ABOUT SUNDAY: The Omaha Storm Chasers jumped on top of the Indianapolis Indians with two runs in the first frame and did not look back as they took the series finale at Victory Field, 6-1, on Sunday afternoon. Omaha immediately went to work in the first frame as MJ Melendez and Michael Massey tallied back-to-back singles to lead off the game. Carter Jensen moved the runners up with a sacrifice bunt and Drew Waters delivered with a two out, two-run single to grant Ömaha an advantage they did not relinquish. The Indians worked across their lone run of the contest in their half of the first. Ronny Simon led off the frame with a walk, advanced to third on a ground out and a wild pitch and scored on a Nick Solak single. The game held steady at 3-1 until Omaha broke it wide open in their half of the sixth. The Storm Chasers loaded the bases with one out. Melendez connected with another RBI single, and Michael Massey drove in two more runs with a single of his own before being thrown out at second to conclude the inning with a 6-1 lead.

RAIN RAIN GO AWAY: The Indians dropped their last three games against the Storm Chasers over the weekend, tying a season-high losing streak. Of all Triple-A teams, only Indy and Durham are yet to post a four-game skid. The Indians lost their first series at Victory Field since April 1-6 vs. lowa, snapping a streak of nine consecutive home series victories. Indy dropped the season series to Omaha, 8-10, and have not won a season set over the club since resuming play in 2021. Since then, the Indians are 30-53 (.361) against the club.

BUBBA CHANDLER: Bubba Chandler, MLB Pipeline's No. 7 overall prospect in the latest update, made his Triple-A-leading 23rd start of the season on Sunday afternoon. He took his fifth loss of the season, tossing 4.0 innings of three-run ball with six hits, two walks and three strikeouts. Chandler's 116 strikeouts are tied with Las Vegas RHP Mason Barnett for the most in Triple-A.

HE GETS ON (BAE)SE: Ji Hwan Bae was named the Indianapolis Indians July Player of the month on Friday, joining Nick Solak, Drake Fellows and Billy Cook, respectively, as recipients of the team's monthly awards this season. Bae logged a .324 batting average (23-for-71) and .903 OPS in the month while ranking among International League hitters in triples (1st, 4), stolen bases (T-1st, 12; also, Ronny Simon and former Indian Jared Oliva) and on-base percentage (9th, .438). On Sunday, he tallied a pair of doubles. Since returning from the injured list on June 27, Bae is hitting .316 (36-for-114) with 23 runs, six doubles, four triples, 12 RBI, 20 walks, 16 stolen bases and an .863 OPS in 31 games.

SUPER SIMON: Ronny Simon went 0-for-3 with one run, and two walks on Sunday afternoon, extending his on-base streak to 14 games since July 26. In this span, he is hitting .339 (20-for-59) with eight runs, two doubles, one home run, nine RBI, eight walks, five stolen bases and an .842 OPS. Simon has reached safely in 47 of 51 games with Indy and has hit safely in 38 of those.

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak's Triple-A best 39-game on-base streak ended on Thursday night as he went 0-for-4 with three strikeouts. His 39-game run was the longest by a Triple-A player since Buddy Kennedy's 45-game run from May 28-Aug. 1, 2024, between Lehigh Valley and Toledo. Sola-k's streak was also the longest by an Indians player since Chris Richard's 46-game streak from May 13-July 6, 2006. It was the fourth Indianapolis on-base streak of 39-plus games since at least 2005, joining Ty Wigginton (41G, 6/24-8/8, 2005), Ronny Paulino (42G, 6/6-7/27, 2005) and Richard. During his streak, Solak ranked among qualified International League hitters in on-base percentage (2nd, .444), batting average (3rd, .351, 35-for-151) and hits (T-4th, 53), while racking up nine doubles, four homers, 25 RBI, 21 walks to 16 strikeouts and a .934 OPS. On the season, he has reached safely in 73 of his 78 games and has hit safely in 67 of those.

