**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** [The Beloit Snappers beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 3-1 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#) Wisconsin was down 3-0 after the Snappers scored twice with two outs in the third inning and added an unearned run in the fifth. Wisconsin scored their run on an RBI grounder by Zavier Warren in the bottom of the sixth.

**TRIPLE DECKER:** Sal Frelick had a triple prior to Warren's RBI grounder. It was Frelick's first triple for the Rattlers and Wisconsin's first triple since Je'Von Ward had one at Beloit on August 8.

**THE FIRST DECADE:** Wisconsin starting pitcher Justin Jarvis struck out ten over 5-1/3 innings to set a new single-game high as a professional. His previous single-game high was five.

**DEJÀ VU:** Last night was the fourth straight game in which Wisconsin fell behind the Snappers by three runs. Last night was the first time the Rattlers did not rally for the win.

**KEEP CLIMBING UP THAT HILL:** The Rattlers winning streak ended at three games with the loss. Wisconsin has had five three-game winning streaks and one four-game winning streak this season.

**HOW DO YOU SPELL RELIEF?** Carlos Sierra and Cam Robinson combined for 3-2/3 innings scoreless innings last night. In the first four games of this series, the Wisconsin bullpen has allowed three runs – two earned – over 15-2/3 innings.

**ABOUT БЕЛОИТ:** The Beloit Snappers are in their first season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11 and [moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3.](#) Mike Jacobs is in his first season as the manager of the Snappers. Jacobs managed the Clinton LumberKings in 2019, Clinton's last year as an affiliate of the Marlins.

**ABOUT THE MARLINS:** The Florida/Miami Marlins had a history in the old Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and current Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings and went 78-61 to qualify for the playoffs. They were swept by the South Bend Cubs in the 2019 MWL Championship Series.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) puts eight Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Sal Frelick (#2), Joe Gray Jr. (#9), Antoine Kelly (#10), Freddy Zamora (#11), Zavier Warren (#14), Carlos Rodriguez (#22), Joey Wiemer (#23), and Victor Castañeda (#30). [MLB Pipeline](#) has three current Snappers on their Top 30 list of Miami Marlins prospects: Eury Perez (#6), Dax Fulton (#9), and Connor Scott (#24).

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP NICK BENNETT:** Selected by the Brewers in the 6<sup>th</sup> round of the 2019 draft out of the University of Louisville.

**LOUISVILLE:** Bennett was 7-3 with a 4.40ERA in sixteen starts during his final season with the Cardinals. He went 20-6 in 45 games – 40 starts – during his career at Louisville with 209 strikeouts over 215-2/3 innings pitched.

**DREAMS OF OMAHA:** Bennett made two starts for the Cardinals in the College World Series. He was the starter against TCU as a freshman on June 22, 2017 and took the loss. Bennett started against Mississippi State on June 20, 2019 for a no decision in a game that Louisville rallied from a 3-0 deficit to win 4-3.

**TO THE SPRINGS:** Bennett made his pro debut with the Rocky Mountain Vibes, the Pioneer League affiliate of the Brewers. He appeared in six games – three starts – for the Vibes and allowed two earned runs with 19K in 12-2/3 innings.

**ON WISCONSIN:** Bennett appeared in five games – three starts – for the Timber Rattlers in 2019. He walked four and struck out 24 in 20-1/3 innings pitched with Wisconsin. Bennett was 1-0 with a 2.21 ERA. One of his starts with the Rattlers was at Clinton, the Miami Marlins affiliate at the time, and he matched his professional high for strikeouts in a single game with seven and set a single-game high as a pro for innings pitched with 5-2/3.

**THIS YEAR:** Bennett started this season with the Timber Rattlers and was 1-0 with a 4.96 ERA in four games – three starts – before a move to Biloxi in the Double-A South in early June. He was 1-4 with a 4.66 ERA in ten games – six starts – for the Shuckers before coming back to Wisconsin.

**LAST START:** Bennett lost [at Quad Cities on August 26](#). He allowed five runs on seven hits with three walks and four strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

**VS. БЕЛОИТ:** Bennett is 0-1 in two starts against the Snappers this season. He has allowed seven runs – five earned – on twelve hits with three walks and ten strikeouts over 8-1/3 innings against Beloit this season.

## БЕЛОИТ SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP EURY PEREZ:** The Marlins signed Perez as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on July 2, 2019.

**TOP TEN :** Perez is rated as the #6 prospect Miami's minor league system. MLB Pipeline notes that he has grown four inches, added 45 pounds, and has touched 97 mph with his fastball since signing with the Marlins. Perez does not turn nineteen until April, 2022.

**ON ANOTHER PLANET:** Perez started his pro career with the Jupiter Hammerheads this season in the Low-A Southeast. He was 2-3 with a 1.61 ERA and 82 strikeouts in 56 innings over fifteen starts with Jupiter.

**LAST START:** Perez had a [no decision against Cedar Rapids at home on August 28](#). He allowed a run on no hits with a walk, a hit batsman, and seven strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Perez has never faced the Timber Rattlers. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
