SUNDAY IN THE PARK: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers swept a doubleheader from the Beloit Sky Carp at Neuroscience Group Field. The Timber Rattlers won game one 1-0 and game two 7-6 in ten innings.

GAME ONE RECAP: Manuel Rodriguez, Anthony Flores, and Jesús Broca combined on a three-hit shutout. Yhoswar Garcia reached on a two-out error in the bottom of the second inning. Kay-Lan Nicasia followed with a double off the wall in right to knock in Garcia for the only run of the game. Wisconsin had two hits, but it was enough. Flores walked five and struck out five in three innings as a reliever for the win. Broca committed a two-out error in the ninth and threw two wild pitches to allow the tying run to take third before getting the final out on a strikeout.

GAME TWO RECAP: Wisconsin scored three runs in the bottom of the seventh inning to tie the game 5-5. Both teams scored a run in the ninth. The Timber Rattlers won the game on an RBI fielder's choice by Yhoswar Garcia in the bottom of the tenth. It was Wisconsin's sixth walkoff win of the season.

TURNING TWO: Wisconsin's defense turned four double plays on Sunday. They have 84 in 2025.

HOLD THE DOOR: Wisconsin pitchers held the Sky Carp to 2-for-21 with runners in scoring position in the doubleheader.

DÉJÀ VU: Wisconsin's 1-0 win in game one of Sunday's doubleheader was their third 1-0 win over the Sky Carp in a seven-inning game this season. Wisconsin swept a twinbill from Beloit at home on May 16 by winning both games 1-0.

KING OF TRIOS: Jadhier Areinamo had three hits in game two on Sunday for the Rattlers. He also drove in the tying run with a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the seventh and scored the winning run in the bottom of the tenth. Areinamo has four three-hit games and 23 multi-hit games this season. He leads the Midwest League in hits (88) and is tied with Zahir Hope of Great Lakes for the league lead in total bases (136).

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, Pete Crow-Armstrong, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torey Lovullo, is in his second year as South Bend's manager.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL for an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP SAM GARCIA: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Garcia in the eighth round of the 2024 draft out of Oklahoma State.

HITTING THE HIGH POINT: Garcia pitched three seasons at High Point University from 2021 through 2023. He was a First Team All-Big South selection after his sophomore season when he was 5-4 with a save and a 1.94 ERA in sixteen games – eight starts.

STILLWATER: Garcia pitched for Brewster of the Cape Cod League in 2023 and transferred to Oklahoma State University for his final season of collegiate baseball. As a Cowboy, Garcia was 7-3 with a 3.64 ERA in sixteen starts. He had 115 strikeouts over 89 innings.

STARTING OUT: Garcia did not pitch professionally last year. He made his pro debut with the Carolina Mudcats this season and was 5-1 with a save and a 2.08 ERA in ten appearances – two starts. Garcia walked nineteen and struck out 44 in 34-2/3 innings with Carolina before his promotion to Wisconsin on June 3.

LAST START: Garcia lost at Beloit on [July 2](#). He allowed three runs – one earned – on four hits with three walks and three strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings. Garcia also allowed a homer in the game. He has given up a homer in three straight starts.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Garcia has never faced South Bend before tonight. He made two relief appearances against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans, the Carolina League affiliate of the Chicago Cubs, earlier this season as a member of the Carolina Mudcats. Garcia was 1-0 with two runs allowed on six hits with four walks and eight strikeouts in 7-1/3 innings.

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BROOKS CAPLE: The Chicago Cubs selected Caple in the ninth round of the 2024 draft out of Lamar University.

CARDINAL RULE: Caple pitched two seasons at Stephen F. Austin University before transferring to Lamar for the 2023 and 2024 seasons. In his senior season at Lamar, Caple was 7-3 with a 2.40 ERA, 102 strikeouts, 27 walks, and a WHIP of 0.87.

AWARD SEASON: Caple was as two-time All-Southland Conference selection and was the Southland Conference Pitcher of the Year in 2024. *Baseball America* named him Third-Team All-American last year.

LIFE ON THE BEACH: Caple did not pitch professionally in 2024. He began this season with the Myrtle Beach Pelicans of the Carolina League. Caple was 3-1 with a 1.80 ERA in seven starts for the Pelicans. He walked fourteen and struck out 30 over 35 innings before his promotion to South Bend on May 27.

LAST START: Caple lost at Peoria on [July 1](#). He allowed three runs on six hits with two walks and four strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Caple has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. He had a no decision against the Carolina Mudcats, the Carolina League affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers, on [April 13](#). The Mudcats scored three runs on three hits with two walks over four innings against him in that game. Caple struck out two Carolina hitters.
