ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Peoria Chiefs 4-2. Tyler Woessner pitched six scoreless innings and struck out seven as the starting pitcher for the Rattlers as he picked up his fifth win of the season. The Rattlers scored twice with two outs in the first inning and added two runs in the fifth. Peoria scored twice in the seventh but would get no closer. Ben Metzinger, Eduardo García, Joe Gray Jr, and Darrien Miller had the RBI for the Rattlers.

SERIES CLINCHER: Last night's win was the fourth of the series for the Timber Rattlers. This gives the Rattlers their second series win of the season. Their other series win was also against Peoria when Wisconsin took four of six from April 11 through April

TIME FOR TYLER: Last night was the third quality start of the season for Woessner. He allowed three hits and walked one. Woessner is tied with three other pitchers for the league lead in wins (5) and tied for third in the Midwest League in innings pitched (50-1/3).

STAY HOT: Gray went 2-for-3 with a walk, a run, a stolen base, and an RBI. Gray has three straight multihit games (6-for-10).

KING'S LANDING: Justin King pitched a 1-2-3 top of the ninth inning with two strikeouts to record his first save in affiliate ball. King has not allowed a run in his last five appearances. He has thirteen strikeouts and has allowed two hits with one walk over 5-2/3 innings.

ON ASSIGNMENT: The Milwaukee Brewers have announced that Willy Adames will make a rehab start as a designated hitter in Sunday's game. Adames has hit by a foul ball during Milwaukee's game against the San Francisco Giants on May 25. He has been working out with the Timber Rattlers for the last few days and has been cleared to play today.

DID YOU KNOW? Peoria leads the Timber Rattlers 9-8 with four games remaining in the season series. However, the Timber Rattlers have outscored the Chiefs 81-72 in this season.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his second year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Eduardo García (#19), Matthew Wood (#24), and Joseph Hernandez (#25). Hendry Mendez (#13) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. MLB Pipeline has seven Peoria players on their list of Top 30 Cardinals prospects: Tink Hence #3), Cooper Hjerpe (#6), Jimmy Crooks (#15), Ian Bedell (#24), Dionys Rodriguez (#26), Victor Scott II (#27) and Zane Mills (#30). Inohan Paniagua (#17), and Austin Love (#19) are on Peoria's IL.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE: Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

FAST DEBUT: Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

HIT PLAY: Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

WEEKLY AWARD: Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021 after his performance against the White Sox on August 31, 2021. He allowed one run on one hit and two walks with six strikeouts over five innings in the game.

FEELING 2022: Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with Wisconsin and allowed four runs with six walks and 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

LAST START: Cornielle had a no decision against Peoria at home in game one of this series on $\underline{\text{May 30}}$. He allowed five runs on five hits with three walks and a strikeout over four innings.

VS. PEORIA (2023): Cornielle is 0-1 in three starts against the Chiefs this season. He has a no decision at home on April 12, a loss at Peoria on May 6, and a no decision at home on May 30. Cornielle has allowed twelve runs on seventeen hits with five walks and nine strikeouts over 11-2/3 innings in his three starts against the Chiefs.

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TINK HENCE: The St. Louis Cardinals selected Hence in Competitive Balance Round-B with the 63rd pick of the 2020 draft out of Watson Chapel (AR) High School.

TURNING PRO: Hence signed with the Cardinals over a commitment to the University of Arkansas.

STARTING OUT: Hence made eight appearances – one start – for the Cardinals Florida Complex League affiliate in 2021. He was 0-1 with a save and allowed eight earned runs on eleven hits with three walks and fourteen strikeouts over eight innings.

STAYING IN FLORIDA: Hence made sixteen starts for the Palm Beach Cardinals in 2022. He was 0-1 with a 1.38 ERA and recorded 81 strikeouts with just 15 walks in 52-1/3 innings pitched.

HOW DOES HE RATE? MLB Pipeline places Hence as the #3 prospect in the Cardinals organization and #71 in their Top 100 for all minor league baseball. *Baseball America* puts him at #2 in the St. Louis System and #45 in their Top 100 for all minor league baseball.

LAST START: Hence had a no decision against Wisconsin in game one of this series on May 30. He allowed one hit with three walks and six strikeouts over four scoreless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Hence has two no decisions in two starts against the Rattlers this season with both appearances at Neuroscience Group Field. He had the <u>start against the Timber Rattlers on April 13</u> and again on May 30. He has allowed five hits with four walks and eight strikeouts over 7-2/3 scoreless innings.
