Thursday: SeaWolves 2, RubberDucks 1: Dillon Dingler hit a first-inning two-run homer, and Chance Kirby pitched six innings, only allowing a solo homer to **Oscar González**, to win his first start against Akron. **Eric Mock** went a career-long five innings but took the loss. **Nic Enright** pitched three perfect innings in his Double-A debut.

Oscar on offense: Outfielder **Oscar González** hit .188 with one home run and nine RBI in his first 29 career Double-A games for the RubberDucks in 2019. In 2021, he is leading the club with 11 home runs (tied for fourth in the Double-A Northeast), including five go-ahead homers, a .333 average (fourth), 34 RBI (sixth), .604 SLG (third), .977 OPS (fourth), 53 hits (third), 21 extra-base hits (tied for eighth) and 96 total bases (second). His 12-game hitting streak is the team season high.

Returner shining: In his second season with Akron (81 games in 2019), **Alex Call** is among the offensive leaders in the Double-A Northeast with a .314 average (ninth), .390 OBP (eighth), .895 OPS (eighth), 48 hits (tied for eighth), 13 doubles (tied for seventh), 33 runs (fifth), and 12 stolen bases (second).

Back after two years off: **Richie Palacios** missed the 2019 season due to surgery on a torn right labrum and the 2020 season because of the pandemic. In his first regular season since 2018, Palacios is ninth in the league with a .387 on-base percentage, fourth with 16 doubles, and tied for eighth with 32 runs.

Finding his stride: **Tyler Freeman** had his first career five-hit game May 15 and reached base in his first 21 games this season, including a pair of nine-game hitting streaks. He is tied for eighth in the league in hits (48) and fifth in batting average (.327).

Akron is first to win series over Bowie: In a series with four one-run games, and three extra-inning contests, Akron became the first club to win a series over the first-place Bowie Baysox, who had been 10-1 at home this year. The RubberDucks won, 3-2, Tuesday before dropping 1-0 and 4-3 finals Wednesday and Thursday. Akron then won three straight extra-inning games, 5-1 in 12 innings, 17-9 in 12 innings, and 3-2 in 10 innings. Akron outscored Bowie, 31-9, hit .246 to Bowie's .196 and held a 2.59 ERA to Bowie's 3.54.

First-rounders: In Naylor (No. 29 overall in 2018 draft) and Benson (No. 14 overall in 2016), the RubberDucks feature two Indians first-round picks for the first time since 2016, when Clint Frazier (2013) and Bradley Zimmer (2014) teamed up in the outfield during the club's last Eastern League championship season.

RubberDucks host SeaWolves: Akron is playing the third of four scheduled series this season with the Erie SeaWolves, who won four of six games at UPMC Park May 11-16 and three of five games at Canal Park June 1-6. In 2019, Erie won 15 of 19 meetings, including six of seven in Akron. According to MLB.com, top prospects in this series include:

"He gets on base": Akron has three active players among Double-A Northeast leaders in on-base percentage: **Will Benson** (.394, 6th), **Alex Call** (.390, 8th) and **Richie Palacios** (.387, 9th). Benson also has 34 walks (second). Akron is tied for second in the league in walks (178), third in team OBP (.344) and average (.257), and tied for first in doubles (93), with the second fewest strikeouts (380). Akron's 40 stolen bases (19 on the last 12-game road trip) are tied for third.

Ducks on defense: Akron leads the Double-A Northeast with 39 double plays. **Bo Naylor** leads all AA-NE catchers with 28 assists, and the 10 runners caught stealing (out of 26 attempts) with him behind the plate are tied for second-most among the league's catchers. **Oscar González** has five outfield assists, tied for the lead among AA-NE outfielders. **Chris Roller** has three outfield assists.

Home cooking: The RubberDucks won their first six home games and are 15-6 at Canal Park. In 2019, the RubberDucks were 30-40 at home – their first losing record at Canal Park since 2014 (32-39).

A winning start: The last unbeaten team in Double-A in 2021, Akron started the season 6-0 for the first time since the franchise moved from Canton to Akron before the 1997 season. The six-game winning streak was the club's longest since May 2-8, 2018 (seven straight).

Limited experience: Among the 27 RubberDucks entering Opening Day, only six had played as high as Double-A in their careers. All of those appeared for Akron in 2019. **Alex Call** (81 games) and **Oscar González** (29) are returning outfielders. 2019 RubberDuck **Andruw Monasterio** is the only returning infielder, although **Trenton Brooks**, a 2019 RubberDucks outfielder, will play first base. Ohio State alumnus **Tanner Tully**, the 2019 Akron innings leader (129.1) will be the most experienced member of a pitching staff that otherwise has a total of 10 Double-A innings, all by left-hander **Eli Lingos** when he made a start and relief appearance for Akron in 2019.

Through June 26, Hillman is tied for the Double-A Northeast lead with five wins, is second in innings (47.2), sixth in ERA (3.02), eighth in WHIP (1.17) and ninth in opponents' average (.247).

Last appearance: Tuesday, June 22, vs. Erie (W in 3-0 win)

Hillman scattered six hits with no walks and five strikeouts in his seventh straight start of at least five innings. He stranded an Erie runner at third base in each of the third through sixth innings and six total. Akron scored two runs in the fifth inning and went on to a 3-0 victory, making him the league's first five-game winner.

- Spent some time with the Indians during Spring training alongside fellow RubberDucks pitchers Justin Garza and Dakody Clemmer.
- Closed against the Diamondbacks in Spring Training.

- Hillman transferred to Olympia (Fla.) High ahead of his sophomore year and became teammates with Twins 2014 first-rounder Nick Gordon. Gordon's father Tom, a former All-Star closer, became his legal guardian at that time, and he's since played an integral role in the young left-hander's development on the mound. Hillman's mother, Jamila Spann-Williams, had asked Gordon to be Juan's godfather after Nick and Juan had been youth baseball teammates, and Tom Gordon had taken to mentoring Juan.
- Originally was committed to Central Florida in 2015 before signing with the Indians.

