**LAST ACTION:** [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the West Michigan Whitecaps 7-3 on Sunday afternoon at Neuroscience Group Field](#). Wisconsin trailed 3-0 after the top of the fourth but rallied to tie the game with three runs in the bottom of the fourth and scored four times in the bottom of the sixth for the win. Yerlin Rodriguez, Patricio Aquino, and Zach Peek combined to pitched 5 1/3 innings of scoreless relief. Daniel Guijarte had three hits to pace the Wisconsin offense. The Rattlers are 6-0 when scoring five or more runs in a game this season.

**BREAK OUT:** Tayden Hall ended an 0-for-21 slump with a two-run single in the bottom of the fourth to get Wisconsin on the scoreboard. Guijarte was 6-for-60 to start the season before tying the game with an RBI single in the fourth.

**TO THE FRONT:** Wisconsin loaded the bases with no outs in the sixth inning and took the lead on a bases-loaded walk to Hedbert Perez. Jadher Areinamo added a sacrifice fly for a 5-3 lead. Blake Burke drove in another run with a grounder. Matt Wood capped the inning with a two-out, RBI single.

**MULTI-MAN:** Areinamo was 2-for-4 on Sunday. He had two hits in each of his last four games (8-for-16, .500). Areinamo leads Wisconsin with ten multi-hit games this season.

**SPLITSVILLE:** The Rattlers win on Sunday gave them a split with the Whitecaps in the six-game series at home. Wisconsin is 5-10 at Neuroscience Group Field in 2025. They are 6-6 on the road this year.

**SCHEDULING NOTE:** Wisconsin's first 27 games of the season were against the top two teams in each division. The Rattlers were 3-3 against Quad Cities, the West Division Leaders and 4-5 against Cedar Rapids, the second-place team in the West. Wisconsin was 3-3 against West Michigan, the top team in the east, and 1-5 against Lansing, the current second-place team in the East.

**ABOUT PEORIA:** The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his third year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

**ABOUT THE CARDINALS:** St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

## PITCHING MATCHUP

### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP RYAN BIRCHARD:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Birchard in the 5<sup>th</sup> round of the 2023 draft out of the Niagara County Community College.

**PLAYER OF THE YEAR:** Birchard was named the Western New York Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2023. He was 8-0 in ten games – nine starts – with a 1.08 ERA and 95 strikeouts over fifty innings pitched. Birchard was also named a First Team All-NJCAA Division III All-American in 2023.

**QUICK TRIP TO TRENTON:** Birchard made four appearances – two starts – for Trenton in the MLB Draft League after the end of his college season. He allowed one run, walked one, and struck out sixteen over nine innings before signing with Milwaukee.

**DELAYED START:** Birchard did not pitch professionally in 2023. He made a start for the Carolina Mudcats on April 6, 2024 (4.0IP, H, R, 0ER, 2BB, 6K) but was placed on the IL after that game. He next pitched with the ACL Brewers on July 16 and July 22. Birchard rejoined Carolina for appearances on July 28 and August 3 before being sent to Wisconsin on August 13.

**AS A RATTLER (2024):** Birchard made five regular season starts for Wisconsin last season. He was 0-3 with an 8.71 ERA. He walked fourteen and struck out thirteen in 10-1/3 innings with the Timber Rattlers

**LAST START:** Birchard had a no decision against West Michigan at home on [April 29](#). He allowed a run on three hits with three walks and seven strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. PEORIA:** Birchard made two starts against Peoria at home – August 13 and August 19 – last season. He was 0-1 and allowed five runs – four earned – on eight hits with two walks and four strikeouts over four innings.

### WEST MICHIGAN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP CADE WINQUEST:** The St. Louis Cardinals selected Winquest in the eighth round of the 2022 draft out of University of Texas-Arlington.

**THE COLLEGE YEARS:** Winquest was 9-11 with a 5.77 ERA in 46 games – 32 starts – at Texas-Arlington. He had 155 strikeouts in 160-2/3 innings. Winquest also pitched for Tulsa in the Texas Collegiate League in 2020 and Chatham in the Cape Cod Baseball League in 2021.

**LIFE'S A BEACH:** Winquest's first professional season was with the Palm Beach Cardinals of the Florida State League in 2023. He was 3-7 with a 4.87 ERA in 24 games – thirteen starts – in 2023. Winquest had 81 strikeouts and 35 walks in 77-2/3 innings with Palm Beach.

**FALSE START:** Winquest started the 2024 season with Peoria and was 0-2 with a 3.10 ERA in nine games – two starts. He went on the Peoria IL on May 13, was activated on May 29, and went back on the IL on June 18 without making another appearance in a game last year.

**LAST START:** Winquest had a no decision against Beloit at home on [April 30](#). He allowed a run on four hits with four walks and a strikeout over four innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Winquest made two relief appearances against the Timber Rattlers in 2024. He allowed two runs on four hits with five walks and eleven strikeouts over 10-1/3 innings. Winquest had a save on April 5 when he pitched five scoreless, hitless innings with two walks and six strikeouts at Neuroscience Group Field.
