead.

**HOLD THE LINE:** Wisconsin starter Ryan Birchard allowed five runs on 47 pitches in the first two innings. He went back out for the third and pitched a perfect inning. Birchard also worked a scoreless fourth and a scoreless fifth to go five innings to keep the Rattlers within five.

**ABOUT PEORIA:** The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his third year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

**ABOUT THE CARDINALS:** St. Louis has several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Bishop Letson (#14), Blake Burke (#16), Jadher Areinamo (#23), Juan Baez (#26), and Manuel Rodriguez (#29). [MLB Pipeline](#) has three Peoria players on their list of Top 30 Cardinals prospects: Darlin Saladin (#17), Ryan Campos (#18), and Zach Levenson (#28). Zack Showalter (#19) is currently on Peoria's Developmental List.

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP CHANDLER WELCH:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Welch in the sixth round of the 2024 draft out of Tulane University.

**CATCH A GREEN WAVE:** Welch pitched three seasons at Tulane. He was 15-13 with three saves and a 5.42 ERA in 67 games – 29 starts in college. Welch had 204 strikeouts over 199-1/3 innings with Tulane. As a junior – his final season of college baseball, Welch was 7-4 with a 4.65 ERA. In his final collegiate start, Welch was the starting pitcher for Tulane against Oregon State in the NCAA Regional at Corvallis on [May 31, 2024](#). He allowed six runs on seven hits with two walks and a strikeout over four innings against the Beavers.

**CHAMPIONS:** Tulane won the AAC Conference Tournament in Welch's sophomore and junior seasons.

**LET'S GET IT STARTED:** Milwaukee assigned Welch to Carolina on September 8, 2024 and he made his pro debut for the Mudcats against Delmarva. He was transferred to Wisconsin and made a relief appearance in the playoffs against Lake County.

**LAST START:** Welch lost to West Michigan at home on [May 1](#). He allowed four runs on six hits and five walks with two strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings.

**VS. PEORIA:** Welch has never faced the Chiefs prior to this afternoon. Tonight is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals.

## PEORIA STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP JOSE DAVILA:** The St. Louis Cardinals signed Davila as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on July 2, 2019.

**DELAYED START:** Davila didn't make his pro debut until 2021 with the Palm Beach Cardinals of the Florida State League. He also pitched in the Florida Complex League that season and was 1-4 with a 4.86 ERA in fifteen games – nine starts – between the two affiliates.

**HOW HE GOT HERE:** Davila also split time between the FCL Cardinals and Palm Beach in 2022. He pitched for Palm Beach for the entire 2023 and 2024 seasons. Last season, Davila was 6-5 with a 3.54 ERA in 22 games – 21 starts. He walked 46 and struck out 113 over 109-1/3 innings during 2024.

**TWO-TIMER:** Davila won the Florida State League's Pitcher of the Week Award twice in 2024.

**LAST START:** Davila had a no decision against Beloit at home on [May 2](#). He allowed two runs on four hits with two walks, two hit batsmen, and five strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Davila has never faced the Rattlers prior to today. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