OVI-K-DO: Johan Oviedo struck out eight batters on Saturday night across 3.2 innings with two hits, one run and one walk. He struck out six consecutive batters through the second and third frames. He is one of six Triple-A pitchers to strike out eight-plus batters in 3.2 innings or fewer this season and the first since lowa's Peter Solomon (3.0ip, 8k) on May 16 vs. St. Paul. He was the first Indian to do so since Paul Skenes (3.1ip, 8k) on April 18, 2024, vs. St. Paul. It was Oviedo's most strikeouts in a Triple-A game since May 28, 2022, with Memphis vs. lowa.

JASE IS JAMMIN': Jase Bowen continued his hot start to his Triple-A career, going 1-for-4 on Saturday night. He has begun his Triple-A career 5-for-11 (.455) with two runs, one double, one home run and one stolen base. He made a splash in his Indians debut on Thursday, going 2-for-3 with two runs and a home run. In his first Triple-A at-bat, he launched the third pitch from Chandler Champlain 394 feet to opposite field for a solo homer.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians begin a six-game series with the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders Tuesday night at 6:35 PM. The two teams meet for the first time since 2019, when they split the season series, 3-3. RHP Drake Fellows takes the mound for the Indians, set to make his 12th start and 25th appearance of the season. Since joining the Indy starting rotation on June 7, he has allowed two earned runs or fewer in seven of those starts, including five scoreless outings. It marks his first career start against the RailRiders. Opposite Fellows is RHP Erick Leal, who will make his 22nd appearance and 21st start of the season. In his last outing on Aug. 6 (1) at Lehigh Valley, he allowed a career-high tying nine runs (8er), last doing so on May 25, 2015, with Single-A South Bend vs. Bowling Green.

FRIENDS TO FOES FOR FLORES: Rafael Flores is set to face his previous club, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, for the first time since being traded from New York (AL) to Pittsburgh on July 31. Pirates closer, RHP David Bednar, was dealt to the Yankees in exchange for Flores, C Edgleen Perez and OF Brian Sanchez. Flores ranks as the Pirates No. 8 prospect according to MLB Pipeline. Flores has reached base safely in six of seven games with Indy, hitting .240 (6-for-25) with three runs, two doubles, two RBI and six walks.

ON THIS DATE IN 1997: Trailing, 6-1, following a two-run frame by Nashville in the top of the seventh inning, the Indians erupted for five runs in the eighth and one in the ninth to walk off the Sounds at Victory Field, 7-6. Indians leadoff hitter Pat Watkins finished 3-for-4 with two home runs, his second of which came in game-winning fashion to lead off the bottom of the ninth inning. Keith Mitchell ripped two doubles and drove in two in the comehack win

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Drake Fellows: He will be making his 12th start of the season and his 32nd career start compared to 34 career relief appearances.

Last Outing: Fellows took the loss on Aug. 6 vs. Omaha, tossing 5.0 innings of four-run ball with seven hits, two walks and three strikeouts. It was his first loss at home on the campaign.

Against the RailRiders: Tonight marks his first career start against the RailRiders.

Fellows Posts Zeroes: Fellows owns the longest scoreless streak by an Indians pitcher this season, tossing 15.0 scoreless frames across four starts from July 12-31.

May Flowers: Fellows was named the Indians May Player of the Month earlier this season. In six appearances, he ranked sixth among Triple-A pitchers with at least 15.0 innings pitched in ERA (1.15, 2er/15.2ip) and 11th in WHIP (0.96). He was the first Indians reliver to earn the award since Hunter Stratton in Aug. 2023.

Fab Five: Fellows picked up a win in a career and team-high five straight decisions from April 20-May 31. He pitched to a 2.08 ERA (5er/21.2ip) with 25 strikeouts in nine appearances across that stretch.

Miscellaneous: Selected by San Diego in the sixth round (173rd overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt (Nashville, Tenn.) University... Acquired by Pittsburgh from San Diego on Jan. 19, 2021 with RHP David Bednar, OF Hudson Head and LHP Omar Cruz in exchange for RHP Joe Musgrove; New York (NL) recieved LHP Joey Lucchesi from San Diego and sent C Endy Rodríguez to Pittsburgh.
