### INDY BITS

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Indianapolis Indians defeated the Louisville Bats, 6-3, to take a 2-1 advantage in this week's six-game series. Nick Yorke launched his first home run of the season, Nick Solak hit his second homer and Henry Davis notched two doubles to push Indy to victory. Indians starter Carson Fulmer tossed 5.0 innings of three-run ball on five hits, no walks and four strikeouts to earn his second consecutive win. David Bednar, Randy Labaut and Eddy Yean allowed just two hits across 4.0 shutout innings in relief, with Yean picking up his first save of the year in a scoreless ninth frame.

**EXIT MUSIC (FOR A BASEBALL):** In his first game after being reinstated from the 7-day injured list, Nick Yorke launched his first home run of the season to give Indianapolis a 5-3 lead in the fifth inning. In five games this season, he is hitting .300 (6-for-20) with three doubles, one home run, two RBI, and a .964 OPS. He has a five-game hitting streak to begin the season and has reached base safely two-plus times in three of those games.

**SUPER STARTS:** Indians starting pitchers have posted a 2.50 ERA (10er/36.0ip) this season which is the fourth best mark in Triple-A behind St. Paul, Durham and Jacksonville. The rotation's 11.00 strikeouts per nine innings is the fourth best mark in Triple-A, trailing Worcester, Durham and Gwinnett.

**GLASS HALF FULL:** Carson Fulmer earned his second win in as many starts last night, allowing three runs over 5.0 innings on five hits, no walks and four strikeouts. He is yet to allow a walk through 10.0 innings this season. He improved to 2-0 against the Bats in his career, posting a 5.24 ERA (13er/22.1ip) in those games.

**HENRY'S HEATING UP:** Henry Davis has three consecutive multi-hit games after going 2-for-4 with two doubles, one RBI and two runs in last night's contest. His three straight multi-hit performances are his longest multi-hit run since a four-gamer from Aug. 14-18, 2024, vs. St. Paul. Over his past three games, Davis is hitting .500 (6-for-12) with three doubles, two RBI and a 1.288 OPS.

**PEGGY PROWESS:** Liover Peguero went 2-for-4 with one RBI and one run in last night's contest. He is riding a team-high tying eight-game on-base streak, hitting .300 (9-for-30) with two doubles, three RBI, three walks and one stolen base in this span. He has back-to-back multi-hit games for the first time since Aug 14-15, 2024, vs. St. Paul. Wednesday night's performance marked his first game with two-plus hits and two-plus RBI since Aug. 30, 2024, vs. Louisville.

**SO LONG, SOLAK:** Nick Solak deposited his second home run of the season in the third inning of last night's game, extending the Indians lead, 2-0. Solak has a hit in all four of his games this season, batting .250 (4-for-16) with two home runs, three RBI and a .625 slugging percentage. He has driven in a run in three of his four games.

**GALLANT GORSKI:** Matt Gorski has reached base safely in all eight of his games this season and is riding a team-high seven-game hitting streak. In those eight games he is hitting .310 (9-for-29) with three doubles, one home run, four RBI, three walks, two stolen bases and a .892 OPS. He launched his first home run of the season in Game 1 last Thursday vs. Iowa, following DJ Stewart's three-run bomb for a set of back-to-back blasts in the third inning.

**TODAY'S DOUBLEHEADER:** The Indians and Bats are set for a seven-inning doubleheader with game one scheduled for 2:05 PM. Right-hander Mike Burrows takes the mound for Indy and is set to make his third start of the season. He has allowed one earned run across 6.0 innings in his previous two outings. Burrows is 0-1 with a 3.38 ERA (4er/10.2ip) and nine strikeouts in three career starts against the Bats. Opposite Burrows in game one is LHP Drew Parrish. Parrish is set to make his third start of the season, going 0-1 and allowing three earned runs across 4.2 innings. Parrish is 3-1 in his career against Indianapolis, posting a 3.68 ERA (10er/23.1ip).

**GAME 2:** Game two, which is scheduled for 30 minutes after the conclusion of game one, will feature a bullpen game for the Indians. Right-hander Peter Strzelecki is set to make his first career start as the opener. He allowed four runs to the Bats in just a third of an inning on Tuesday night, giving up three hits and two walks. On the mound for the Bats in game two is right-hander Aaron Wilkerson. Wilkerson is set to make his third start of the season. After allowing eight earned runs in his season debut on March 30 vs. Memphis, he tossed 6.0 shutout innings to follow on April 5 at Omaha. Wilkerson made one previous start against Indy and earned the win on May 28, 2016, with Pawtucket, tossing 6.2 innings of one-run ball with nine strikeouts.

**ON THIS DATE IN 2019:** For the second straight day, left fielder Trayvon Robinson finished the game with four hits en route to two Indy victories over Charlotte. He topped his 4-for-4 performance on April 11 with four extra-base hits in the second game of the series. With two doubles and two triples, he was the first Indy player to hit two triples in a game since Willy Garcia on April 27, 2016. That wasn't the first feat matched in the game either, as first baseman Will Craig stole home as part of a double steal, marking the first time an Indy player swiped home since Eury Perez on July 17, 2017.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

**Mike Burrows:** Right-hander Mike Burrows is set to make his third start of the season. He has allowed one run in 6.0 innings over his past two starts.

**Last Outing:** Burrows did not factor into the decision, allowing one run over 2.1 innings on April 6 vs. Iowa.

**Against the Bats:** Burrows is 0-1 with a 3.38 ERA (4er/10.2ip) and nine strikeouts in three career starts against the Bats.

**September Callup:** Following his 10-strikeout performance in the Indians 2024 season finale, Burrows was recalled by Pittsburgh for his major league debut on Sept. 28 at New York (AL). He earned the win out of the bullpen, allowing two runs (one earned) over 3.1 innings. He struck out Oswaldo Cabrera swinging as his second batter faced for his first MLB punchout.

**Prospectus:** Burrows is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 13 prospect by *Baseball America* and No. 15 by MLB Pipeline.

**Miscellaneous:** Selected by Pittsburgh in the 11th round (324th overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Waterford (Conn.) High School... Had his contract first selected by Pittsburgh on Nov. 15, 2022.

- » Was named Indianapolis' May Player of the Month after hitting nine home runs in 23 games, good for a .720 slugging percentage and 1.050 OPS; His nine home runs in the month were the third-most by an Indians batter in a single month since 2005 and the most since Michael Ryan launched 10 in July 2007.