2021 RUBBERDUCKS FIELD STAFF

#24 Rouglas Odor, Manager (Second Season) – Odor, 53, became the 18th manager in club history when he led the club in 2019. The RubberDucks posted a 61-79 record, good for fifth in the Eastern League Western Division following a 34-35 first half record. Odor has twelve seasons of managerial experience where he has compiled a career record of 422-442 (.488).

When Odor was Akron's hitting coach in 2014, he became the first person to wear the uniforms of the Canton-Akron Indians, Akron Aeros, and Akron RubberDucks. He played 197 games for Canton-Akron during the 1991, 1993-94 seasons, and he was the hitting coach for the Aeros' 2012 Eastern League Championship squad.

The 2021 season is Odor's 34th in the Cleveland organization as a player or coach (21st as a coach). The former shortstop was a 32nd-round draft pick by the Indians in 1988 and played in the minor leagues for the Indians from 1988-94 and for the Milwaukee Brewers organization in 1995. The 2019 season was Odor's first as a manager since 2008. He managed San Felipe in the Venezuelan Summer League (1999-2000), the Burlington Indians (2001-2004), the Mahoning Valley Scrappers (2005-2006), Gulf Coast League Indians (2007-2008). In 2009, Odor began serving as hitting coach for the Kinston Indians (2009-2010), Double-A Akron Aeros (2011-2012), High-A Carolina Mudcats (2013), Double-A Akron RubberDucks (2014), and Triple-A Columbus Clippers (2015-2017).

The Maracaibo, Venezuela, native resides in Winter Haven, Florida, with his wife, Milagros. He has three sons and is the uncle of Texas Rangers infielder Rougned Odor.

#35 Owen Dew, Pitching Coach (1st Season) — Owen Dew, 32, makes his first visit to Akron after serving as the pitching coach for the Lake County Captains in the Class-A Midwest league in 2019. Dew began his baseball journey as a right-handed pitcher for Seminole State College of Florida (2008-2009), before moving to the University of Central Florida in 2010, when he was drafted in the 21st round of the 2010 amateur draft by the Cleveland Indians. That same year, Dew advanced through Mahoning Valley with a strong 2.64 ERA in nine starts for the Scrappers. At Class-A Lake County, Dew was converted to a relief pitcher where he appeared in 15 games over the 2010 and 2011 seasons. In Dew's final season as a player, the right hander appeared in 34 games, accruing 70 innings and posted a 3.86 ERA with 41 strikeouts.

Since his playing career, Dew served as an assistant coach at Seminole State College of Florida while also assisting the Cleveland Indians as an associate scout from 2014-2017. Dew was then appointed as a full-time minor league pitching coach within the organization, making stops with the Mahoning Valley (2017), Arizona League Indians 2 (2018), and Lake County Captains (2019). The 2019 Lake County Captains pitching staff posted a team ERA of 3.73 over 1191 innings, good for eighth in the Midwest League.

#16 Junior Betances, Hitting Coach (First Season) — Betances, 47, hits Akron for the first time in his 21-year coaching career with the Cleveland Indians organization. After posting a .289 batting average over 165 games in 1998-1999 with the Akron Aeros, Betances joined the coaching ranks in various roles for the Cleveland Indians Dominican Summer League team from 2000-2010. Betances then served as Arizona League Indians coach from 2010-2015, and moved to Lake County in 2017 as the Bench coach for Manager Larry Day. The native of La Vega, Dominican Republic, Betances has developed a wealth of experience in various player development roles within the Indians organization.

#28 Mike Mergenthaler, Bench Coach (First Season) — Mergenthaler, 32, moves up the Indians farm system to Akron in 2021, following his 2019 season serving as the Lynchburg Hillcats bench coach for Manager Jim Pankovits. In 2018 and 2019, Mergenthaler worked as a hitting coach for the Cleveland Indians' and Milwaukee Brewers' joint Dominican Super League team. The Thiells, NY, native was drafted as a player in the 32nd round of the 2011 amateur draft by the San Francisco Giants, playing in their system for parts of 2011 and 2012.

Jacob Legan, Athletic Trainer (First Season) — Legan heads to Akron for the first time in his six-year career with the Cleveland Indians. Legan previously served as the Lynchburg Hillcats' athletic trainer in 2019.

Scott Nealon, Strength and Conditioning Coach (Second Season, not consecutive) — Nealon enters his eighth season in the Cleveland Indians organization, returning to the same position he held in 2016 for the RubberDucks Eastern League Championship Series. Nealon was the Triple-A Columbus strength and conditioning coach the last three seasons (2017-2019), including the Clippers' 2019 Governor's Cup championship season. Previously, Nealon served as strength and conditioning coach for the Carolina Mudcats (2013-2014), Lynchburg Hillcats (2015), before he made his way to Double-A Akron. Nealon earned his master's degree in exercise science from Baldwin Wallace University in Berea, Ohio.

We Are the RubberDucks

On October 29, 2013, team owner **Ken Babby** stood before a capacity audience at the Akron Civic Theater and announced that the team would be known henceforth as the **Akron RubberDucks**. In addition to being symbolic of the fun, family-friendly brand of entertainment offered by minor league baseball, the name also honors Akron's long history as the "**Rubber Capital of the World.**" Brandiose Marketing of San Diego, California designed the team logo, colors, and various marks and insignias. Please note that for print coverage, *RubberDucks* is spelled as one word with a capital "D." In broadcast coverage, referring to the team as "*the Ducks*" is an acceptable variation of the team's nickname.
